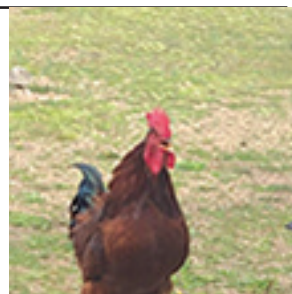

As of July 1st, declawing a cat will be illegal in Virginia. HB1354 was proposed by Delegate Marty Martinez, a Democrat in the 29th District. It passed the House in a 58-41 vote and passed the Senate in a 25-13 vote. It has now been signed into law by Governor Youngkin.

The summary as passed says [the bill] "makes unlawful the practice of declawing cats for any person engaged in the practice of veterinary medicine except as necessary for a therapeutic purposed, as defined in the bill."

Further, the now-law states "Therapeutic purpose" means any action intended to address an existing or recurring infection, disease, injury, or abnormal condition in an animal's claw, nail bed, or toe bone that jeopardizes the animal's health and for which addressing the infection, disease, injury, or abnormal condition is a medical necessity. "Therapeutic purpose" does not include any action performed for cosmetic or aesthetic reasons or reasons of convenience in the keeping or handling of a cat."

The declawing of a cat is not just a removal of the nails, but is an amputation of the first digit of the paw. While declawing the front claws is more common, some people declaw all four paws.

New York was the first state that banned this practice; that law was passed in 2019. Maryland was next in 2022. A few states are currently debating the issue.

Judging by online comments, the law is a very controversial one.

Some veterinarians believed that declawing can lead to problems with how cats walk and they say that sometimes (albeit, rarely) claws begin to grow back internally, causing pain. Other veterinarians say that they have never had an issue with their clients' declawed cats.

We suggest that if you adopt a kitten, you should start clipping their nails so they can be used to it.

Perfume Bottles

Perfume is always a popular Mother's Day gift. It combines luxury and sentiment and lasts much longer than a bouquet of flowers. Perfume bottles are often works of art in and of themselves, increasing their appeal. They are popular collectibles, whether they contain perfume or not.

Apple Cider Vinegar Is a Surprising Help for Blood in Urine



DEAR DR. ROACH: Recently, I had anal cancer and was treated with chemo and radiation.

The radiation burned my insides and severely damaged most of my internal organs. One of the aftereffects was occasional blood and small clots in my urine. A few months ago, both the frequency and amount of blood, especially the clots, increased dramatically. The size and number of the clots got so large that they blocked my urethra.

During a visit to my urologist, he looked into my bladder and declared it "angry." Then he told me the same thing every doctor has told me about every problem caused by my treatment: "It was caused by the radiation, and there is nothing that can be done."

Shortly after this, I began to take unfiltered apple cider vinegar in hopes that it would improve my digestive problems. It helped a little, but the big difference was that I have not had a single recurrence of either blood or clots in my urine. Can you tell me if this is due to the vinegar or if it is just a coincidence? -- A.G.

ANSWER: No, I can't definitively tell you whether the vinegar helped. It was probably by chance, but let me explain a little about it.

Rectal cancer is often treated with radiation, or combined chemotherapy and radiation, either prior to or after surgery. The dose of radiation is quite high compared to some other cancers, and the complications can be significant.

In addition to damage to the bowel and bladder, radiation treatment can damage the bones and bone marrow, leading to poor blood-cell production, infertility, premature menopause, and more cancer years later. On the other hand, radiation is used when it is expected to improve the cure rate of cancer. Still, the side effects can be challenging.

Hemorrhagic cystitis (bleeding from the bladder) can be caused by chemotherapy or radiation. It may start within a few months or as long as 20 years after radiation.

I am surprised your urologist did not offer any treatments, as there are certainly ones available. Although none of the currently available systemic drugs are proven to be very effective, hyperbaric oxygen is one treatment that is, at least, moderately effective. Medicines placed into the bladder and laser bladder treatments are sometimes tried as well.

I was unable to find any study that evaluated the effectiveness of apple cider vinegar. I am skeptical, but reports like yours of apparent improvement associated with its use might convince a researcher to conduct a study to determine whether it really is effective.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am presently taking 300 mg of gabapentin once daily for neuropathy, which had become increasingly severe with burning, itching, and pins and needles. It is helping, but not 100%. I still need ice packs at night for relief sometimes. Do you have any suggestions for alternative treatment? -- B.R.

ANSWER: Gabapentin is an effective drug for painful neuropathy, whether the cause is known or not. However, its side effect of sedation limits its use, and the medicine needs to be advanced slowly to be tolerated.

In my experience, 300 mg once daily is not adequate for most people, but 300 mg three times daily is effective for many. The recommended dose in one type of severe neuropathy, postherpetic neuralgia, is 1,200 mg three times daily. It may take months to be able to get to this dose.

I have also had some success with anti-inflammatory medicines as an adjunctive treatment.

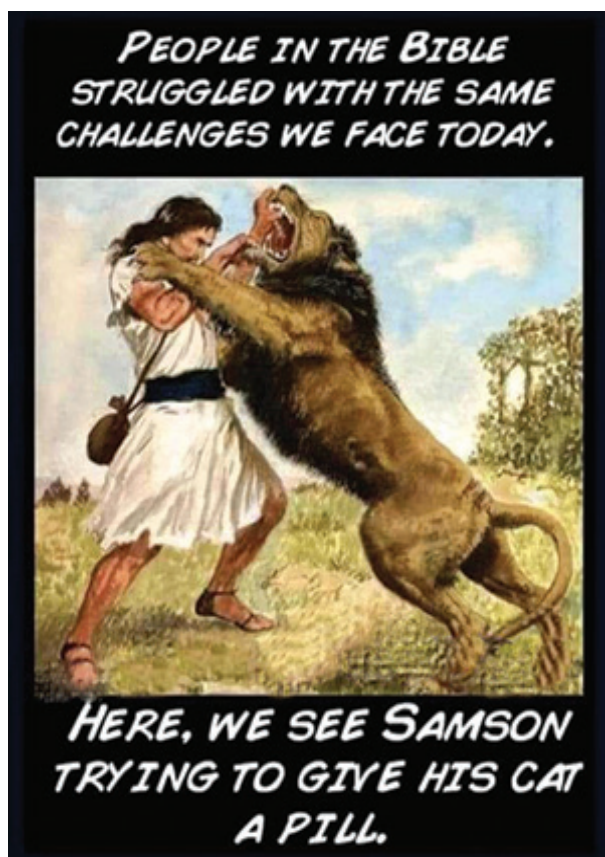

Strawberry Pound Cake



Ingredients

- Pound Cake
- 2½ cups fresh strawberry, hulled and finely chopped
 - 12 ounces unsalted butter, softened
 - 1¾ cups granulated sugar
 - 5 large eggs
 - 3 cups all-purpose flour
 - 1 teaspoon (6g) baking soda
 - 1 teaspoon (4g) baking powder
 - 1 teaspoon (5g) salt
 - ¾ cup (180g) sour cream
 - 1 teaspoon (5ml) strawberry extract or
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
 - 2-3 teaspoon red food coloring

Strawberry Glaze

- 2-3 tablespoons reserved strawberry puree
- 1 tablespoon lemon or strawberry extract
- ½ cup (60g) powdered sugar

Instructions

Add strawberries to a blender or food processor and blend until smooth.

Pour into a medium saucepan, bring to a boil over medium-high heat. As soon as it boils, reduce heat and simmer until the moisture evaporates from the strawberries. It should reduce by half. Reserve 2-3 tablespoons of strawberry puree for making the glaze. Let it cool completely while you make the batter for the cake. Preheat the oven to 300°F/150°C. Grease a tube pan generously with cooking spray and set aside.

Cream together the butter and sugar at high speed in a stand mixer until it’s fluffy and starts to look white, about 5-7 minutes.

Stir in the eggs, a little at a time, beating the mixture well between each addition.

Mix in flour, baking soda, baking powder, and salt into the batter.

Follow with sour cream, strawberry extract, and vanilla extract. Stir well until everything is fully combined. DO NOT over mix.

Fold in the pureed strawberries and 2-3 teaspoons of food coloring into the cake batter until completely mixed in. Scrape down the sides of the mixing bowl.

Pour batter into a greased cake pan. Tap pans on the work surface to eliminate any large air bubbles.

Bake at 300°F/150°C until a tester inserted into the center comes out clean, 60-70 minutes or more.

Transfer to a wire rack and let it cool before glazing.

Strawberry Glaze

In a medium bowl, add remaining pureed strawberries, lemon or strawberry extract, and powdered sugar, whisk together until smooth, adjust glaze consistency with more powdered sugar or milk.

Pour glaze over cake and serve immediately or let it cool before slicing. Enjoy!

Tips & Notes:

No bundt cake pan, no worries, just divide the cake batter between two well-greased loaf pans. And don’t get me started on what awesome cupcakes they’ll make for your kid’s party. If you’d like to freeze it, don’t glaze it, wrap it up good and tight with plastic wrap, then wrap it up again with aluminum foil, and freeze. When your sweet tooth is calling, allow it to thaw and come to room temperature, add the glaze, and enjoy.

This pound cake recipe makes the best strawberry shortcake. Instead of glazing it, top the slices with the strawberry puree with a little sugar and homemade whipped cream.

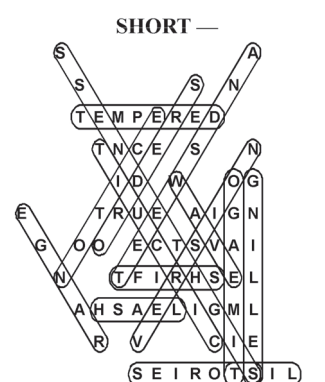
