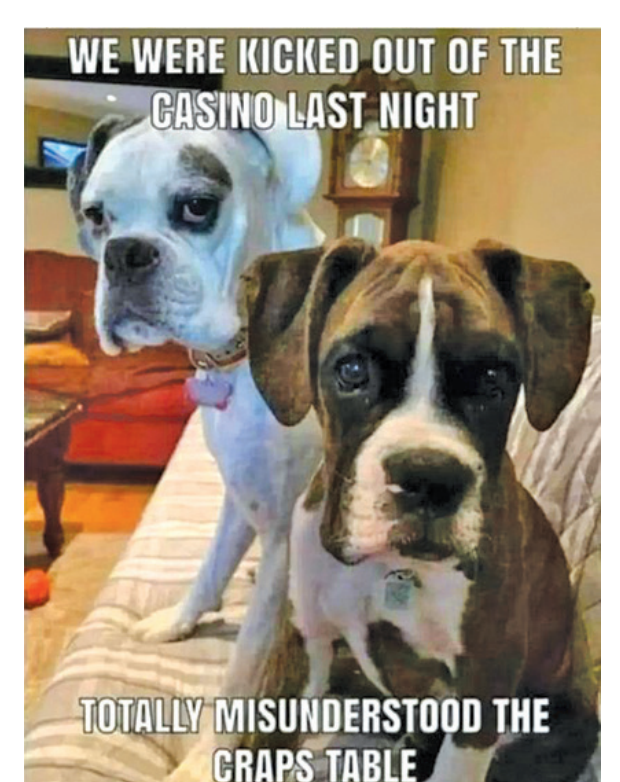

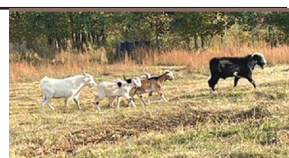

Playing Cards

Bicycle Playing Cards may be the most recognizable brand by the United States Playing Card Co. The brand has been around since 1885. One look at this store counter display advertising Bicycle Playing Cards will tell you that it's not from the late 1800s.

The large center scene shows a lively, colorful scene with two men and two women in formal dress around a card table. Changes in men's formal wear since the 19th century are much less dramatic than changes in women's clothes. The women in this picture have short hairstyles and low-neck sleeveless dresses that weren't seen until the 20th century. This display sold for \$1,375 at a Potter & Potter auction, and its description dated it to "circa 1930."

Q: In 1967, as a 14-year-old, I lived in Sebastopol, California, with Charles Schulz as a neighbor. I was friends with his sons. One day, as I was visiting his place, I got several discarded sketches on 4- by 6-inch notepad paper. When Mr. Schulz was formulating ideas for his strip, he would sketch out his ideas on notepads before he finalized them in his strip. Then he would crumple them up and toss them away. Many years ago, I framed them with copies of the actual comic strips that they inspired, which were published a month or so later. I have always wondered what value these sketches could have.

A: Charles Schulz created the comic strip "Peanuts" in 1950. It originally ran from 1950 to 2000 and has been in reruns since then. Original art for popular comic strips sells for high prices. The record price for original art for "Peanuts" was \$192,000 for a four-panel, black-and-white daily strip from 1950. It sold at Heritage Auctions in 2020. Individual sketches have sold for a few hundred dollars to over a thousand dollars. Subject, size and condition help determine the value. The artists' signature also adds val-

ue. Your small, unsigned sketches will be of interest to collectors if they are in good condition. Contact an auction house that sells comic art to find out the value of the sketches.

Q. Is it true that Sam Waterston is leaving "Law & Order"? Who is going to replace him? — *K.J.*

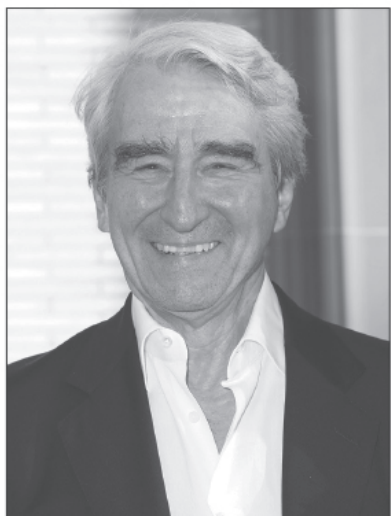

Joining them this season is the Grammy-winning country/pop duo Dan + Shay, who met when they moved to Nashville, Tennessee, separately.

Dan + Shay hit it big in 2018 with their single "Tequila" and followed that with the crossover hit song "10,000 Hours," which they recorded with Justin Bieber. The twosome actually isn't new to "The Voice" — they appeared in season 20 as "battle advisors" for former judge Blake Shelton.

In terms of Billboard rankings, the most successful winners from "The Voice" include Cassadee Pope from season three. She climbed to the top-five spot of the country music chart with the song "Wasting All These Tears." According to TVLine, she's since left the genre to return to her pop-punk roots. Season nine's Jordan Smith had the

most successful debut album of the winners so far and also found success as a songwriter. He penned "Ashes" for the "Deadpool 2" soundtrack, which was recorded by none other than Celine Dion. Last season's winner who goes by one name — Huntley — has yet to release a single, but he did sing the National Anthem at an NFL game.

Q. When are the Oscars this year? I remember when they used to be in February, but they seem to have been pushed back later and later. — *I.E.*

A. The 96th(!) Annual Academy Awards will air live on ABC on Sunday, March 10. Jimmy Kimmel will host the ceremony for the second year in a row, and it'll begin an hour earlier than in past years (7 p.m. ET instead of 8 p.m.). There will also be a 30-minute live pre-show on the red carpet.

The earlier time slot is an attempt to boost ratings. With the ceremony expected to end by 10:30 p.m., the network is hoping viewers will stick it out instead of turning off their TVs and other devices before it concludes.

By January 1st of each year, each Virginia releasing agency (public animal shelter, private animal shelter, and homebased rescue group) must submit an annual summary of the animals received and what happened to them (returned to owner, adopted, transferred, died in shelter, euthanized, still in shelter) to the State Veterinarian. We were in favor of the bill that made this report into law about 20 years ago. Beginning in 2006, the summary reports are required to be posted on the State Veterinarian's website.

What no one could foresee was how those reports would become weapons to vilify the work of shelters, especially public shelters. There are some that would reduce the work of a shelter to one number – the "live release rate." The simple numbers on a report can never be taken at face value because each number represents a voiceless animal who has an unknown story.

We are their voice and this is their story.



Under contract with the City, we operate the city public animal shelter. We remain one of the few truly open admission shelters in the country. We could choose the easier path that other shelters have taken to become limited admission.

Some people will tell you that because of our euthanasia rate, we are among the lowest performing shelters in Virginia.

We disagree. We believe we are among the highest performing shelters in Virginia because:

- We never turn away an animal, no matter the behavioral issues, medical issues, age, adoptability, or locality.
- When considering a potential home for our animals, we do everything in our power to ensure that animal will never again be hungry, cold, thirsty, hot, stray, abandoned, or mistreated. We treat every animal as if he were our own beloved companion we can no longer take care of and must find a home for.

In the early 2000s, we attended an annual statewide conference. A woman conducting one of the workshops asked if we ever worried about an animal once we found a home for

them. Almost everyone in the room raised a hand. The woman then said, "Don't. It's your job to get them out of the door. Forget about what happens to them in their new home."

A couple of years later, again at an annual statewide conference, we were told that the only way to decrease euthanasia was to decrease the number of animals received. This would be achieved by not accepting unadoptable animals or animals from owners. Possible methods to discourage people from bringing an animal to a shelter included waiting lists, charging a fee, or simply not returning telephone calls.

We rejected both of those workshop presentations then and we reject them now.

\$5 Million in Housing Grants for Special Needs Veterans

The Department of Veterans Affairs has done the final math for 2023, and the number of homeless veterans who found permanent housing has passed the initial goal. The total now stands at 46,000 veterans who were helped.

At the same time, the VA hooked up with 40,000 veterans to get them the resources they need to find housing and worked to ensure that 95% of housed veterans can stay that way.

All this is part of the Housing First program. The theory is that getting a veteran into a home first is crucial, then to be followed up with the services needed to ensure the continued housing. Part of that includes education, legal help, health care and jobs training. Veterans who are part of the Housing First program generally find housing more quickly, in 35 days as opposed to 223 days on average.

Now, having the final 2023 number of 46,000 veterans put into housing, the VA has announced funding in the amount of \$5 million in grants (renewable for a second year) to help the special needs group of homeless veterans (mentally ill, the elderly, women, the terminally ill and those with children). The Homeless Providers Grant and Per Diem Program gives the cash to community groups that handle both temporary transitional housing and case management, hooking them up with services, permanent housing and access to VA benefits.

There are only 16 of the special needs grant recipient groups that can apply for a share of that \$5 million. The list of grantees indicates that each group concentrates on only one category of the special needs list, with the Chronically Mentally Ill group having a slight edge over the other categories. The actual awarding of the funds will run from October 2024 to September 2026, with applications needing to be received by April 15, 2024.

Cattle Drive Casserole

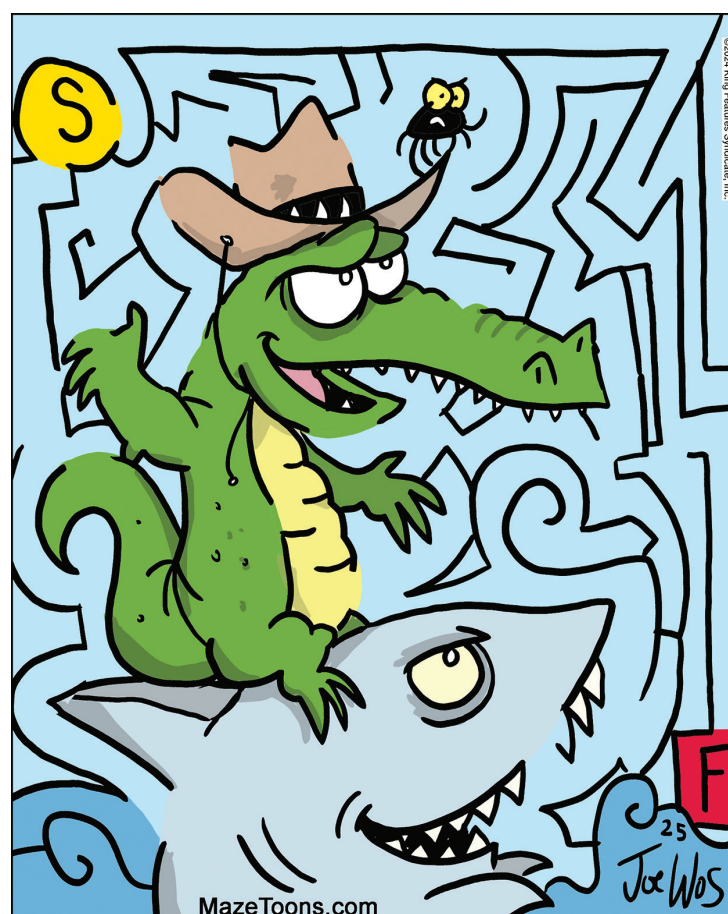


Ingredients

- 1.5 pounds Lean Ground Beef
- 1 Red Bell Pepper seeded, chopped
- 1 Yellow Onion chopped
- 1 ounce Taco Seasoning Mix
- 2 ½ cups Biscuit Mix like Bisquick
- 1 cup Water
- Cooking Spray like Pam
- ½ cup Sour Cream
- ½ cup Mayonnaise
- 4 ounces Diced Green Chiles drained
- 1 ½ cups Cheddar Cheese Fiesta Blend, shredded, divided
- 1 teaspoon Garlic Powder
- ½ cup Salsa mild

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees
 Place ground beef in skillet. Break apart with spoon and cook on medium high until no longer pink, stirring as necessary. Drain off excess fat. (You can make the biscuit dough while the meat is cooking.)
 Place biscuit mix and water in mixing bowl. Stir together. This is best done with your hands to get it thoroughly mixed. Spray casserole dish with cooking spray and press the dough into it, filling all the way out to the edges. Place in preheated oven and bake for 5-8 minutes until set and lightly golden. Set aside. Do not turn off oven.
 Add chopped onions and red bell pepper to ground beef. Stir and continue cooking about 4 minutes. Add taco seasoning mix, stir well to coat. Remove from stove.
 Add the ground beef mixture on top of the biscuit layer and spread evenly all the way to the edges.
 In a medium mixing bowl, combine sour cream, mayonnaise, drained green chiles, ¾ cup shredded cheese and garlic powder. Mix well. Carefully spread sour cream mixture as a layer on top of the ground beef mixture. Add small spoonfuls of salsa intermittently over the top of the sour cream layer. No need to spread it thin. Add the remaining shredded cheese evenly on top.
 Place in preheated oven, uncovered. Bake for 30 minutes until warm and bubbly.

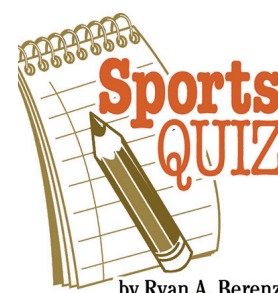

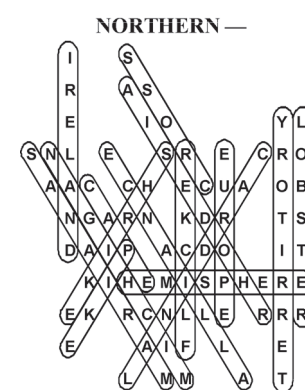
