Piedmont Pets

This is an annual reminder:

We receive many notices about pets that have wandered away. We also see many more posts on social media about lost pets. Many owners tell us that their animal must have been stolen because their dog or cat has never just wandered away; however, most of the time the animal has become lost for a variety of reasons.

A dog will sometimes just follow a scent his nose has picked up. sometimes they have been scared by other animals, and sometimes they just wander away. Cats who are allowed outside can also become frightened by other animals or loud noises and run away in fear. In addition, cats do get into car engines and are given a very dangerous ride to destinations far away.

There are many reasons why dogs and cats become strays. The best line of defense is to provide a collar and identification information. Even in areas that permit dogs to wander require a current city or county tag. Microchipping a pet is becoming increasingly important because of the increase in people picking up strays and either keeping them or placing them in rescue groups.

If the worst happens and your dog or cat is missing, contact all animal shelters within a 50-mile radius. It may be very helpful to make copies of a recent picture and take them to the shelters. Sometimes, owners describe an animal and the person hearing the description gets a different picture in their mind. Coming to the shelter is wise.

People are beginning to rely just on social media, and this is not a good idea. Walk or drive through your neighborhood several times each day, and ask mailmen, delivery people, and anyone you see if they have seen your pet.

Most veterinary clinics will allow notices about lost pets to be placed on a bulletin board. Place advertisements in local newspapers and with radio stations. Include a lot of information about your pet, including age, sex, size, breed, and color. It is sometimes wise to leave out one identifying feature so if someone calls claiming to have found your pet, you would be able to spot calls from people who merely seek a monetary reward.

A reward for finding a returning a lost animal is always a good idea, and should be included on all notices and advertisements.

Life as a stray animal is not pleasant, and owners need to be diligent in doing everything they can to search for their pet and bring them safely home.

Mocha Mugs

To a pottery collector, a "mocha mug" isn't meant for a coffee drink. "Mocha" is a type of decorated earthenware pottery made in England and sold in America in the early 1800s. Mocha pottery, or mocha ware, is usually utilitarian; pieces were originally used in the kitchen or during meals. It has colorful decorations painted in a slip glaze made from clay thinned with water to a liquid consistency. The decorations are usually painted over white glaze.

Traditional patterns have descriptive names, like "banded," "checked" and "marbled," or repeated "tulip," "fan," "seaweed," "dendrite" or "leaf" motifs. Others have less obvious names, like "cat's-eye," which consists of clusters of dots, and "earthworm." or thick, mottled lines in waves or loops.

This mug, which was made about 1800 and sold for \$375 at Link Auction Galleries, has earthworm and cat's-eye patterns in its center section, with a green and brown banded top border and brown banded lower border.

The name "mocha" may come from some patterns' resemblance to mocha stone, another name for moss agate, an opaque multicolor semiprecious stone. Mocha pottery may also be named for the coffee-colored glaze that appears in many designs.

itself. A handwritten letter is worth more than a typed letter with a handwritten signature. The content of the letter also affects the value. The letter must be seen by an expert to authenticate it. Contact an auction house or gallery that holds sales of autographs to see what it is worth.

TIP: Never display bottles with labels in a sunny window. The labels will fade.



City holds groundbreaking for new housing development

Mayor Alonzo Jones and other members of the Danville City Council joined city government staff and local developers today to celebrate the groundbreaking of the first large-scale Monument Berryman Redevelopment Area Plan project. The event marked a significant milestone in ongoing efforts to address pressing housing challenges facing the community.

"We are dedicated to meeting the needs of both our current and future residents, whether it be through rental housing, homeownership opportunities for first-time buyers, or accommodations for those seeking larger or newer residences," Jones said.

The forthcoming residential development will comprise a total of 34 townhomes and 60 market-rate apartments, offering comfortable and contemporary living options for individuals and families alike.

The developer, CCKW LLC, will kick off the nearly \$14 million project by constructing eight townhomes at the corner of Cabell and Monument streets. Two of the townhouses already have contracts with two more pending. The units will be around 1,500 square feet and feature three bedrooms and three bathrooms, a living room, kitchen, and back patio. Designer cabinets in the kitchen and bathroom, luxury

vinyl plank flooring, drywall walls, designer cabinets and stainless-steel appliances will make these units high quality with modern conveniences. The homes are priced in the low \$270,000s.

In subsequent phases, 10 townhomes will be built on Monument and Shelton streets, followed by eight more townhomes on Monument Street and 60 market-rate apartments in three, two-story buildings on the block bounded by Monument, Cabell, Shelton and Beaureguard streets. In the final phase, the remaining eight townhomes will be built on Cabell and Beauregard streets.

The apartments will have one, two, or three bedrooms and two bathrooms. Rents will start from \$1,100 with 12 units available earning 50% to 80% of the area median income.

Susan McCulloch, division director of Housing & Development for the City of Danville, said the buildings will embrace the aesthetics of the nearby River District while incorporating complementary, modern design elements.

"We are very excited to see new construction in the Monument Street and Berryman Avenue area," McCulloch said. "CCKW has been working on refining its project and the product is providing urgently needed townhomes and multifamily homes. We appreciate CCKW's new development adjacent to the River District."

Steven Gould, an attorney with PLDR Law who represents CCKW, thanked the City Council and city staff for their vision in seeing the potential in the Monument-Berryman area. He also thanked the residents in the neighborhood.

"On behalf of the CCKW team, I want to extend thanks to our current neighbors in the Monument-Berryman area who have been so welcoming," Gould said. "This is a great community now, and what CCKW hopes to do is build upon that."

City officials and staff see the Monument-Berryman area as a potential anchor community because of its walkability and proximity to the River District, which has seen significant growth over the past 13 years with over \$300 million invested by the public and private sectors. Buildings once vacant in the River District now have a new life as living spaces and as places to eat and gather with friends.

The redevelopment of the Monument Street and Berryman Avenue area represents the culmination of years of work conducted by the city's blight eradication program. Parcels were acquired with the intention of neighborhood stabilization and new development. The majority of the parcels were acquired by the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority for this program. In 2022, the city issued a request for redevelopment proposals for the area. The development plan proposed by CCKW LLC was chosen from this process.



You Know Better, Right?

A retiree fell for a scam that drained his account Scrap: Appliances, Mowers, Scrap Metal of all his savings. It took a lifetime to save the money and only a minute for it to vanish. All it took was him giving information to a scammer.

The gentleman received an email saying he was owed a refund and asked that he fill in his banking details. He believed that email was from his bank. Within moments of sending the email, his account was emptied. Not only that, but he was then instructed on the phone, by someone he believed was a bank security officer, to hand over his credit cards to a bank courier because those accounts were also compromised.

The scammer quickly went on a spending spree. It's rare, but the criminal was actually caught. While he might get a few years in jail, the victim has been left to try to pick up the pieces of his life, with no hope of getting that money back.

Some basic hints for safety:

If you're uneasy about any portion of a call, HANG UP.

Don't do banking on your phone or computer, even if you know what you're doing with those devices.

If you get a call from someone claiming to be at your bank, hang up. Dial the number of the bank yourself and find out if they were actually looking for you. Especially do not follow their instructions if the "security" people at your bank insist you need to transfer your money into a different account to keep it "safe."

If you're asked to call *72 followed by a different number, HANG UP. Do not dial *72. It's a call forwarding option that prisoners, callers to 900 sex line numbers and people in foreign counties use as a way to charge expensive calls to your phone.

Don't panic if you suspect you have a scammer on the line. Just hang up.

Expanded PACT Act

Expanded benefits for the PACT Act have kicked in years sooner than expected. As of recently, March 5, 2024, veterans who were exposed to toxins can get VA health care without applying for VA disability benefits first.

The PACT Act covers over 20 presumptive illnesses for exposure to Agent Orange and other toxins, as well as the burn pits, radiation, oil well fires, depleted uranium and more. The covered illnesses include emphysema, chronic bronchitis, a dozen types of cancer and interstitial lung disease.

Deployment wasn't necessary; veterans were exposed to asbestos, firefighting foam, paints, chemicals, pesticides, Camp Lejeune water and more here in the U.S.

If you filed before and were turned down, file again or call. The VA is supposed to go through the files and contact you, but don't wait on that.

If you're already enrolled in VA health care, call your local VA health facility and ask for your initial screening for toxin exposure. Don't wait on this; get a baseline test.

To get more information, call 800-698-2411 (800-MYVA411).

Or go online to VA.gov/PACT and scroll through the information. You'll find links to file for VA disability, a supplemental claim and more. Read about military exposures at www. publichealth.va.gov/exposures.

For all the millions the VA has spent to inform veterans about PACT, there are some they're leaving out: members of the Maine National Guard who trained at the Canadian military support base in Gagetown, New Brunswick, Canada. In 1966 and 1967, the place was saturated with Agents Orange and Purple as a means of testing effectiveness in killing foliage.

In 2005, the Canadian government did site testing of the ground, water and air. They ended up handing out money to Canadians who'd been there.

Gagetown is still used for National Guard training, not only for units from Maine but other states as well. People became ill, of course, from exposure, but they're not eligible for VA health care for exposure to Agent Orange or any of the other "rainbow" of toxin colors at Gagetown.





Best St. Patrick's Day Sugar **Cookie Bars**



Ingredients

For the cookie bars

- 1 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 2 cups granulated sugar
- 4 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ½ teaspoon almond extract
- 1 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon baking soda
- 5 cups all purpose flour

For the buttercream

- 1 cup unsalted butter, softened 4 cups powdered sugar or 16 ounces 1/4 cup heavy whipping cream or 3 table-
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Instructions

spoons milk

For the cookie bars

Grease a sheet pan (about 12x17) and set aside. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar on medium speed. Add eggs one at a time. Then scrape down sides of bowl and add both vanilla and almond extract; mix well. In a medium bowl, whisk together salt, baking soda, and flour. Then slowly add to the butter/sugar mixture until just combined. Press dough evenly into the prepared sheet pan. Bake at 375° for 15 minutes or until very lightly golden. Remove from oven and set aside to cool.

For the buttercream

Beat softened butter on medium speed with an electric mixer or stand mixer. Beat for 3 minutes until smooth and creamy.

Add powdered sugar, cream, and vanilla extract with the mixer running on low. Increase to high speed and beat for 3 minutes. If the frosting is too thick, you can add a little more cream. Just add one tablespoon at a time, then mix thoroughly until you get the consistency you like.

Add green food coloring gel until you get the color you like. Add a little bit of yellow food coloring gel if you want to. Frost the giant cookie once cooled by plopping it all on. Spread it evenly and top with St Patrick's Day green sprinkles. Cut into squares, serve, and enjoy! Store covered at room temperature for 24 hours, then in the refrigerator for up to 5 days.
