

Medicare Minute

"Medicare Part A Part 1"

On a Medicare card Part A will have the word "Hospital" beside it. Because of that Medicare Part A is most commonly known as the inpatient or hospitalization part of Medicare. This means when a Medicare beneficiary is admitted into the hospital most of the services that are received are filed under Medicare Part A. This sounds simple but sometimes it's not.

Medicare Part A has a deductible of \$1,632 per benefit period. Notice two things here. First is the deductible of \$1,632. If you are admitted into the hospital and had Original Medicare only, you would owe the first \$1,632 of your stay. This deductible covers hospital services, including semiprivate rooms, meals, general nursing, drugs as part of your inpatient treatment, and other hospital services and supplies.

The second thing to notice is the term "benefit period". This tells you the deductible is not an annual deductible but could hit you more than once in a calendar year. A "benefit period" begins when you are discharged from a hospital or skilled nursing facility and ends when you haven't received any inpatient care for 60 consecutive days. If you are admitted as an inpatient after the 60 days of no inpatient care a new benefit period begins, meaning another \$1,632 deductible. Also if you are confined to the hospital for 60 consecutive days your deductible will cover you but on the 61st day you will begin paying a coinsurance.

The good news is for most Medicare beneficiaries Part A is free. Free meaning you don't pay a premium for it. The reason for this is while you are working you pay 1.45% of your pay check into Medicare. If you did that for 40 quarters you're entitled to Part A for free. Next week will discuss the other benefits of Medicare Part A.





building, at 267 Claude Posey Road.

According to Colbert County Schools Superintendent, Chris Hand, Meal Barrel Project Director, Penny Freeman, contacted the district's central office to inquire whether the school system had any unused facilities available for the nonprofit's use.

Hand told Freeman about the middle school building.

"They were requesting to use a building that has been sitting vacant since 2007," Hand said, noting that school board policy has provisions that allow the district's facilities to be used by organizations for appropriate purposes something they have always supported in the past.

"We were able to make this available to them without conflicting with any functions of the school system." Hand said that the building, while in "poor condition," is solid structurally.

In a Memorandum of Agreement between the board of education and the Meal Barrel Project. it was agreed that the use of the building would be rent-free. However, the nonprofit will assume all costs related to utilities, maintenance, and operation. The agreement stands for one year with the option to renew.

Freeman expressed her gratitude to the school board and Hand "for their efforts in helping [the Meal Barrel Project] secure warehouse space."

"Having the use the old Cherokee Middle School building is a tremendous blessing for the Meal Barrel Project and our community," she said. "We are deeply grateful for this chance to keep our services running smoothly while we work towards a centrally located facility to better serve our clientele.'

Freeman noted that ne location "may the location significant cause inconvenience,

particularly for those who currently walk to receive donations, but she assured those dependent on the Meal Barrel Project the organization is 'committed to continuing [its] services without interruption."

She said that there is currently an ongoing search for a more centralized satellite location in the Shoals that could be used for donations with the middle school to be used as a warehouse. "A centrally located donation center is ideal, because it would be more accessible to the majority of those we currently serve, reducing the barriers to receiving the help they need," she explained.

She said the goal of the Meal Barrel Project is to "minimize the strain" on those who utilize its services, ensuring they are able to obtain food and other essential resources without additional hardship.

The need for volunteers also foremost on Freeman's mind she noted that a central location makes engaging volunteers easier.

In the meantime, she encouraged churches, businesses and community members who are able to assist in transportation needs.

Freeman said those willing to volunteer delivering food can contact her directly at 256-810-4289.

The Meal Barrel Project's move results from an April 15 vote by the Sheffield City Council to discontinue the nonprofit's lease of Armory building. The building is slated to become a city garage.

Freeman said that the Meal Barrel Project said remains "committed to finding a permanent, convenient location to continue [its] mission of combatting food insecurity and uplifting those in need."

"proved" to Sally that these people were legitimate. They informed her that she had to make a \$900 dollar cash payment immediately or they would throw her in jail. She was given the address of a local convenience store where she was to meet the deputy for the exchange. She was warned not to tell anyone about this or she would be thrown in jail.

Okay, I know some of you are saying, "How could anyone possibly fall for that?" But these people are good. Once they get a good hook into the "fear"

section of your brain, rational thought takes a back seat and scammers can play you like a puppet.

Her husband, also a close friend of mine, was just starting his first cup of coffee when he heard his wife, clearly in distress, talking on the phone with the deputy. She made an urgent "zip your mouth" motion to him as she was gathering up her keys and purse. She very briefly explained to him that she had to transfer some money or she was going to be arrested. Before my friend could even

take a sip of coffee, she was running out the door. He tried to stop her to ask what the heck was going on but it was too late: She had already taken the bait and left her husband standing in his underwear in the driveway. Her husband tried calling to let her know it was a scam to no avail.

Sally received \$900 from the ATM and proceeded to a shabby convenience store in Seven Points, Florence. She pulled into the parking lot and that's when the terror thankfully released her and rationality took over again. Sally relayed to me that it was at this point that "This is a scam" entered her mind. She sat there for a moment mulling over the consequences of simply driving off and finally did just that - drove off.

I suspect the scammer would have met her, introduced

himself, taken her \$900 cash, and promised that the warrant would be removed from her record. However, the scammer very well could have actually "arrested" her and Very Bad Things could have happened.

In case you don't know, caller ID can be faked. The sheriff or police will never phone you to request money; they will simply show up at your home and arrest you. So if you receive a call like this, call the police and let them handle it.

Rules Of The Road For Boats

Legal issues arising from boat accidents include negligence, product liability, failure to adhere to safety regulations, and operator error. Depending on the circumstances of the incident, the outcomes often involve settlements and sometimes criminal charges.

We handle boat accidents and have seen several cases where people operating boats will hit another boat or another person. As you would expect, propellers cause major injuries. Boats, like automobiles, have rules that govern their operation and regulations that require specific safety equipment on each vessel.

There are rules for boats that are different from those of cars. An example is Alabama statute §33-5-25, which imposes a legal duty on the operator of any boat involved in an accident. The operator must render assistance as necessary to save others affected by the accident and provide their name and their boat's identification to any injured persons.

Other than sailboats, rowboats, or canoes, a boater's safety course and a test are required to be certified to operate a boat. The boat has to be registered in the name of the person who owns it. The rules and regulations for the safe operation of a watercraft deal with right-of-way, among other issues. Drivers of automobiles have red lights, green lights, stop signs, and markings on the road to indicate the right-of-way.

In a boat, the right-of-way changes based on the vessel being operated and the type of boat that is either yielding or has the right-of-way. Commercial barges have the right-of-way as they can't stop within a half mile. Sailboats typically have the right-of-way because existing wind conditions limit their direction of travel. Power boats intending to overtake or pass other power boats have rules that dictate the correct side to pass or overtake and specific horn signals that can or must be given.

Commercial boats have stringent rules and are subject to inspection and regular maintenance. Required safety equipment is tested regularly and can include items such as bilge pumps and expected items such as life vests. Cruise ship captains have been convicted of manslaughter for failing to abide by maritime safety

As someone who loves boating, the best advice I can give is to keep a proper lookout. That's a duty imposed by law, but it's also common sense when you're on the water.



respectively and was the owner/broker from 1975–2008.

Bill was instrumental in establishing the Muscle Shoals Board of Realtors and implementing the MLS system locally.

Bill loved his community, loved the people in it, and was an encourager. His rather ominous stature could be intimidating. It was for me at first sight in the 80's. However, his

reassuring voice and captivating smile could easily bring you around.

He knew how to be a boss and how to be an advocate. My mother was a realtor in the area for 25 years, and she worked for Bill at Coussons

Realty in the latter part of her career. She thought the world of him, and she was not alone.

Bill was wise and he was greatly respected. He was frank when he needed to be, but any advice was solid and consistent.

I heard Bill's wellgrounded perspective a few times in local meetings. was often conveyed while describing how and where he might have made some mistakes, or obtained results that may have been personally disappointing. That simultaneously demonstrated his humility and allowed others to contemplate direction and consider some possible pitfalls for themselves.

And besides enjoying a round or two of golf on occasion, Bill came in contact with a lot of people outside of his work environment.

Again, from his obituary, Bill was voted Realtor of the Year several times and he

achieved the Realtor Emeritus Award. He also built hundreds of homes in the area and developed Heathrow, Heatherton, Heatherhurst, Ryan's Place, Beckman Place, Bridlewood, Winborne Park, Brannon Wood, Briarcliff, and several others. Bill was named the Alabama Home Builder of the Year, 1984.

Bill was active in the community throughout his career, serving on

many boards i n c l u d i n g the YMCA, Muscle Shoals Home Builders Association, the Shoals Chamber of Commerce, SEDA, UNA's Board of

Trustees, the Port Authority, the

Shoals Area Association of Realtors, the Alabama Homebuilders Association, and a cofounder, and longtime board member of the Alabama Home Builders Self Insurance Fund.

He also served on the Florence City Council and was involved in other local works of which few were aware.

Bill had been out of the public eye for a while, caring for his ailing wife and then taking it easy himself in recent years, although he actively sold real estate until 2019.

We can recognize professional and personal accomplishments for a lot of local individuals. However, many of those aren't praised as readily by the people with whom they interacted or came in contact.

That might be Bill's greatest legacy.







Dear Dave,


I've made a lot of stupid money mistakes in the past. Even though I finally paid off six figures in debt a few years ago and am in control of my finances for the first time in my life, I'm having a hard time forgiving myself for all the dumb things I did. I have an emergency fund and other savings set aside, and I'm almost ready to buy a house. But it seems like there's still a cloud hanging over my head from all my bad decisions. How do I stop obsessing over my past financial mistakes?

Dear Brea,

If you've had enough determination to pay off six figures' worth of debt and to build savings on top of that in the last few years, you're doing a phenomenal job! Most people would just make excuses or give up, but you educated yourself, put your head down and stomped out all that debt. I'm very proud of you, hon. What you've done speaks volumes about your character and selfdiscipline.

The late Maya Angelou once said, "Do the best you can until you know better. Then when you know better, do better." That's the key for you, I think. Doing dumb things doesn't always mean you're a dumb person. Sometimes, we just don't have the knowledge or guidance we need to do things the right way. But once you learned a few things and saw there was a better way—a smarter way—you jumped in and made incredible things happen. You cleaned up your finances, and you changed your entire future for the better. I think that's pretty cool. And you know what else? It makes you a pretty smart lady.

I think part of your struggle may be the fact that you've spent more time making the wrong decisions with money than you've spent making the right ones. That's understandable. But time will help heal that struggle. It'll distance you



emotionally from the old you until you're confident in the new you—not just in your actions, but in your heart and mind. I mean, think about it this way: If you violated trust with a friend, how would you rebuild it? First, it would take time. And second, it would take a series of trustworthy actions.

Let's say someone had drinking problem for a long time, but they've been dry for three months. After three months, their spouse still might not trust them with the checkbook. I totally get that. It's a good start, but it's not like they haven't had a drink in three years. That's where time comes into play. The more time they demonstrate a solid pattern of not going back to the bottle, the more evidence they create for why others should trust them.

I think you've developed a pretty good track record of being smart with your money, Brea. So cut yourself some slack. If God is willing to forgive us for the really bad things we say and do, you need to be able to extend a little grace to yourself for the dumb things in your financial past.




