



Butterfly Jewelry

In North America, summer, especially late summer, is butterfly season. Multiple generations hatch as caterpillars grow, pupate and emerge to pollinate flowers and lay eggs of their own. If you would prefer a butterfly that lasts longer, they often appear in decorative arts and jewelry, like this pin or pendant that sold for \$594 at New Orleans Auction Galleries. Real-life butterflies are admired for the striking colors and patterns of their wings, but this pin dazzles with gemstones. Its colors come from about 1.72 carats of

sapphires. While the name of the stone is synonymous with a brilliant shade of blue, sapphires can come in many other colors, as they do here. About 2.90 carats of diamonds add more sparkle (and value!) to the pin. They are rosecut, an old shape with irregular facets meant to preserve the original size and shape of the stone. Today, most diamonds in jewelry are brilliant-cut, a style that was developed in the 18th century to create more facets on the stone and reflect more light.

Chests that are too heavy to move easily or are in poor condition don't sell well. The peeling pasteboard panels on your chest would be difficult to restore. A heavy European decorated bridal chest from the second half of the 19th century was

up for auction last year. It was in poor condition and listed as "difficult to move." It didn't sell, even though the starting bid was listed as \$150. You might find someone who enjoys taking on a project, but the weight will keep most people from tackling it.

TIP: Wear your old jewelry, especially the pieces that look old. You will be surprised how many will ask about it.

Winslow Hospital added to the Virginia Landmarks Register

The Virginia Department of Historic Resources on Tuesday announced that it has named Danville's Winslow Hospital to the Virginia Landmarks Register, which is the commonwealth's official list of places of historical, architectural, archaeological, and cultural significance.

Built in 1940 on Betts Street in the Almagro community, the Winslow Hospital was the first and only hospital in Danville constructed specifically to serve the African American community during segregation and the Civil Rights Movement.

Mayor Alonzo Jones said the designation is great news for the community. "The Winslow Hospital is an important part of the history of our city," he said. "I am pleased the Housing Authority acquired this property and was able to get the historic designation."

City Manager Ken Larking said that he looks forward to seeing the building back in beneficial use.

"This historic designation will improve the chances that the building is redeveloped and becomes a contributing part of the Almagro neighborhood," Larking said. "The City's Plan Danville comprehensive planning process put a special emphasis on this neighborhood, and we know from resident feedback how important this structure is to them and Danville."

The Danville Redevelopment & Housing Authority (DRHA) purchased the building last year.

"DRHA is delighted with the state's decision to add this property to the registry," said Donald Paredez, chief executive officer of the DRHA. "This designation will ensure that the Winslow Hospital remains a vital part of the past and future of the Almagro community and the city of Danville."

Operated by African American physicians and staff, the hospital played a critical role in treating the victims of Bloody Monday on June 10, 1963. This event, marked by violence against

demonstrators protesting segregation and racial discrimination in Danville, stands as one of the most intense incidents of the Civil Rights Movement in Virginia. The hospital closed in 1971 when medical services in Danville were fully integrated at the former Danville Memorial Hospital.

The Winslow Hospital was one of 12 sites that the Commonwealth's Board of Historic Resources approved for listing in the Virginia Landmarks Register during its meeting on June 20. The Virginia Department of Historic Resources will forward the documentation for these newly listed sites to the National Park Service for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places.

Listing a property on the state or national registers is honorary and sets no restrictions on what owners may do with their property, according to the Virginia Department of Historic Resources. The designation is foremost an invitation to learn about and experience authentic and significant places in Virginia's history. Designating a property on the state or national registers — either individually or as a contributing building in a historic district — provides an owner the opportunity to pursue historic rehabilitation tax credit improvements to the building. Tax credit projects must comply with the Secretary of Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation.

Treasury staff to help citizens find missing money

The City of Danville's Treasurer's Office, along with the Virginia Department of the Treasury, is bringing its semi-annual unclaimed property virtual call event on Thursday, July 11, and Friday, July 12, to help local citizens who might be owed funds they don't know about.

Since 2019, this event has helped citizens to find over \$1,047,811 in unclaimed funds.

Customers can call 1-833-302-0704 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday and Friday to have staff check their name for missing money. Customers may also visit the website at www.vaMoney-Search.org.

The State Treasury's Unclaimed Property Division operates essentially as a centralized lost and found. It handles unclaimed money and property turned over by companies when they have lost track of the rightful owner.

Unclaimed property can include utility deposits, customer refunds, unpaid wages, money from insurance policies, securities and investments, bank accounts, safe deposit box contents, credit balances, refund or dividend checks, tangible property, and more.

After his family moved to Maryland and eventually to the family home in Takoma Park, John attended the local elementary school and graduated from Blair High School in 1954. He attended Montgomery College before transferring and graduating from the University of Maryland with a degree in microbiology in 1961. He attended medical school at George Washington University School of Medicine and under the auspices of the U.S. Navy, completed a residency in Neurosurgery also at GW. Now on active duty with the Navy he received orders to Oak Knoll Naval Hospital in Oakland, California to serve in the Neurosurgery department. Back in the states John returned to Pensacola and NAMI to serve as the Head of Otolaryngology department and Senior Clinical Instructor training future flight surgeons, a highlight of his military career. By this time, he had attained the rank of Captain and was board certified in both Neurosurgery and Otolaryngology.

In 1987, his wife Beverly was offered professional employment with a major oil and gas company located in San Ramon, California. She and their two sons relocated to Dublin, CA where the children began school, and she started her new job. Unfortunately, John could not be transferred to a post in California until the following year. He was eventually assigned to Alameda Naval Air Station working in the branch medical clinic and Oak Knoll Hospital's Health and Science Research department.

After a distinguished career spanning over 20 years of active duty, Captain Branch retired from the Navy on April 1, 1992. His service was recognized with numerous awards including the National Defense Service Medal, Meritorious Unit Commendation, Humanitarian Service Medal, and Overseas ribbon. While serving his last post at NAMI, John was awarded the "United States Meritorious Service Medal" by U.S. President Ronald Reagan.
