# Piedmont Pets

We have already had some very warm days; they remind us that summer is on the horizon. It is a good time to begin summer preparations for pets. Each year, we are heartbroken when dogs and cats are brought to us with varying degrees of heat exhaustion. And once you have seen a dead dog on a chain with no water or shade in sight, you realize how deadly the heat can be.

- 1. Once the temperatures are in the low 60s, pets should be kept home unless it is possible to have someone stay in the car with them while someone else completes the shopping or errands. Never rely on cracked windows or cars parked in the shade to keep animals cool!
- 2. Owners of all companion animals are required to provide standards of adequate care. For the purposes of summer, that means animals must be safe from the adverse effects of direct sunlight and heat. That is very clearly defined in the Code of Virginia. Doghouses quickly become sweltering heat boxes! There must be a way for the animal to escape direct sunlight and heat It is now illegal in Virginia for any companion animal to be tethered during

a heat advisory.

- We strongly urge people to walk dogs in the early morning or in the evening. Pavement can quickly burn paws. If you don't want to walk on pavement with bare feet, your animal should not have to!
- It is more important than ever to provide a constant source of drinkable water. This means that outside companion animals should not be expected to drink hot water.

This is definitely not a comprehensive list, but will help some owners get prepared for the summer care of pets.

#### Eagle Symbolism

The Fourth of July is a time to display American symbols like stars and stripes; red, white and blue; Uncle Sam, Lady Liberty and, of course, the majestic eagle. The bald eagle became the national bird of the United States with the creation of the Great Seal in 1782. Eagle symbolism was already well established by then.

Eagles are sacred to many Native American nations. European colonists brought their own eagle symbolism to the Americas. Eagles were associated with the divine in mythological pantheons and appeared in heraldry. The eagle, "aquila" in Latin, was used as a standard by ancient Roman legions. "Aquila" is also the name of a prominent constellation in the summer skies of the Northern Hemisphere.

Eagles also appear in American folk art. This carved and painted wooden eagle, wings outstretched like the eagle on the Great Seal, sold for \$5,000 at Brunk Auctions. It is attributed to Wilhelm Schimmel, who emigrated from Germany to the United States in the late 19th century. Wandering around Pennsylvania, having run-ins with the law, doing odd jobs at farms and selling his wooden carvings, he was something of a folkloric figure himself.

• I'd like some information • about Wallace Nutting and his work. One of his pictures has been in my family for over 50 years. The words "The Swimming Pool" are written below the picture on one side and it's signed "Wallace Nutting" on the other side. There are some stains, water spots and discoloration. It's in the original frame.

Wallace Nutting (1861-1941) A was known for his colored pictures of New England landscapes and Colonial interiors. He also made reproduction furniture and wrote several books. Nutting opened Wallace Nutting Art Prints in New York in 1904. He moved to Connecticut in 1905 and then to Framingham, Massachusetts,

in 1912. Collectors call his pictures "prints," but they are hand-tinted photographs. Nutting took the photographs and his staff printed, colored, titled, signed and framed the pictures. Millions of copies were sold. There are over 10,000 different titles. Twelve of the pictures were reprinted by machine in the 1930s and early '40s. Some prints sell for \$10 to \$20, some for over \$100. If the picture is in poor condition, it will be hard to sell.

TIP: Don't frame a good print in a clip frame. There should be air space between the paper and the glass.



#### FRESH PEACH PIE



Ingredients

1 (14.1-oz.) package refrigerated pie crusts

5 cups sliced peeled peaches (7 or 8 medium peaches)

1/2 cup granulated sugar

1/4 cup cornstarch

1/4 cup packed brown sugar

1 Tbsp. fresh lemon juice

3/4 tsp. vanilla extract

1/4 tsp. table salt

2 Tbsp. unsalted butter, cut into small pieces

1 large egg, lightly beaten

2 Tbsp. turbinado sugar

Directions

#### Prepare pie crusts:

Preheat oven to 375°F. Set pie crusts out at room temperature according to package directions.

#### Prepare pie filling:

Combine peaches, granulated sugar, cornstarch, brown sugar, lemon juice, vanilla, and salt in a large bowl; toss gently to combine.

Add crusts and filling to pie plate: Unroll 1 pie crust onto a work surface and gently roll to a slightly larger circle. Fit dough into a 9-inch pie plate, pressing into bottom and up the sides (allow excess to extend over the edge). Spoon filling into crust (it will likely be very juicy). Scatter butter pieces over filling. Unroll the other pie crust and fit on top of filling; fold edges under, sealing to bottom crust, and crimp. Brush top of pie crust with egg; sprinkle evenly with turbinado sugar. Cut 4 slits in top of pie for steam to escape.

#### Bake pie:

Bake at 375°F until crust is golden brown and filling is bubbly with thickened juices, 55 to 60 minutes, shielding with foil after 40 minutes if crust starts getting too browned. Cool on a wire rack for at least 30 minutes before slicing.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

2 lbs corn kernels (fresh or thawed, see notes)

1 cup diced cherry tomatoes

¼ cup diced red onion

1 medium cucumber, peeled and diced

¼ cup chopped cilantro ½ cup plain Greek yogurt


½ cup mayo
