#### Parks Open on April 5

ROGERSVILLE-The Lauderdale County Commission will be opening the two countymaintained parks for the season on Friday. April 5. Those are Wheeler Campground (on Alabama 101 near Wheeler Dam) and Brush Creek Park (on Lauderdale 14 near Waterloo).

Due to traffic concerns on Alabama 101, the commission will continue our practice of taking reservations at the Wheeler Campground during the first weekend the park is open, April 5-7. Anyone wishing to camp at the park during the first weekend MUST call the Solid Waste office and make reservations.

This is ONLY for the opening weekend. The campsites will be on a "first come basis" after the April 5 weekend.

The Solid Waste office will start accepting reservations for the opening weekend at Wheeler Campground on April 3. Call 256-760-5878 M-F from 8am-4pm.

Also, individuals

may reserve ONLY ONE campsite. No one can reserve multiple campsites.

Payment for the opening weekend must be made to the Wheeler Campground attendants by 4pm on April 5. If payment for the reserved campsite is not made by that time, the reservation will be released.

The Wheeler Campgrounds have water and electric hooks and a dumping station. The cost of \$15 per night and \$10 per night for senior citizens.

Brush Creek Park features primitive camping areas and pad camping (for RVs and pull campers) with water hookups only. There is a dumping station at the

This year, there will be a \$10 per night fee for campers using the pad camping area.

As in the past, the length of camping stays for Wheeler Campground and Brush Creek Park will be limited to a maximum of 14 days. Campers staying the maximum length of stay much leave the park for 10 days before returning.

Stays for tent camping is limited to a maximum of 10 days, then they must leave the park for seven days before returning.

'Our parks continue to have a lot of interest from the public, we want to ensure that as many people as want to will have a chance to enjoy our two parks and campgrounds," said Tom Smith, manager of the Lauderdale County Solid Waste Department, which oversees the parks. "In the past, we have had to turn some people away, because some campers want to spend several weeks at the campgrounds. We had some who wanted to take up residence at the parks. That's not what they are for. Limiting the camping days will offer more people the chance to enjoy our parks."



She married Rev. Thomas Donley Tuscumbia in 1867. The 1910 census reports she had 11 children with 7 surviving. Her husband, Thomas, died in a hunting accident. In 1920 Delia was listed as living in the Porter Donley household (one of her surviving sons) listed as widow and 'Grandmother'.

According Theto Star. American Tuscumbia based African newspaper American by Professor edited Washington George Trenholm, and the newspaper of the Muscle Shoals Black Missionary Baptist Association, Delia was a member of the Mosaic Templars of America (MTA). The MTA was an African fraternal American organization and was active in numerous church and community events. The organization led praise services (July, including preparation of a surprise dinner for her brother, Rush Watkins on his marriage to Rose Bonner (Feb 1906) after his first wife, Bertha B. Watkins' passing some prior. Rush and Bertha B. Watkins' children were Maria (Mariah) Watkins, Robert Watkins, Letha Watkins, Thomas Watkins, Minna Watkins, Luvinia Watkins, and Ellen Watkins.

Delia died sometime hetween 1910-1920, although the precise date

is unknown. Bertha B. Watkins had been deeded approximately five acres of land by Ella W. Thornton in her Last Will and Testament for "services" rendered." The relationship with the Dr. G.W. Thornton family included Virginia, Tennessee, and Alabama. Bertha subsequently bequeathed the land and home to Rush Watkins.



These pests are attracted to carbon dioxide and can detect even trace amounts of this gas animals naturally exhale when breathing. 

ast week. I saw a brief clip of Harrison Butker's interview on EWTN talking about the responsibility men have to society. EWTN (Eternal World Television Network) is based





## Common Problem

This week I spoke with a very nice gentleman who was disappointed with my opinion of his case. He felt as if the legal system was in some way broken. It's not, but it's the way it is for a reason.

Here's what we're talking about. This gentleman had worked in a well-respected industry and was living off of his social security. He had a wreck that was not his fault. Money was tight and he did not go to the hospital or a doctor. He did not go to a chiropractor or a nurse practitioner.

He toughed it out for over a year. He cut back on his activities and struggled to make himself comfortable. After 14 months he sees a doctor for the first time and gets an MRI. The gentleman then discovers that he has a herniated disc.

I believe the man is telling the truth. He had no medical history prior to the accident because he didn't go to the doctor. If he had seen a doctor on a regular basis for yearly check-ups, we would know that he probably had a good back or at least he hadn't complained about it.

I tried a case in Huntsville for a very nice lady whose first complaint of shoulder pain was four months after the accident. She didn't complain about her shoulder to the ambulance crew or to the emergency room. She didn't mention it to her doctor nine days after the accident. She had shoulder surgery, and I valued that case between \$65,000.00 and \$75,000.00 for a variety of reasons personal to her case such as how likable she was, how provably honest she was and the poor result she got from the surgery. The jury gave me \$6,500.00. Not \$65,000.00. When I interviewed the jury after the trial, they felt that because she was so active with no complaints for four months, she could have injured her shoulder in one of the many activities she engaged in.

The legal reality is that a doctor has to say that the accident more likely than not or "probably" caused the injury that you are seeking compensation for. We've seen cases where people believe their cancer came out of remission or they're concerned that perhaps their ability to reproduce has been compromised. Without a doctor's opinion, you don't win. Without documentation of treatment, your case isn't what it would have been. If you're not hurt, don't say you are. If you are hurt, go tell the doctor.



and a resume gathering dust, see an ad for "Social Media Influencer for Kittens." (They are not always this obvious. Sometimes it's an ad for house cleaning that pays \$1500 per week. Regardless. the pay is usually outrageous, the work sounds like a dream, and all you have to do is send over a copy of your driver's license "for verification purposes." Red flag alert! Because the only verification

happening here is whether you're gullible enough to fall for their scheme.

Here's the thing, folks: If a iob ad promises vou a sixfigure salary for cuddling kittens, run for the hills (or at least close the browser window). Remember, legitimate companies don't need your social security number to interview you.

So, how do you avoid becoming a victim of these resume-robbing rogues? Here that seems too strange to be are a few tips:

• If it sounds too good to **be true, it probably is.** Don't let desperation cloud your judgment. A job that pays a king's ransom for minimal effort is about as real as a unicorn with a social media following.

 Do your research. Look up the company before sending over your resume. A quick Google search can save you a world of identity theft headaches.

 Never send over sensitive information through email. Legitimate companies will have a secure application process on their website.

• Trust your gut. If something feels fishy, it probably is. Don't be afraid to walk away from a job offer true.

Remember, job hunting can be tough, but don't let scammers make it any tougher. Keep your wits about you, and the only thing you'll be "influencing" is your bank account with a real, honestto-goodness job. And who knows, maybe then you can finally afford some real food, not just ramen noodles. Now that's a dream job we can all get behind!





#### IT'S A TOUGH SITUATION FOR BOTH OF YOU


Dear Dave,



## **Medicare Minute** "Physician Charges'

There are three ways your doctor can be paid if you are on Medicare. The three ways are through Medicare assignment, Medicare excess charges or by not taking Medicare at all. Today we will discuss these three methods.

The most common way a physician gets paid is by Medicare assignment. These physicians are called "participating doctors". After the Part B deductible of \$240 is met, participating doctors will accept the Medicare approved amount for their services. These doctors charge Medicare 80% and the beneficiary 20% of the cost of the benefit. For example, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, and you would be responsible for the other 20%, or \$20.

A "non-participating doctor" can choose to accept or not accept Medicare assignment. If the doctor does not accept Medicare assignment you may have to pay an additional 15% of the cost of the service the doctor provided. This is call a Medicare excess charge. It means you would be responsible for 35% of the Medicare reduced amount instead of 20%. If we follow the example in the previous paragraph, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, but you would be responsible for 35%, or \$35.

Doctors who opt out of Medicare can charge whatever they want for their services and you are responsible of 100% of the cost. The majority of doctors in north Alabama accept Medicare, so you won't be faced with this situation very often.

Most people who have Medicare also have a supplemental policy that helps cover the 20% Medicare doesn't cover. If you are just entering Medicare and would like to know which policies cover what Medicare doesn't pay, you can contact our office for more information.


