Natalie Baggio to succeed Dr. Hamel at Corewell Health

Corewell Health is preparing for a passing of the leadership torch, as longtime President Dr. Loren Hamel retires at the end of June. Corewell announced today that the new regional president will be one of Hamel's lieutenants, Senior Vice President/Chief Operating Officer/ Chief Nursing Executive Natalie Baggio, RN.



Hamel, who headed the former Lakeland Health System, was one of the architects of the merger of Lakeland into Spectrum Health of Grand Rapids. That combination soon gathered additional health care entities and eventually effected a huge mberger with Detroit's Beaumont Health System, creating Corewell, now Michigan's largest health system.

The transition is now largely completed, and Hamel is retiring, turning over the health care reigns to Baggio, whose professional roots are in the nursing ranks.

Baggio is a resident of St. Joseph and has been working in Berrien County's arm of Lakeland/Spectrum/Corewell since 2017. She will continue to be headquartered here in the Twin Cities, according to Corewell spokesperson Gillian Conrad:



Love Makes Sense

Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth. 1 John 3:18

Writing a good sentence is an art form. You can master that art by developing an awareness of what makes a sentence work. To be sure, there are nuances to sentence structure that may take a lifetime to master, but there are also some essential elements. to every English sentence that even a toddler must master. One element that must be included in every sentence is the verb. The verb denotes action, occurrence, or existence. It is the verb that brings order and structure to what would otherwise be a collection of random and chaotic vocables. Without the verb, a sentence does not make sense and has no meaning. Even in simple sentences, the verb plays a crucial role. "See Jane." "See Jane run." "Run, Jane, run!" Without the verb, we wouldn't know what to do with Jane.

A sentence doesn't make sense without a verb, and a Christian doesn't either. Actions are essential in the life of a Christian. You can tell someone you love them every single day, but if you never show it, your words make no sense and have no meaning. Like a sentence that doesn't have a verb, the words "I love you," when not connected to an action, are only a collection of random and chaotic vocables. Without action, love is senseless sentimentality and a meaningless emotion.

If you want your love to make sense and have meaning, do what Jesus has already done. Jesus loved you not so that you would be simply lovable but so that you would be loving. Jesus loved you so that you would be a person of action; be a person who is engaged in works of service and is willing to make personal sacrifices.

Words are appropriate for making promises and commitments of love. But it is an action that brings meaning to those words. So, "Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth."



Dave Says Plug In or Promote from Within?

Dear Dave.

I own a small business with about 20 team members, and we're doing pretty well. Last year, we had revenues of about \$1.2 million and profits of \$250,000. How do I find leadership within my company that cares about the vision and value of my company enough to help me grow it to the next level? I have two people in mind here who have impressed me a lot in the last two years, and I'd like for one of them to take a step up in the company. I'd like for this person to also challenge me and help me grow as a leader. Troy

Dear Troy,

I want leaders on my team who aren't afraid to bring things to my attention. If there are things they feel I need to work on, or look at differently, I want them to let me know. I'm not perfect, that's for sure. And I've made plenty of mistakes during my 30-plus years in business. But when it comes right down to it, it's not their job to challenge me and help me grow. As a leader, that's on me. It's my responsibility to make sure I'm constantly challenging myself and growing as a leader and businessman.

Now, developing your team members and getting them to actually care and align with

your mission? That is part of your job. You don't want leaders within your organization who aren't aligned with what you're trying to accomplish. When that happens, you've got a leader working a J-O-B. And at that point, they're no longer a leader. They're just a boss. Leaders lead. They show the way, they encourage and they lead by example. A boss just tells people what to do.

Over the years, I've had more luck promoting from within than I have bringing in someone new and plugging them in. Maybe there's someone there who's smart, already showing potential and demonstrating they care about the place and your mission. That's someone you can tap on the shoulder and start to move in a leadership direction. That kind of person is already fired up and wired up, so take the bridle off them and give them a chance to run.

Here's an easy first step: Find a really good small-business and leadership book, buy three copies and start a series of study sessions with you and the two team members you mentioned earlier. Let them know you feel they have real leadership potential, then read through the chapters together and discuss one or two over a lunch each week. Open up the discussions, and just let them talk. After a few weeks of this, it'll start to become clear really fast if either one is suited for a bigger role in the company. It'll become the ultimate interview process.

Great question, Troy. Best of luck to you and your company as you take this next big step! Dave

Oh C'mon, How Is This a Baseball Column?

Not to be immodest, but I became aware the other day that someone felt my last column - about baseball players with names that are famous in other fields of endeavor - was pretty enjoyable. That someone was me, but still.

If you feel like that opening paragraph is some sort of lame attempt to soften you up for

yet another column like that one, you would be, as my big sister likes to say, keeeee-rect!

For starters, let's consider the daunting challenge of guys who don't merely have the same moniker as another athlete, but the same as a superstar, Hall-of-Fame athlete: Examples include:

Say "Bob Gibson" and baseball fans immediately think of the intimidating Hall-of Fame pitcher. But it takes the nerdiest of baseball nerds to think of the other Bob Gibson, also a hurler, whose 12-wins – in his entire career! come up juuuuust a bit short of HOF Bob's 251.

Bill Russell, the basketball player - maybe the greatest team player in any major sport, with 11 championship rings in 13 seasons kinda overshadows the baseball Bill Russell, who to his credit played a long time in the majors and made three All-Star teams.

Jim Brown is considered by some to be the greatest player in the history of the National Football League, and his feats will forever overshadow those of the handful of Jim Browns who

played baseball; although the best of those Jim Brown had a long and pretty decent career for the Chicago American Giants of the Negro National League.

Johnny Rutherford pitched for one season in the big leagues, 1952 if you're keeping score, and was perfectly average – 7 wins, 7 losses, a .500 record. The Johnny Rutherford that most people likely think of is - with three victories at the Indianapolis 500 – a darn sight better than average! (Personal anecdote: I was briefly a sports reporter for the Shelbyville (IN) News and was once lucky enough to use one of the paper's press passes to roam around the Indy Motor Speedway on Carburetion Day, which allowed me to get out on the track - on foot! - and take photos of drivers in their cars. Among my subjects was the great Johnny Rutherford.)

Terry Bradshaw's four Super Bowl rings with the Pittsburgh Steelers just couldn't be matched by baseball's Terry Bradshaw, who only got into 34 games in the mid-1990s.

league baseball, to nowhere near the acclaim of the boxer Joe Frazier.

You can define "Namesake" however you like (a person named like someone who came before, or the person who came first) and you'd still get the following: a Hall-of-Fame quarterback and obscure big-leaguer both named Jim Kelly; a renowned journalist and an unrenowned pitcher both named Mike Wallace; the lead singer of the multi-platinum band Coldplay and a journeyman hurler - still playing in 2024 - both named Chris Martin.

You'd also get an immortal Shakespeare character and a pitcher who may have been the inventor of the knuckleball, both named King Lear. Okay, okay, baseball's King got that tag as a nickname, but that's another story. Holy Just-Gota-Column-Idea! Keep your eyes on this space maybe that's next week's story!!

Galbraith explains that he wasn't necessarily 'looking' in New Buffalo. However, interesting ideas seem to 'find' him. And that's what happened when he met with Ben Holland, who owns the real estate involved in the project. Galbraith says Holland was looking for a food and beverage concept, and the pair immediately 'clicked' in their vision for the site. Initially, they chose a simpler Mexican-based concept, but soon turned their attention to a contemporary New American menu that will focus on tourists in season but be attractive to locals all year long

The restaurant will be called 'PostBoy'. Galbraith says, "Our team named the restaurant after the founder of New Buffalo Captain Wessel D. Whittaker's ship *Post Boy*, which in 1834 crashed ashore near where the town is found standing today. The 10,000-square-foot home of the new restaurant, which formerly housed a Subway and Keller Williams Realty office, is currently undergoing a dramatic transformation to draw inspiration from a mix of coastal and Danish aesthetics with retro touches that are both nostalgic and comforting."

Galbraith says that's the 'secret sauce' in how he creates restaurant concepts as well as menus: Take something that's familiar-like a flavor-that invokes positive nostalgia. Then present it with a 'twist' or a flair that challenges the customer but makes the experience fun. Familiar flavors, a little flair and some fun! Galbraith says it works almost every time and that formula will be his guide as he creates the menu for PostBoy in New Buffalo.

door space being transformed into a multi-purpose patio, both for outdoor seating and as a waiting area. Galbraith smiles as he describes an old postal truck that's being restored for the patio space and will offer shirts, hats, and other souvenirs tourists will love. During the busy summer season, guests will approach an outdoor host location, then follow a 'paver path' to their indoor or outdoor dinner seating.

Galbraith believes his focus on the total dining experience is something that sets his restaurants apart from many others. He says the old concept of 'fine dining' has been replaced by "chef driven but never pretentious—ever!" He is proud to have worked under several of Chicago's premier chefs in their signature restaurants. Places like Intro, Blackbird, BOKA, S.K.Y., Elske, Bellemore, and more.

But Galbraith knew he wanted to make his own way in the industry, and eventually to mentor others with similar dreams. At 39, he's now at a point where that's beginning to happen. And he credits his team for giving him the confidence and 'head space' to keep growing and moving forward. "Quite simply I'm very lucky to have an incredible staff and partners. Nothing I do comes from my sweat alone. It's really all the people around me that deserve a giant nod and applause."

Galbraith gives special thanks to two special business partners: his sister/partner Cheyenne Galbraith at Houndstooth and his wife/partner Gabrielle Galbraith at Anemel.




