No place has a shortage of cats and every locality is dealing with what to do about

It is vital to keep cats inside. Outside cats face many dangers, and their life expectancy is 1-5 years. A cat kept strictly inside has an average life expectancy of 12-18 years.

Contact with other cats outside leads to the risk of disease transmission. Feline leukemia and feline immunodeficiency are transmitted from cat to cat and, once contracted, result in the eventual death of

Dogs and other wild animals pose a threat to cats; the very real danger is one of exposure to rabies. Outdoor cats can suffer torn ears, cut eyes, abscesses, and other injuries requiring veterinary treatment.

Indoor cats are not generally exposed to fleas, ticks, ear mites, or other parasites that can cause anemia, skin irritations, allergic reactions, and even death. Outdoor cats are at risk to be poisoned. Neighbors may deliberately poison cats they view as nuisances, but accidental poisonings also occur. Chemically treated lawns, bait left out to kill rats or mice, and antifreeze can all be deadly dangers.

It is a myth that cats are "streetwise." Cats are intelligent and alert, but they stand very little chance against traffic. We can tell horror stories, and even have the pictures, of outside cats that have been beheaded, scalped, electrocuted, burned, tortured, or starved. A dogfighting investigation

seminar I attended a couple of years ago showed actual video of cats and kittens being used to train dogs to kill. Trees also present hazards for the outside cat. Dogs or loud noises can scare a cat to climb so high, they cannot get down. I have heard repeatedly that a cat can climb down a tree. The reality is, cats cannot easily climb down facing the ground, and they usually do not back down out of a tree. We have had to intervene countless times to get them out of trees.

We have also had to rescue countless cats (kittens, mostly) from the engines of cars. Some survive, and some do not.

The list of hazards for outside cats goes on and on.

Outside cats are at the mercy of the people they encounter, as well as weather conditions and other animals. We encourage everyone to keep their cats inside. It truly is the best life for a cat.



Antiques & Collecting

Art Nouveau

In design, the line between art and science isn't always clearly drawn. This has been true for centuries. One of the most influential figures in the art nouveau movement of the late 19th to early 20th century was a scientist, not an artist.

Beginning in 1889, biologist Ernst Haeckel published a series of books called "Art Forms in Nature" that captured the geometric structure and intricate beauty of sea life, microscopic organisms, plants, animals and insects. While art nouveau designs are stylized and exaggerated, especially human figures, the influence of nature, especially as captured by Haeckel, is clear in the organic asymmetrical shapes and the use of plants, animals, birds and insects as subjects or motifs.

This lamp shaped like a cluster of mushrooms with long stems and graceful curving shapes may not have been made in the art nouveau period, but it is definitely art nouveau style. Its leaded glass shades, bronze base and nature inspiration are reminiscent of Tiffany lamps, themselves emblematic of art nouveau, but compared to them, it was a bargain. While authentic Tiffany lamps can sell for recordsetting prices of thousands of dollars, this mushroom lamp sold for \$344 at a Hindman auction.

bro stopped making the original toys in 2000 but has made new Emoto-Tronic Furby toys since then. Furby Babies sell today for about \$20 to \$40 without a box and \$40 to \$60 in the original box.

Danville Utilities secures major funding for key projects

Danville Utilities has received substantial grants and low-interest loans to support major capital improvement projects aimed at enhancing service reliability and supporting regional growth. These projects include the expansion of the Southside Pumping Station, replacement of a critical gas main loop, and an inventory survey of lead and copper water pipes.

"We are thrilled to receive this significant funding, which will enable us to make essential upgrades to our infrastructure," said Jason Grey, director of Danville Utilities. "These projects are crucial for supporting our community's growth and ensuring the reliability of our services." Expansion of Southside Pumping Station Danville Utilities will undertake a \$30 million project to expand the Southside Pumping Station's capacity from 7.6 million gallons of wastewater per day to 11 million gallons per day, addressing projected economic development growth.

This project is funded by a \$10.5 million low-interest loan from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality's Clean Water Revolving Loan program, with an interest rate of 0.5%. Additionally, a \$4.5 million grant will be used for principal forgiveness under this loan program. Preliminary engineering has been completed, and the expansion is expected to take four to five years. Danville Utilities will apply for an additional \$15 million in funding this summer. Replacement of a main gas loop Last month, Danville Utilities received a \$10 million grant to replace the leak-prone ductile iron gas main loop serving Goodyear Boulevard, Gypsum Road, and South Main Street. The current main, which serves Goodyear Tire & Rubber, will be replaced with a higher capacity steel gas main, resolving one of the most problematic areas for leaks in Danville Utilities' service network. The replacement will occur in three phases.

Lead and copper water pipe inventory
A third grant of \$500,000 from the Virginia
Department of Health will fund an inventory
survey of lead and copper water pipes. This
survey is scheduled to be completed by October,
ensuring the community's water infrastructure
meets safety and regulatory standards.
Electric vehicle fast charger

A fourth grant of \$76,580 from the Department of Energy's Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program will cover the installation of a DC fast charger at the Danville Visitor Center at 645 River Park Drive.

DC fast chargers are currently the fastest charging option available for electric vehicles. They can charge a vehicle in less than an hour. The charger would be managed by a third party and charge rates that would cover electric costs for anyone using the fast charger. Total funds In total, Danville Utilities has secured \$15.1 million in grants and \$10.5 million in low-interest loans. The utility has also applied for an additional \$45.5 million in grants and \$33.9 million in low-interest loans to further support various capital improvement projects.





Medicines Usually Maintain Efficacy Past Their **Expiration Dates**

DEAR DR. ROACH: I recently tested positive for COVID using an expired home test, and I self-isolated for five days. I also realized every Tylenol, antihistamine, DayQuil, NyQuil and allergy pill that I had was past its expiration date. Some were only expired by a few months, but most were expired by two to four years. I guess I don't get sick often.

My question is: Before I dispose of these, how effective are they, and are any of them dangerous to use? -- K.L.

ANSWER: Drug manufacturers are required to make expiration dates, and they guarantee that the drugs are what they say they are and are effective until a certain date (at least if they are properly stored in a cool and dark area). This does not necessarily mean that they become ineffective or dangerous after expiring, and many drugs have been proven to maintain efficacy for years or decades after the printed expiration date.

A military study found that 90% of drugs are still effective 15 years after expiration. It is rare for a drug to become dangerous; however, the tetracycline class of antibiotics is one where toxicity has been found.

In general, if a drug is a few months to a year past its expiration date, it is probably OK. (Liquid drugs, nitroglycerin and insulin are notable exceptions.) But at some point, you have to ask yourself whether it is worth the small risk of the medicine being less effective, especially for inexpensive overthe-counter (OTC) drugs.

Also, COVID test kits may have an extended expiration date. The Food and Drug Administration maintains a list at tinyurl.com/COVIDTestKitEx-



SKILLET BLACKBERRY COBBLER



INGREDIENTS

1 box of 2 refrigerated pie crusts (I prefer Pillsbury)

2 (10-14 oz) bags frozen blackberries 1 stick butter, melted

1 1/3 cups sugar (for berries) 1/2 cup flour

1/4 cup sugar (to sprinkle on crust before baking)

1/2 stick butter, cut into small cubes (to dot onto crust before baking)
1/2 cup water

INSTRUCTIONS

Heat oven to 350 degrees.

Unroll one pie crust and place in bottom and up sides of 12 " cast iron skillet.

Pierce bottom and sides of crust with a fork. Bake 7 minutes; remove from oven. Increase oven temp to 375 degrees.

In a large bowl, mix melted butter, 1 1/3 cups sugar, and all of flour.

Put berries in bowl with butter/sugar/flour mixture; toss until berries are covered and mixture is crumbly.

Gently pour berries into skillet; sprinkle water over berries.

Unroll second pie crust over top of berries, seal crust at the edge of the skillet. Scatter the small pieces of butter on top of the crust.

Sprinkle 1/4 cup sugar on top of crust. Cut tiny slits in top of pie crust. Bake for approximately 45 minutes or until bubbly at edges and beginning to brown on top.

(I highly recommend a pie shield to keep edges of crust from over browning.)


