
Two Funny True Events



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

# ZUCCHINI

### **ZUCCHINI MUFFINS**

# Yield: 18 muffins INGREDIENTS

- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup whole-wheat flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly grated nutmeg
- 1/4 teaspoon fine salt
- 1 stick (8 tablespoons) unsalted butter, melted
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup Greek yogurt
- 3 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- 1 medium zucchini, grated on the large holes of a box grater (about 1 cup)
- 1/2 cup golden raisins

### DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F. Line 18 muffin cups with paper liners.
- 2. Whisk together the all-purpose and whole-wheat flours with the baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon, nutmeg and salt in a large bowl.
- Beat the butter, sugar, yogurt, eggs and vanilla together in another large bowl using an electric mixer on medium speed until fluffy. Reduce the speed to low and beat in the flour mixture until combined.
- 4. Stir in the zucchini and raisins. Divide the batter evenly among the prepared cups.
- Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center of the muffins comes out clean, 15 to 18 minutes. Cool the muffins in the pans on a wire rack for 10 minutes; remove from the pans and cool completely on the rack.

# **ZUCCHINI BREAD/LEMON HONEY BUTTER**

Yield: 2 loaves INGREDIENTS

### Lemon Honey Butter:

- 3 large eggs
- 1 cup vegetable oil, plus more for greasing the pans
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 2 cups shredded zucchini (about 1 medium zucchini)
- 1 tablespoon grated lemon zest
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon fine salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- Honey Lemon Butter, recipe follows
- 4 ounces unsalted butter, softened
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 1 tablespoon grated lemon zest

### DIRECTIONS

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Grease two 9-by-5inch loaf pans. In large bowl beat together the eggs, oil, sugar and vanilla. Slowly add zucchini. Add lemon zest and mix thoroughly.
- 2. In a separate large bowl combine flour, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon and salt. Slowly add zucchini mixture until completely combined. Divide the batter between the prepared loaf pans. Bake until a toothpick comes out clean and the sides have started to brown, about 45 minutes. Let cool on a rack 15 minutes. Unmold and serve warm or at room temperature sliced with the Lemon Honey Butter.

### Lemon Honey Butter:

1. In a small bowl, combine the butter, honey and lemon zest and mix together well.

# COCOLATE-ZUCCHINI BREAD INGREDIENTS

- 8 tablespoons (1 stick) unsalted butter, at room
- temperature, plus more for buttering the pan
- 1 1/4 cups all-purpose flour, plus more for dusting the pan
- 2 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder (not Dutch process)
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 teaspoon fine salt
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1 large egg, at room temperature
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- 1/4 cup buttermilk, at room temperature
- 1 cup shredded zucchini (about 8 ounces)
- 2 ounces semisweet chocolate, finely chopped

# **DIRECTIONS**

- Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. Butter a 9-by-4by-3-inch loaf pan. Dust with flour, then tap out the excess.
- 2. Whisk the flour, cocoa, baking soda and salt together in a medium bowl.
- 3. Beat the butter and sugar in a medium bowl with an electric mixer on medium-high speed until light and fluffy, about 4 minutes. Continue to mix and drizzle in the oil and beat until incorporated. Beat in the egg and then the vanilla.
- 4. Reduce the mixer speed to low and beat in the flour mixture in 3 additions, alternating with the buttermilk in 2 additions, beginning and ending with the flour, scraping the sides of the bowl occasionally. Fold the shredded zucchini and chocolate into the batter and pour into the prepared pan.
- 5. Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, about 55 minutes. Let cool completely in the pan on a wire rack.

# **FUDGY ZUCCHINI BROWNIES**

### Yield: 24 brownies INGREDIENTS

- Nonstick cooking spray, for the baking dish
- 12 tablespoons (1 1/2 sticks) unsalted butter
- 1 cup dark chocolate chips
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 2 teaspoons kosher salt
- 4 large eggs
- 1 cup whole wheat or all-purpose flour
- 1 tablespoon pure vanilla extract
- 2 medium zucchini (about 1 pound), grated
- 1 cup chopped walnuts, optional.

### DIRECTIONS

- 1. Arrange a rack in the center of the oven and preheat to 350 degrees F. Spray a 9-by-13-inch baking dish with nonstick spray.
- 2. Melt the butter in a large saucepan over low heat. Add 1/2 cup of the chocolate chips and cook, stirring

with a rubber spatula, until the chocolate is melted; remove from the heat. Stir in the sugar, cocoa powder and salt until combined. Stir in the eggs and then the flour until fully combined. Fold in the vanilla, zucchini, remaining 1/2 cup chocolate chips and the walnuts, if using.

Scrape the batter into the prepared baking dish.
 Bake until the brownies are glossy and firm, 30 to 35 minutes. Let the brownies cool to room temperature or until slightly warm, at least 30 minutes (they will get fudgier the longer they cool). Cut into 24 pieces. Serve immediately or store in an airtight container for up to 1 week.

# **ZUCCHINI BREAD WAFFLES**

# Yield: 12 waffles **INGREDIENTS** Waffles:

- 2 cups grated zucchini, squeezed with paper towels
- 2 carrots, peeled and grated
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 4 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon grated nutmeg
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 2 1/2 cups buttermilk, at room temperature
- 4 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 3 large eggs, at room temperature
- Nonstick cooking spray, for spraying the waffle iron Syrup:
- 8 ounces cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 tablespoon maple syrup
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- About 1/2 cup milk, at room temperature

# **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Preheat the waffle iron to the regular setting.
- 2. For the waffles: Toss together the zucchini and carrots in a bowl. Mix the flour, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg and salt in a separate bowl, then toss with the zucchini and carrots to coat them. In a separate pitcher, mix the buttermilk, melted butter, granulated sugar, vanilla and eggs. Pour the buttermilk mixture over the zucchini mixture, stirring gently.
- For the syrup: Mix together the cream cheese, powdered sugar, maple syrup and vanilla in a bowl. Add enough milk to thin it to a syrup texture. Set aside. (If your syrup is lumpy, you can strain it for a smoother finish.)
- 4. Spray the waffle iron with nonstick cooking spray and scoop in the batter. Cook until golden, about 5 minutes depending on your waffle iron. Repeat with the remaining batter.
- 5. Serve the waffles drizzled with the syrup.



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

# **Gentleness Is Love's Humility**

Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, GENTLENESS, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

GENTLENESS is not to be misunderstood as weakness or a willingness to let others always have their way. Instead, this is the supernatural ability in the Spirit's power not to demand control or be extreme in our responses. Rather, we can submit to God's control over whatever situation we are in.

Biblical GENTLENESS is "strength under control," in fact, the Greek word translated in Galatians 5:23 "GENTLENESS" came from a term that was used of a wild horse that had become obedient to the bit and bridle. It was therefore not the lack of power, but great power under the control of a master.

Often times we may feel like if we are being GENTLE, we are allowing people to use or take advantage of us, this is NOT true. Christianity does not mean being soft spoken, weak, easily intimidated, it is strength under control and the Holy Spirit will help us to do this.



Paul says to us: Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Or do you not realize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you fail to meet the test! 2 Corinthians 13:5 (ESV)

Consider the following when doing a self-examination: Am I being down to earth (humility), having a quiet ego (humility), being quick to let things go (forgiveness), having a soft and supportive demeanor (kindness), and being oriented toward others (kindness). Does this describe you?

Listen my friend, "Fruit" grows out of life, the life of the Spirit (Galatians 5:25). The Spirit produces living fruit. The virtues of the fruit of the Spirit grow out of fellowship with God. Fruit grows as a branch from a vine (John 15:5). The Holy Spirit produces the fruit of Christlikeness. The fruit of the Spirit naturally flows from walking in the Spirit (Galatians 5:16).

We are created in the likeness and image of God, for His purpose, and we are to abide in Him and produce Spiritual Fruit.



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
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
# "Wise Words" By: Hayes Wise Second Chance

Who never said anything nice.



# **CLAYBANK MASTER GARDENERS**

Greetings Gardeners!

August 2024

Is this summer heat beating you up? This gardener is finding the early morning humidity almost suffocating, but by early evening the outdoors feels more tolerable, and with frequent hydration breaks the yard can get a little attention. "You can do a lot in five minutes" a wise lady once told me, and with that in mind I head outside and find out it is quite true! A cool wet towel around the neck also helps.

- •Short bursts of heavy rain are not a substitute for a good deep watering with the hose, once or twice a week. Shallow watering for a couple minutes does more damage than help, because it encourages the roots to stay near the top of the soil drying out the shrub or plant much faster. Remember, plants in pots also dry out much faster than plants in the soil. If the leaves are curling up, they are conserving moisture and are saying, "I'm thirsty!
- •At our July Master Gardener meeting Paige Stephens introduced us to turning our gardening interests indoors to various types of terrariums, using either rare cactus or tropical plants. She demonstrated various ways to grow unusual plants in entire

mini-ecosystems using tiny creatures to help decompose leaf matter and clean the terrarium, even some with mini water features.

This information is for those of you who don't have your affairs in order.

1.Make sure all bank accounts have direct beneficiaries. The beneficiary need only go to the bank with your death certificate and an ID of their own.

2.- TOD = Transfer On Death deed if you own a home. Completing this document and filing it with the court saves your heirs thousands. This document allows you to transfer ownership of your home to your designee. All they need to do is take their ID and your Death Certificate and they will then have the deed signed over. Doing this will avoid the home having to go through probate.

3.- Living Will: Allows one to put in writing exactly what you want done in the event you cannot speak for yourself when it comes to healthcare decisions.

4- Durable Power of Attorney: Allows one to designate a person to make legal decisions if one is no longer competent to do so.

5- Power of Attorney for Healthcare: This document allows one to designate someone to make healthcare decisions for their person.

6- Last Will and Testament: Designates to whom personal belongings will go too.

7- Funeral Planning Declaration: States one's wishes as far as disposition of the body and the service/s.
8- If the above documents are completed, you can AVOID probate. If all the above is not done, you have to open an estate account at the bank. All money that doesn't have direct beneficiaries goes into this account. You have to have your executor to open the estate

account. The executor also has to publicize your death in the newspaper or post publication at the courthouse, to allow anyone to make a claim on your property. - It's a complete nuisance.

9- Make a list of all banks and account numbers, all investment institutions with account numbers, lists of credit cards, utility accounts, etc. Leave clear instructions as to how and when these things are paid. Make sure heirs knows where life insurance policies are located.

10- Make 100% sure SOMEONE knows your Apple ID, bank ID account logins and passwords!

11.- Make sure you have titles for all automobiles, campers, motorcycles etc

12- MOST IMPORTANTLY!- Talk with those closest to you and make all your wishes KNOWN. Talk to those whom you've designated, as well as those close to you whom you did not designate. - Do this to explain why your decisions were made and to avoid any lingering questions or hurt feelings.

Hope this lights a spark to encourage all your friends and family to take care of these things and to make it easier for those we all leave behind.


