

Two Beaches, a Carousel and Michigan's Largest Splash Pad -Lots of fun below the bluff!

In addition to the action downtown, extra fun awaits you just below the bluff! Start out at the Silver Beach Center which houses the Curious Kids' Discovery Zone (curiouskidsmuseum.org) and the Silver Beach Carousel. Enjoy hands-on exhibits, Carousel rides, local history exhibits and more. The Shadowland on Silver Beach (shadowlandonsilverbeach. com) is also located here, offering a perfect venue for weddings and other events. Silver Beach Carousel will be open varying days and hours this summer. Be sure to check out silverbeachcarousel.com for updated information and birthday party options.

Just across the street is the Whirlpool Compass Fountain boasting Michigan's largest splash pad. Guests of all ages can enjoy splashing through the fountain and be in awe of the cannons that shoot water 35 feet into the air. Next to the fountain, grab a bite to eat or a schooner at a local favorite - Silver Beach Pizza. The Amtrak station is located here as well for a convenient pick-up/drop-off location for travelers.

Looking for a great place to gather with friends on the lake? Silver Beach was named the "Sweetest Sand" by Timeout Chicago. com and "Best Family Beaches" by Parenting Magazine. This is a great place to spend the day in the sun, enjoy walking the shore, and relaxing. Other area beaches include Lions Park Beach, Tiscornia Park and Jean Klock Park. All of these locations offer restrooms and changing facilities as well as paid parking.

In addition to the sandy fun on the beaches, be sure to grab a lawn seat at the nearby Shadowland Pavilion. This space is the perfect venue for musical events and can be reserved for weddings, family reunions and other special events. Stunning views of the sunset, lighthouse and passing boats make this a great place for hosting events.



- The concrete inner splash pad is 150 feet in diameter
- The outer ring of the splash pad is 200 feet in diameter
- The fountain offers 28 varying water jet heights
- The water jets supply 785 gallons of water per minute
- Spray from the cannons shoots 35-ft up in the air
- The cannons supply 2,560 gallons of water per minute
- The water reservoir holds 10,860 gallons of recycled water



The Art and Music Scene

There is every type of art imaginable throughout the city of St. Joseph. A walking tour is the best way to take it all in.

Start at the Krasl Art Center where you can browse the wonderful sculpture collection, special exhibits and shop in their gift shop. A great weekend for art is July 13-14 during the Krasl Art Fair on the Bluff. The Krasl Art Fair has been rated among the top art fairs in the country; ranked #10 in the nation by Sunshine Artist Magazine, #32 by the Art Fair Sourcebook and #6 by the Art Fair Calendar. There will be a variety of artists featuring a mix of fine art and fine crafts.

As you stroll through downtown St. Joseph, MI be sure to keep an eye out for gorgeous murals.

Currently the town boasts 3 mu-

rals, plus one in the Benton Harbor Arts District, and is excited to bring a temporary mural to the Lake Bluff stairs this year starting in early summer.

On Main Street, the Priscilla U. Byrns Center serves as home to the Heritage Museum and Cultural Center and offers a state-of-theart setting for your trip to the past. The center houses exhibit halls, artifact and archival collections, a research library, and elegant banquet facilities.

Visit the galleries and artist studios housed at The Box Factory for the Arts. Every year they host the Michiana Annual Art Competition Exhibit, catch this year's event May 17-July 7.

The summer brings back two free weekly concert series, the Wednesday Brown Bag Concerts (July 17-August 28) from 12:00pm-1:00pm and the Friday Night Concerts (July 19-August 30) from 7:00pm-8:00pm. Both series are held at the John E.N. Howard Bandshell, overlooking the charming St. Joseph River. For more details visit stjoetoday.com/brownbagconcerts and stjoetoday. com/fridaynightconcerts.

Enjoy concerts performed this summer by the Southwest Michigan Symphony Orchestra (SMSO). The Orchestra will perform at its annual Salute to America concert at the Shadowland on Silver Beach on July 3 with the City of St. Joseph fireworks closing out the event. A special family-friendly event featuring Peter and the Wolf will be held July 27 with two (2) performances held at Shadowland at Silver Beach. For more informa-

Sundays, as well as July 4 and Labor Day, are filled with music provided by the St. Joseph Municipal Band. Concerts take place at the John E.N. Howard Bandshell located on Port Street.
