Mission Accomplished! The Sixth and Final KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship at Harbor Shores was One to Remember

More than a decade ago, in 2011, Whirlpool Corp. and the PGA of America first came together to highlight Southwest Michigan through the KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship. Since then, this Championship has been played at Harbor Shores every other year (except for 2020, due to the pandemic). It has been a wildly successful ride, bringing international attention to Harbor Shores and Benton Harbor, Michigan. This past Memorial Day

weekend was the sixth and final KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship at Harbor Shores. This remarkable 13-year partnership between Whirlpool Corporation and the PGA of America has had a profound impact on the community, serving as the catalyst for the revitalization of the area and showcasing Southwest Michigan as a great place to work, live and play, attracting residents and visitors from all over the world.

Over the years, this Championship has had an average annual economic impact of \$7 million. It has also resulted in \$500,000 in wages for local residents over the term of the sponsorship.

Most importantly, over a million dollars have been donated to local youth non-profit organizations, including The First Tee, Boys & Girls Club, YMCA, the local children's museum and Benton Harbor Area schools. Whirlpool Corporation and the PGA of America also established the Jack and Barbara Nicklaus Champions for Change scholarship for local college students. On May 22, the two entities announced they would donate \$150,000 to fund this important scholarship for the next five years.

The 84th KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship kicked off on Wednesday, May 22, with PGA WORKS Beyond the Green, a career-exploration event. Nearly 80 local students from historically underrepresented backgrounds were given an exclusive opportunity aimed to educate and inspire them to explore careers in the \$102 billion golf industry. These students came from the Michigan Hospitality Foundation, Bridge Academy of Southwest Michigan, Benton Harbor Area Schools culinary program and the Boys & Girls Club. After a message from PGA of America President John Lindert, the day included tours of the Whirlpool

Innovation Center and the Corewell Health Center for Wellness, as well as a panel discussion led by Beyond the Fairway Podcast, hosts Doug Smith and Will Lowry on what it means to live a "Bold Life". Students also had the opportunity to get hands-on experience with VR gaming, golf and, of course, cooking.

Wednesday afternoon continued with a Young Professionals event in the Benton Harbor Arts District, followed by a free community concert featuring R&B legend Jeffrey Osborne and sensational jazz artists Gerald Albright and Kim Scott.

Starting on Thursday, the highly anticipated showing of celebrity chefs got underway at the KitchenAid Fairway Club, including famed chefs Alex Guarnaschelli and Carla Hall, HGTV Designer Jasmine Roth and resident chefs Chris Covelli and Brett Wagner. This year also featured more Michigan-based talent than ever before, including Brian Maynard (Forté Coffee), Elton Mann (Plank's Tavern), Nate Brown (local celebrity from Flint), Justin Paruszkiewicz (Sister Lakes Brewery), Cheyenne Galbraith (Houndstooth), Deb Sailor (The Cheese Lady) and Abra Berens (Granor Farm). 
That's my goal too! Which is why after all these years, I still like sitting in the Carmen Fan-zonel





The Danger

Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. 1 John 4:7

In the world of 21st Century philosophy, Charles Taylor is a pretty big name. According to thebestschools.org website, Taylor "has been influential in defining how we conceive of ourselves in the modern world." In a book

entitled, "Dilemmas and Connections," Taylor makes a compelling observation about the secular mind and what motivates the secular mind to do good for other people.

A paraphrase of Taylor's observation is as follows: People with a secular mindset do good for others because, among other things, it makes them feel good about themselves. Then he took upon himself the guilt of all of our self-serving motives, our hidden agendas, our false humilities, and he paid the price in full at the cross. And now, as our living Savior, he comes to us in his Word, calling us to repentance, washing us clean, renewing our hearts, empowering us to love others as he has loved us.

Honestly, I wouldn't worry about it too much if I were you. The only exception to that might be if you had loans you owed to that same bank.

If you had a car loan with a particular bank, for instance, I wouldn't keep a lot of money in that bank.


