

### **Arnolds Park Amusement Park** Important Updates:

• All Concerts will move forward for the summer. • Beach and docks are closed. No swimming and docks are

closed to pedestrians & boat tie up. We will not open the beach until water recedes and the DNR gives an all clear for returning to the water. Docks will remain closed until the water recedes, repairs can be made and we are comfortable with the level of the lake and any boat traffic.



The Queen II will not be operating until further notice. The water must recede off of Pirate Jack's dock to attempt entry. There will be an assessment when the water recedes if it would be wise to go on excursions. We want to be good neighbors on the lake to those with shoreline property damage. We will look to hold opportunities for groups on the Queen while tied up at the dock once the water recedes. All current Queen II charters that are booked are being contacted to make alternate arrangements

### ISU Extension and Outreach "Venture Club" to Visit Little Sioux Stems and The Prairie Flower

The Iowa State University Extension and Outreach Dickinson County office will continue its "Venture Club" for adults interested in exploring and supporting local businesses right in their own backyard with a tour of Little Sioux Stems and The Prairie Flower on Friday, July 12.

The event is open to the public, and everyone is welcome. Participants should meet at the Extension office located at the fairgrounds in Spirit Lake at 8:30 a.m. From there, everyone will carpool to each business and end the day at approximately 12 noon.

"We call our monthly travels the 'Venture Club,' but there is no membership or mandatory attendance involved. Any adult is welcome to join us when it interests them and works in their schedule," said Sue Boettcher, adult program coordinator with ISU Extension and Outreach Dickinson County. "We are really excited to visit Little Sioux Stems and The Prairie Flower."

The first stop at 9 a.m. will be a tour of Little Sioux Stems, a specialty cut flower farm founded in 2022. With just under 5 acres, the farm boasts a quarter-acre garden with 35+ varieties of flowers and pollinators. Next, the group will head to The Prairie Flower for a tour and light refreshments. The Prairie

Flower is a native seed and plant nursery and dealer. They provide local ecotype native prairie and wetland plants and seeds, as well as native cultivar seeds, pasture and hay seeds, and lawn grass mixes.

Following The Prairie Flower, the group will conclude the event by returning to the Extension office at approximately 12 noon.

There is no charge from Extension to participate in the event, but participants will need \$7 to cover the tour fee at Little Sioux Stems. Any additional purchases are at the expense of the

### **ILCC** Receives Generous Donation

Iowa Lakes Community College recently announced the receipt of a substantial donation from Easy Automation Inc. (EAI), a leading international supplier of automation technology and equipment to the feed, agronomy, and grain handling industries. EAI has generously donated a fully functional minimill to the College, which will be housed at the SERT building on the Estherville campus. This donation will provide students with a unique opportunity to gain hands-on experience with cutting-edge automation technology.

"This impressive machine is not so "mini" as it stands over 12 feet tall and simulates an automated feed mill environment. This will provide our students with invaluable hands-on experience in equipment operation and troubleshooting, utilizing a programmable logic controller in a miniaturized version of a real-world application," explained Chad Tischer, Engineering Technology Program Coordinator at Iowa Lakes.

EAI originally developed the mini-mill to test software for batching and controls in automated feed mills, particularly for adding micro-ingredients like vitamins and medicines. Previously housed at EAI's Welcome, Minnesota, facility, the mini-mill is no longer needed, so they chose to donate it to Iowa Lakes Community College to ensure it continues to support educational endeavors.

The mini-mill allows students to engage with equipment operation by adding "feed" (using plastic pellets to avoid issues with actual feed) based on operator inputs and onboard load cells connected to a Programmable Logic Controller (PLC). The setpoint weight is determined before the pellets are augered back to the top and recycled, mimicking the operation of more extensive feed mill facilities.

Moreover, our students will have the chance to design PLC and Human-Machine Interface (HMI) programs to interact with the equipment, mirroring tasks they will encounter in their future careers. This invaluable hands-on experience will be integrated into various classes, including PLCs, Fluid Power, Industrial Instrumentation, and Motor Control, offering a comprehensive and practical educational student experience.

"We are deeply grateful to EAI for their generous donation. This gift will help equip our students for successful careers in the automation and feed industries. The mini-mill contains numerous possibilities for providing learning opportunities and will significantly enrich the education of our students," expressed Dean of Career and Technical Workforce Jeff Soole.

Blues Traveler with special guest Spin Doctors - Friday, Sept. 13, 7:30pm. Formed in 1988 in New York City, in 1990, the Spin Doctors were signed to Epic Records/Sony Music by A&R executive Frankie LaRocka. The band's epic debut EP, Up For Grabs, was recorded live at Wetlands in Lower Manhattan and released in January 1991. In August 1991, the Spin Doctors released their full-length debut album, Pocket Full Of

Kryptonite, co-produced by Frank Aversa,

Peter Denenberg, and Frankie LaRocka.

Relentless touring and a wave of posi-

tive press kept the album alive into the

next year, when sales began to increase dramatically. ... Kryptonite was certified gold in September 1992 and received an additional boost from the band's October appearance on "Saturday Night Live." Reaching the one million mark in January 1993,...Kryptonite entered the Billboard Top Ten one month later. By June 1993, the album was triple platinum and had breached the Top Five among Billboard Pop Albums while spinning off two major hit singles: "Little Miss Can't Be Wrong" and the No. 1 Rock radio song of 1993,

"Two Princes." which also earned the band a Grammy Award nomination for Best Rock Performance by a Duo or Group. Ultimately, Pocket Full Of Kryptonite sold over five million copies in the US and another five million overseas. "[Their] popularity is based on universal rock & roll virtues," said Rolling Stone, which put the band on the cover of its January 7, 1993 issue. "The Doctors aren't trying to blaze new trails-they know we've been down this way with the Stones, Curtis Mayfield, and a few of their other touchstones. But the proof-plenty of it-is in the party." In June 1994, the Spin Doctors released their second Epic album, Turn It Upside Down. Once again co-produced by Peter Denenberg and Frankie LaRocka, the album featured new originals like "Biscuit Head," "Bags Of Dirt," and "You Let Your Heart Go Too Fast." The band set out on a three-month headlining tour and played to immense crowds at the Woodstock and Glastonbury festivals. Their cover of the Creedence Clearwater classic "Have You Ever Seen The Rain?" was a highlight of the multi-platinum Philadelphia soundtrack. In November/ December 1994, the Spins opened for the Rolling Stones on a series of eleven North American stadium shows. In March 1995, their album hit the one million (platinum) mark in the US, moving an additional million copies overseas. The Spin Doctors' next Epic album, You've Got to Believe In Something, was produced by Danny Kortchmar and released in May 1996; more touring followed. The band would release three more albums: 1999's Here

Comes The Bride, 2005's Nice Talk to Me,

and If the River Was Whiskey, which was released in 2013. Thirty years. Athousand twists. But whatever happens down the road, rest assured that the Spin Doctors will always be the last men standing, still making music like their lives depend on it, still riding the bus, still shaking the room. Even now, plans are afoot for a seventh studio album to be released on Capitol Records in early 2025 and another swashbuckling world tour, adding to their tally of almost two thousand shows.

Judd Hoos is an independent American rock band from the Black Hills of South Dakota. In the past year, they appeared on NBC's American Song Contest with Snoop Dogg & Kelly Clarkson, been in the studio, released new music, and played over 100 Midwest clubs, theaters, festivals, fairs, and made their debut on the Sturgis Buffalo Chip main stage. 



**Dear Motor Medics**,

I'm addicted to my seat heaters. Every car I have ever purchased has had them and it has even been a deal breaker for me when shopping for a car if it did not have them. I use my heaters year-round unless it is too warm out. My driver's side seat heater just failed on my Cadillac and or course it is 2 months out of factory warranty. They would love to replace it for me at a charge of \$800.00 and that's just not going to happen. I am not ready to purchase a new car, but I want my seat heater to work. Is there anything I can do to get it going again?

Dear Joe,

I too enjoy my heated seats and when they fail. I would never think of spending \$800 just to keep my rear end warm. Good thing that there are alternatives out there. You could check with your local recycled parts place, AKA Salvage Yard, and they may have an entire working seat for you that will match your interior, or you could investigate an aftermarket heater. Seat heaters are a great accessory for anyone who has a seat to sit on. Cars, trucks, tractors, they all can be equipped with heaters usually at a much lower price than a replacement factory unit. Check your local car stereo shops or accessory installation dealer to see if they offer them.

**Dear Motor Medics,** 

I had the air conditioning system fail on my Land cruiser two years ago due to a large leak in the rear refrigerant lines that run under the vehicle. Where the lines run, they are susceptible to damage from road debris and those concrete stops they put at the front of parking spaces. You know, the ones with the metal stakes holding them that my teenage daughter thinks is ok to drive over instead of backing up. So, after the cloud of refrigerant smoke cleared, I took it to both the dealer and an independent shop for a repair quote. Both places were over \$1000.00 to replace the lines. They said the lines come as a set and take many hours to replace. Is there anything I can do that won't cost me so much money? Thanks, Rich in Attica Indiana

Dear Rich,

Ouch! You have a few choices. You can do without air conditioning, you can spend the money for new lines, you could block off the rear lines and just use the front a/c, or you can repair the lines you have. There are a/c line repair kits out in the market that not all shops have but the ones that do will be able to cut out the damaged section and splice in a new one. You can also have a rear delete kit installed. Either one will be a large savings over having the entire line set replaced.

Thank you to all the citizens of Spencer for their continued patience and support during these challenging times.

The shelters have been consolidated and now a single shelter set up at the Spencer Events Center in collaboration with the Red Cross. Residents can **CITY** of

now go to the shelter to register for disaster relief with FEMA. Remember, all FEMA representatives will have a badge. If they do not have a FEMA badge, they are not with FEMA.

The Grand Bridge has been inspected and reopened by the Department of Transportation (DOT). Engineers have confirmed

Pink yard flags have been placed in yards to indicate gas shutoff. Please do not remove these flags or pile garbage on them. Our teams continue to work throughout the city to restore gas services. Appliances need to be certified by a licensed pro-

fessional before gas services can be restored. The Fire Department is surveying the community for unsafe structures. Homes with major damage or structural failure will be marked with a circle and a red X to indicate severe hazards, such as structural damage, electricity issues, gas leaks, or flowing water. Homeowners can enter their homes, at their own risk.

The tetanus clinic at Spencer Hospital, Entrance B, will open at noon. If you have an open wound and have been in flood water, it is crucial to get a tetanus booster if you have not had one in 5+ years. Other clinic locations are the Thrifty White mobile pharmacy in the Menards parking lot and a new clinic location is available at Hy-Vee pharmacy.

Spencer Municipal Utilities and Black Hills Energy are working on a restoration plan for those without electricity. If you do not have power today, you must go through an electrician before it can be turned back on. Our goal is to assess the exterior of every home to deem it safe or unsafe for homeowners.

As the water recedes, there is a high volume of basement and structural collapses. Debris removal is being broken down into manageable sections. This will be a slow, planned process, transitioning from days to weeks and months. We are working diligently to form a safe and effective plan for debris removal.

A second dumping site will be opening at the Aquatic Center's

debris area as a temporary dump site to assist with the removal The call center is open from 7 AM to 7 PM at 712-264-8407.







In 2003, The Dark Knights were inducted into the Iowa Rock and Roll Music Association (IRRMA) Hall of Fame.




# 30 Years of Service: Local Volunteer Receives Governor's Award

Please do not remove these flags or pile garbage on them. Our teams continue to work throughout the city to restore gas services. Appliances need to be certified by a licensed professional before gas services can be restored.

The Fire Department is continuing to survey the community for unsafe structures. Homes with major damage or structural failure will be marked with a circle and a red X to indicate severe hazards, such as structural damage, electricity issues, gas leaks, or flowing water. Homeowners can enter their homes, at their own risk.

Due to safety concerns, if your power has not been restored and you are ready to have it restored, please call a City of Spencer licensed electrician. In accordance with city, state, and national codes, your electrician will request an inspection and contact the city for residential inspections or the state for commercial properties.

The landfill and transfer station will be closed on Sunday, to allow staff to assess the needs in their own homes. Both dump sites will remain open 24/7 for debris drop-off.







To restore gas service, power and water must be restored, and appliances inspected by a licensed professional, and the space cleared of water and debris. Do not remove the pink flags in your yard, as they help track meters needing repairs. Removing the flags will delay the restoration process.

Structural Damage Update:

The Fire Department is continuing to survey the community for unsafe structures. If your home has been marked with a red X (indicating significant structural damage), the City of Spencer recommends you contact a licensed engineer or architect to look at the stability of the structure. Please note: This is not a requirement, just a recommendation.

Electrical Re-Energizing Update:

For commercial properties without power, please contact your electrician to coordinate with the state electrical inspector. Residential properties now have two options:

1) Have an electrician review your property and get a city inspection for fast approval before submitting to SMU, or

2) Complete a waiver form to request power re-establishment without a safety review. Waiver forms are available at City Hall or online at https://spenceriowa.seamlessdocs.com/f/ bmq6qi3qghvu.

Wet ammo disposal:

Per the Iowa State Fire Marshal and Chief Coulson, wet ammo can be dropped off at the East 1st Street entrance of the Fire Station (Door #1). It needs to be in a hard container, preferably a bucket. It cannot be in a box.



# FEMA Teams Visit Local Neighborhoods to Help Flood Survivors

FEMA teams will begin visiting shelters and neighborhoods in Clay, Emmet, Lyon, Plymouth, and Sioux counties on Tuesday, June 25, to help survivors of record flooding in northwest Iowa. FEMA Disaster Survivor Assistance (DSA) teams will work in coordination with state and county emergency management. DSA Teams will be in impacted counties and visiting shelter locations. Additionally, DSA teams will be assisting residents in Adams, Cedar and Jasper counties. They were added to the disaster declaration for damage for severe storms, tornadoes and flooding that occurred from May 20-31.

FEMA can provide money to eligible applicants for help with serious needs, paying for a

temporary place to live, home repairs and other needs not covered by insurance. The teams help survivors apply with FEMA and address immediate and emerging needs. They also provide application status updates and referrals to community resources.

FEMA staff can easily be identified by their federal photo identification and FEMA clothing. Residents are encouraged to ask for official photo ID before providing personal information.

Types of FEMA Assistance Available

FEMA is offering a wide variety of help to people affected by the recent flooding. Every homeowner and renter who suffered damage is encouraged to apply.

Money provided by FEMA does not have to be repaid and may include:

Serious Needs: Money for lifesaving and life-sustaining items, including water, food, first aid, prescriptions, infant formula, breastfeeding supplies, diapers, consumable medical supplies, durable medical equipment, personal hygiene items and fuel for transportation.

Displacement: Money to help with housing needs if you cannot return to your home because of the disaster. The money can be used to stay in a hotel, with family and friends or other options while you look for a rental unit.

Home Repair or Replacement: Money to help you repair or replace your home damaged by the disaster. The money can also help with pre-existing damage to parts of your home where the disaster caused further damage.

Rental Assistance: Money you can use to rent housing if you are displaced from your home because of the disaster.

Personal Property: Money to help you repair or replace appliances, room furnishings, and a personal or family computer damaged by the disaster. This can also include money for books, uniforms, tools, medical equipment and other items required for school or work, including self-employment.

Child Care: Money to help you pay for increased or child care expenses caused by the disaster. Transportation: Money to help you repair or replace a vehicle damaged by the disaster when you don't have another vehicle you can use.

Moving and Storage Expenses: Money to help you move and store personal property from your home to prevent additional damage.

### **FEMA Home Inspections**

FEMA housing inspectors are working in Iowa, inspecting damage reported by people who have applied with FEMA. Inspectors will call or text to make an appointment before coming to a home. They will display official photo identification. If the official ID is not visible, it's OK to ask to see it. This helps prevent fraud.

### Apply with FEMA Whether You Have Insurance or Not

Everyone with disaster damage should apply whether they have insurance or not.

If you have homeowners, renters, or flood insurance, you should file a claim as soon as possible. Please stay in close contact with your insurance agency.

FEMA cannot duplicate benefits for losses covered by insurance. If your policy does not cover all your disaster expenses, you may be eligible for federal assistance.

Disaster recovery assistance is available without regard to race, color, religion, nationality, sex, age, disability, English proficiency or economic status.







### **Petunias: A Favorite Annual**

What flower is easy to grow, blooms from spring to frost, and has a diverse variety of colors and flower forms? Answer - the petunia. So,

it is no wonder the petunia is one of the most popular annual flowers in the U.S. Petunias have

minimal requirements - a moderately fertile, well-drained soil and a sunny location. Sites with less than 5-6 hours of sun lead to fewer blooms and lanky plants. Also, shady locations tend to have wetter soil that can lead to rot



While petunias are fairly low maintenance, some varieties may require deadheading to encourage a constant display of blooms. If petunias get too leggy, cut them back to about half their length in mid-summer and follow with fertilization and water to promote new growth.

There are four categories of petunias based on flower size and growth habit - grandiflora, multiflora, milliflora, and spreading or ground cover. The category will determine the best use for the petunia, such as the garden, container, or wall.

Grandifloras have large single or double flowers, with some single flowers up to 5-inches across. They are often used in window boxes, hanging baskets and containers. While spectacular in

size, grandiflora petunias do not hold up well in rainy weather. Multiflora petunias have a greater number of smaller single or double flowers. Because multifloras are more compact, they are more resistant to wet weather than grandifloras. Single form multifloras are often used in mass plantings in flower beds. Double multifloras are more suitable for containers.


Milliflora petunias are miniature with even smaller flowers and plant size. The flowers are 1- to 1½-inches in diameter and do not require deadheading. Because they are compact, millifloras are used in containers or in the borders of flower beds.

Spreading or groundcover petunias grow vigorously and may cover an area 3- to 4-feet in diameter. This category is very heat and drought tolerant and requires little maintenance as they are self-deadheading. They are great for hanging baskets, containers, or as an annual groundcover.

However, selection involves more than the category of petunia and where it is to be planted. There is an amazing range of color and color patterns.

Traditional colors include blue, pink, purple, red, white, and yellow. There are newer colors such as black, bronze, coral, magenta, and lilac. New color patterns include picotee, stripes, splashes, hearts, white star-shaped centers, chartreuse-green edges, and polka-dotted flowers.

While petunias may be a popular flower among gardeners, they are far from "average" with so many characteristics from which to choose. My advice? Have fun selecting the "perfect" petunia for you!
