ALBION - The Albion Police Department would like to issue a warning to dirt bike owners within the village and surrounding area of a recent theft and a separate attempted theft.

In both instances, a U-Haul moving truck was used in a burglary of a garage and separately the attempted theft from a yard. Both incidents occurred after midnight between the hours of 2-4 a.m. and the offenders have not yet been identified.

We are urging residents to take the following precautions to protect their property:

- 1. Secure your dirt bikes: Ensure your dirt bikes are locked and stored in a secure location, preferably out of sight from the
- 2. Install security cameras: Use security cameras and alarm systems to deter potential thieves and to provide evidence in case a theft occurs.
- 3. Be vigilant: Report any suspicious activity involving U-Haul trucks during late hours. If possible, take note of the vehicle's license plate number and any distinguishing features.

If you have any information about these thefts or if you witness any suspicious activity, please contact the Albion Police Department at (585) 589-5627 or the Orleans County Sheriff's Office Dispatch at (585) 589-5527. Body of man, 39, recovered from canal in Hulberton

HULBERTON – A man drown in the Erie Canal on July 30 in Hulberton.

The Orleans County Sheriff's Office recovered the body of Robert Bristol, age 39, of Hulberton in the Town of Murray.


An acquaintance reported Mr. Bristol missing at approximately 5:25 tthe morning of July 30 Sheriff's deputies conducted an extensive search of the area using the Sheriff's K-9 Unit, Drone Unit, and Marine Division along with deputies on foot, Sheriff Chris Bourke

Deputy Jeff Cole and K-9 Otto from the Sheriff's office tracked Bristol from his last known location directly to the bank of the Erie Canal near the Hulberton lift bridge. Bristol was found submerged in water close to the area where the K-9 track ended.

The Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Murray Joint Fire District, Orleans County Emergency Management Office and the Monroe County Sheriff's Office Dive Team.

Sheriff's Investigators are continuing the investigation into the circumstances surrounding the death.

"At this time, we have reason to believe that consumption of alcoholic beverages may have contributed to Mr. Bristol falling in the canal," Bourke said. "The body was transported to the Monroe County Medical Examiner's Office for further investigation."




