Ingredients

- 6 large eggs
- 1/2 cup low-fat mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons whole-grain
- mustard

• Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

- 2 scallions (white and green), thinly sliced,
- 1 rib celery, minced, scant 1/2 cup
- 2 radishes, grated large on a box grater
- 8 romaine lettuce leaves
- 1 cup pea or other sprouts

Directions

1. Put the eggs in a saucepan with enough cold water to cover. Bring to a boil, cover, and remove from the heat. Set aside for 12 minutes. Drain the eggs and roll them between your palm and the counter to crack the shell, then peel under cool running water.

2. Dice the eggs. Combine the eggs with mayonnaise, mustard and season with the salt and pepper. Stir in the scallions, celery, and radish.

Divide the egg salad among the lettuce leaves, top with the sprouts and roll up. Serve 2 rolls per serving.

Deviled Eggs

Ingredients

Refrigerated

- 12 Eggs
- 1 Hot sauce (Optional)
- 1/4 cup Mayo
- 1 tsp Mustard, yellow
- 1 tsp Pickle juice





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- 2 tsp chopped Pickles
- 1 Paprika
- 1 Salt and black pepper
- 1 tsp Sugar
- 1 tsp White vinegar

Directions

1. Fill a large pot with enough water to cover the eggs, then bring to a boil. Using a slotted spoon gently lower the eggs into the boiling water. Cover and let simmer for 10 minutes.

2. Remove the eggs from the heat and run under cold water until completely cooled.

3. Peel the eggs, cut in half and scoop out the yolks into a medium bowl.

4. Add the mayo, mustard, pickles, pickle juice, sugar, vinegar, hot sauce and salt and pepper to taste, and mix with a fork until well combined.

4. Using a small spoon, fill each egg white half with a generous teaspoon of filling. Lightly sprinkle with paprika to garnish.

Egg and Cheese Bread Omelet

Ingredients

- 1 chopped Scallion
- 3 Eggs, large
- 1 Kosher salt
- 2 slices White bread
- 2 slices American cheese
- 1 tbsp Butter, unsalted

Directions

1. Combine the eggs, scallion and 1 tablespoon water in a small bowl and whisk to combine.







2. Heat the butter in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat until melted and starting to brown around the edges. 3.Add the egg mixture and swirl the pan to coat the bottom.



4. Working quickly, dip 1

slice of the bread in the eggs, then flip it and place close to one edge of the pan. Repeat with the remaining slice of bread, setting it across the pan from 2. the first bread slice (near the opposite edge) so they are in a straight line with eggs all around. Season with 3. a pinch salt.

5. Continue to cook the eggs until they are completely set on the bottom, 1 to 2 minutes.

6. Slide a large metal spatula under the bread slices and flip the whole omelet in one single motion.

7. Put the cheese on top of the omelet, covering the bread slices.

8. Using the spatula, fold one side of the omelet (but not the bread side) over the bread and cheese

followed by the other side. Then fold in half to form a sandwich and continue to cook until the bread on the bottom is golden brown, 1 to 2 minutes.

9. Flip and cook until the other side is golden brown, 1 to 2 minutes.

Oven Denver Omelet

Ingredients

- 8 large eggs
- 1/2 cup half-and-half cream
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 cup finely chopped fully cooked ham
- 1/4 cup finely chopped green pepper
- 1/4 cup finely chopped onion

Directions

 Preheat oven to 400°. In a large bowl, whisk eggs and cream. Stir in the cheese, ham, green pepper and onion. Pour into a greased 9-in. square baking dish.
Bake until the omelet is golden brown and the center is set, 25-30 minutes.

Sheet Pan Eggs

Ingredients

- 12 large eggs
- ¹/₂ cup heavy whipping cream
- 8 slices bacon



- 1 red bell pepper, chopped
- ¼ cup green onions, sliced
- salt and pepper to taste
- additional green onions for topping
- ¹/₂ cup spinach, chopped

Directions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit and prepare a sheet pan by spraying it with non-stick cooking spray and lining it with parchment paper then spraying it down with non-stick cooking spray again.
- 2. In a large bowl, whisk together the eggs and heavy whipping cream. Set aside.
- 3. Heat a skillet over medium high heat, cook the bacon until it has reached the desired doneness. Remove the bacon from the pan and set it on some paper towels to cool. Chop the cooled bacon into bits.
- 4. Remove most of the bacon grease from the pan, leave about 1 tablespoon. Add the chopped bell pepper to the pan and sauté until it is tender and just begins to brown.
- 5. Add the bacon bits, cooked bell pepper, green onions, spinach, and salt and pepper to the egg mixture. Whisk everything together.
- 6. Pour the egg mixture into the prepared pan and bake it for 12-15 minutes or until the eggs are thoroughly cooked through.
- 7. Remove from the oven, cut into sections and enjoy!

Breakfast Casserole

Ingredients

- 24 ounces frozen shredded potatoes
- salt and pepper
- 12 eggs
- 2 cup half and half
- 1 teaspoon season salt
- 1 1/2 cup cheddar cheese grated
- 1 1/2 cup pepper jack cheese grated

• 2 cup chopped ham Or your preferred meat. **Directions**

1. Grease a 9x13 inch pan. Add the frozen and shredded potatoes to the bottom of the pan. Sprinkle with salt and pepper.

2. In a large bowl, whisk the eggs together. Then add half and half, season salt, cheddar cheese, pepper jack, and chopped ham.

- 3. Pour over the top of the frozen potatoes. Cover with foil and refrigerate for 2 hours or overnight.
- 4. Bake uncovered at 350 degrees for 90 minutes.
- 5. Let rest for 10 minutes before serving.





Greetings Gardeners,

Last month at the Dale County Library a Lunch and Learn workshop Claybank Master Gardener Janet

Shinaberry

demonstrated the benefits of catching rainwater in large 80 gallon olive or pickle barrels. Why catch rainwater? If you live in an area that gets city water that has



chemicals like chlorine and fluoride in it, you will find your plants will not be as robust as with natural rainwater. The barrels are fitted with a spigot (with a gasket to prevent leakage) close to the bottom of the barrel where a bucket or gallon container can catch the water. The rainbarrel can be placed under the roof line of your home where water will drip into the barrel. We had a gutter placed under the roof edge to capture the rain and direct it into one of our rainbarrels. A screened cover plus a splash of Neem Oil mix prevents mosquitos from hatching in the water. Neem Oil is a natural, organic oil that is also a fungicide and insecticide, and will benefit your plants. One 16 oz bottle of Neem Oil will make 20 gallons of neem mix. enough to last for a couple years for a neighborhood garden. Another organic product that we use on our veggie plants is fish fertilizer, or fish emulsion, used for centuries to fertilize edible food plants and flowering plants. Most garden supply stores carry these products. After May's abundance of rainfall, your gardens will need a boost of organic fertilizer. Always follow the label's directions. The label is the law!

What to plant in June for our area? The Alabama Extension's SOW app recommends **basil**, **collards**, **corn**, **Mexican tarragon**, **okra**, **oregano**, **pumpkins**, **rosemary**, **southern peas and thyme**. Tomato and pepper plants should already be mature, but the high heat of summer may make these plants slow in fruiting. Providing afternoon shade may help prolong their production. The *Claybank Master Gardeners* meet on the 2nd Wednesday of the month at 11 AM at Hoppergrass Restaurant in Ozark, 129 East Ave., across from the new Three Scoops and Sandwich ice cream shop. Our May meeting will be on Wednesday June 12th. Come join us, we love new faces.
