





The Ranch


A New York family bought a ranch out West where they intended to raise cattle. Friends came to visit and asked if the ranch had a name.

"So far, none have survived the branding."



Last week, I was in a doctor's waiting room. A man stood in front of me and showed me pictures of a dog that they had had for eleven years. The pictures were both heartwarming and heartbreaking; they were taken during the last few moments of the dog's life as his family was saying good-bye to their beloved member.

As he walked away, I thought that his dog had enjoyed the kind of life we wish all dogs (and cats, birds, ferrets, rabbits, on and on) could enjoy. Sadly, that is not the case.

While some people provide perfect homes, others provide adequate homes, and others provide less-thanadequate homes. The law in Virginia is quite specific about the responsibilities of the owners to their animals.

There are two basic responsibilities not mentioned in the Code; however, my guess is that every shelter employee would agree with them. Of course, we wish that a law could be passed that required the spaying and neutering of each dog and cat!

First, it would be nice if the owner of every dog vaccinated the dog against parovirus. This is a deadly disease that is easily preventable. Shelters would have a much easier time if mother dogs had been vaccinated. The immunity is passed through her milk. Puppies are always more at risk than adult dogs and if they had not been nursed by a vaccinated mother, the risk is always greater.

Canine parvovirus is a highly contagious disease that is spread from dog to dog by contact (whether direct or indirector) through feces. Mortality in untreated cases is approximately 90%. The symptoms include lethargy, loss of weight and appetite, vomiting, and then diarrhea (usually bloody). The virus can live in the ground for about six months.

Treatment is expensive and not guaranteed to have a positive outcome. When puppies or dogs come into a shelter, they may not have any symptoms and can lead to an outbreak of parvovirus.

The feline version is panleukopenia and it is just as deadly for cats.

An outbreak of either canine or feline parvovirus is every shelter's nightmare.

Second, if would be nice if the owner of every dog and cat microchipped them and then keeps the registration current.

The best way to reunite a stray dog or cat that you find is to take them to the public shelter in that locality. Relying solely on social media is not a good idea. Shelters scan for microchips and then call the company to get the owner's name and contact information. We just absolutely love it when a microchip is found, the registration is current, and the animal goes home! An added bonus is that shelters can make sure that a rabies vaccination is also current.

As a service to the community and through the generosity of the John and Elizabeth Hall Animal Rescue Fund, we are once again offering a free microchip event at the shelter on Saturday, March 23rd, from 11 a.m. – 1 p.m. for residents of Danville and Pittsylvania County. There will be a limit of two per household and people will be asked to sign a statement that the animal is theirs and will remain theirs.

The Bonhams Skinner auction where this chair sold listed it as a Harvard University Windsor chair, bringing together two icons of colonial America. Harvard University, originally called the New College, was founded in Cambridge, Massachusetts, in 1636, making it the oldest college in the United States. This means that Harvard predates the Windsor chair in America.

The first Windsor chairs were made in England in the seventeenth century, and they were being made in Philadelphia by the 1730s. There were many variations on the Windsor chair, especially in America.

American designers were the first to add rockers and writing arms to Windsor chairs. The chair can be made in many shapes, and they can be easily distinguished by the shape of the chair's back.

No matter the style, a Windsor chair can be recognized by its spindle back, turned legs and stretcher base. They are made with stick-and-socket construction, meaning the chairs are built by inserting the legs and the back spindles into holes in the seat. Windsor chairs and similar styles are also called "stick furniture."

TIP: Examine a piece of furniture and look for unexplained holes, stains and fade marks. They may indicate a fake or repair.



City manager submits proposed budget

City Manager Ken Larking tonight submitted to the City Council a proposed budget that continues the efforts in recent years to enhance job opportunities, reduce crime, and improve education, as well as revitalize neighborhoods and create additional housing options. As a result of these strategic efforts, Larking said the city, for the first time in many years, is experiencing growth.

"Because we are an isolated city, we cannot rely on the expansion of a major metro area into Danville to bring growth and opportunity," Larking stated in his budget message to the City Council. "We need to build it for ourselves with the help of key partnerships, creativity, tough decisions, and hard work."

He added, "If we are to continue and accelerate the positive momentum, we need to continue to provide quality services, invest in our neighborhoods, support the school system, attract business development, build a skilled workforce, and keep our community safe."

Though the city is experiencing growth, Larking said there are still residents who have not fully participated in the economic opportunities that have been brought to the city.

"We need to be intentional about encouraging more economic opportunities and providing pathways for people to have the skills and abilities to take advantage of these opportunities," he said. Also, in his presentation of the proposed budget to the City Council, Larking said the city needs to continue to take steps to create an environment that will encourage young people to stay in Danville or return one day.

"The theme of this year's budget is in keeping with our brand that 'Danville is home' and 'home is here," Larking said. "The investments that we have been making and will continue to make are helping to make it possible for our young people to have a good job, a home they can afford, and a quality of life that they seek. We are in a global competition for talent, and if do not provide these things, then we are going to lose them. The best thing that we can do for our young people is make Danville a place they want to call home."

Key budget numbers

The proposed budget provides for a 10-cent decrease in the personal property tax rate. Also, the recommended budget includes added elderly tax relief on real estate and mobile homes by increasing the threshold from \$35,000 to \$40,000.

The real estate tax rate would remain at 84 cents per \$100 value, which is the third-lowest rate among cities in Virginia.

No increase in utility rates and utility fees is proposed.

The budget includes the establishment of a short-term rental fee and increases in fees for Planning Commission and zoning, inspections, solid waste, and cemetery services.

The total recommended budget for the next fiscal year is \$347.8 million for operations, capital and debt service. This total is 7 percent or \$22.7 million more than the current fiscal year's budget of \$325.1 million.

The proposed budget is a working draft for the next fiscal year, which begins July 1. The City Council will hold public hearings in May and June prior to adopting a budget. Final adoption is scheduled for June 18, but must take place no later than June 30.

Revenue forecasts

Larking told the City Council that the proposed budget includes \$25 million in gaming tax revenue from the casino. That figure is a \$12 million increase from the current budget year. Caesars has been operating a temporary casino since May. The permanent Caesars Virginia casino resort project is expected to be completed in late 2024. Other revenue forecasts also are favorable as compared to last year, Larking said. Those increases include:

- \$3.2 million real estate taxes
- \$1.8 million personal property taxes
- \$1.2 million interest earnings
- \$842,000 business licenses
- \bullet \$701,000 delinquent real estate and personal property tax revenue
- \$700,000 sales tax

Expenditure highlights

Of the \$25 million expected gaming tax revenue from Caesars, \$16.3 million is state-collected gaming tax revenue and \$8.7 million is the local supplement that Caesars Virginia agreed to pay as part of the development agreement with the City. This agreement includes a minimum payment to the City equal to \$5 million per year. Most of this guaranteed payment will go toward the cost of an average of 5 percent pay for performance increase for City employees, the local portion of pay increases for Danville Public School employees, and increased health insurance costs for both City and school system employees. This budget recommends using the remaining \$20 million of gaming tax revenues to pay for activities recommended in the 2024 Investing



in Danville Committee report. This includes the following:

- \$7.8 million for capital and special projects.
- \$5.2 million for economic development initiatives.
- \$2 million to put in reserve for a future balloon payment on an Industrial Development Authority loan, which was used to finance economic development projects in FY2022 and FY2023 in anticipation of future casino revenues.
- \$1.5 million for lease and debt payments associated with the new police headquarters.
- \$1.25 million to Danville Public Schools for school bus aids, elementary school security, and early tuition costs.
- \$788,800 for the tourism marketing program.
- \$700,000 for removal of blight.
- \$526,630 to pay for gang prevention efforts previously funded mostly with grant funds.
- \$91,350 to pay for a grant administrator.
- \$97,916 to pay for new parks maintenance positions necessary to help maintain the Riverfront Park and three new splash pads.
- \$40,000 for the summer internship program.

The recommended budget provides funding for school operations in the amount of \$27.84 million – an increase of \$2.48 million.

The proposed budget provides funds for the pay-for-performance system for employee raises, rising health care costs, and an increase in retirement contributions. As proposed, 11 new positions will be created, and seven existing positions will be reclassified. In addition, the budget funds a career development plan for the Juvenile Detention Center that will help with employee retention.

Odds & Ends

Remain calm

He's currently the number two record-holder, having recently won a title for using his head to bounce a soccer ball into a trash can 52 feet and 5.9 inches away. Rush says he's aiming to win a new record each and every week.

Die-hard movie buffs are celebrating a flick that was just released—for a second time. It made its first debut just about a hundred years ago featuring that femme fatale of the day, Miss Clara Bow. The film, The Pill Pounder, made its debut in 1923 and then was lost. Gary Huggins of Kansas City found it recently at an antique film fest in Omaha, NE when he purchased a stack of oldies for twenty bucks. He told reporters that "a distributor that had been in Omaha for decades had gone out of business a while ago and this auction house had some of their films. It was the best 20 dollars I've ever invested, for sure."







- * Have stubborn stains in the toilet? Put some teeth in your cleaning job by dropping in a denture-cleaning tablet and letting it sit overnight. In the morning, scrub and flush. It just might do the job.
- * "Lighten blemish spots on your skin with lemon juice. Just dab on several times per day." -- O.M. in Georgia
- * "Collect small bits of soap into a cup or jar. When you have several, add a tablespoon or two of water to the cup to soften the soap pieces. When they are moderately soft, pour out the contents on a washcloth, fold it over and press into a bar shape with your hands. - 2. The Lovin' Spoonful, in 1966. The group's name came from Mississippi John Hurt's "Coffee Blues."
- 3. "Beatles '65," released in 1964. Over the years there have been posters and T-shirts using that image. Originals can be worth quite a bit. 4. "Denise," in 1963.
- 5. "Kokomo," by the Beach Boys, in 1988. Even though the song topped the charts in the U.S. and other countries, it can't seem to get rid of the negative reviews coming from music critics. The only ones to like it have

Best Carrot Cake For Easter



Ingredients

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 tsp. baking soda
- 1/2 tsp. table salt
- 2 tsp. ground cinnamon
- 3 large eggs
- 2 cups granualted sugar
- 3/4 cup vegetable oil
- 3/4 cup buttermilk
- 2 tsp. vanilla extract
- 2 cups grated carrot
- 1 (8-oz.) can crushed pineapple, drained
- 3 1/2 oz. flaked coconut
- 1 cup chopped pecans or walnuts

Buttermilk Glaze

Cream Cheese Frosting

Directions

Line pans:

Preheat oven to 350°F. Line 3 (9-inch) round cake pans with parchment paper; lightly grease and flour parchment paper. Set pans aside.

Combine dry ingredients:

Stir together first 4 ingredients—flour, baking soda, salt, and cinnamon.

Make batter:

Beat eggs and next 4 ingredients at medium speed with an electric mixer until smooth. Add flour mixture, beating at low speed until blended. Fold in carrot and next 3 ingredients.

Pour batter into prepared cake pans.

Bake, glaze, and frost:

Bake at 350°F for 25 to 30 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out

Drizzle Buttermilk Glaze evenly over layers; cool in pans on wire racks 15 minutes.

Remove from pans, and cool completely on wire racks.

Spread Cream Cheese Frosting between layers and on top and sides of cake.

Buttermilk Glaze

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1/2 cup buttermilk
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine
- 1 tablespoon light corn syrup 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Directions

Bring first 5 ingredients to a boil in a large Dutch oven over medium-high heat. Boil, stirring often, 4 minutes. Remove from heat, and stir in vanilla.

Cream Cheese Icing

- 1/2 cup butter or margarine, softened 11 ounces cream cheese, softened (about a block and a half)
- 1 (16-ounce) package powdered sugar
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract

Directions

Beat butter and cream cheese at medium speed with an electric mixer until creamy.

Add powdered sugar and vanilla extract; beat at high speed 10 seconds or until smooth.




