September is National Preparedness Month. The lessons of Hurricane Katrina taught us that companion animals must be included in emergency plans, or the results will be disastrous.

Through the years, we have taught that animals should be evacuated with you and a 72-hour emergency kit for each companion animal would be wise. Included in the kit should be food, bottled water, veterinary records, and first aid supplies (including any medicines required).

There are other tips that could prove to be lifesaving measures for your animals:

1. Make sure dogs and cats have current identification attached to the collars; however, a microchip will not be lost or pulled off. Please consider calling your veterinary clinic today and asking for their microchip services. Or, watch for our free microchip clinics!

2. Always keeps a current photo of your pets. During a widespread disaster, a picture could be proof that the lost pet is yours.

3. Keep veterinary records, including proof of the current rabies vaccination, in the 72-hour kit. However, also keep a copy of the rabies certificate in other areas. It would be wise to have a complete set of the records in a family member's

home in another area. After a disaster, more wild animals are going to be in populated areas. Local, state, and federal authorities may ask for proof of protection against rabies.

4. When the forecasters first issue warnings, bring your pets inside. Animals have an uncanny ability to sense weather changes, and their behavior may change. They may run or hide in fear.

5. During times of emergency, animals will be under stress. Feed them familiar foods, but also keep a supply of moist food available. They may be more likely to eat it, and the moisture content of the canned food will help in preserving water supplies.

6. Keep a supply of newspapers on hand for sanitation purposes.

Planning in advance for emergencies is always a prudent thing for pet owners to do.



Union Made

Trade unions played a crucial role in establishing Labor Day as a holiday. "Union Made" has long been a point of pride for American industries, as in this sign advertising Sweet-Orr clothing, which sold for \$7,380 at a Morphy auction. Talk about the value of hard work! The sign celebrates workers as not just the makers of the clothes, but as the brand's clientele.

The story goes that James Orr returned from the Gold Rush without gold, but with a business idea. Having seen firsthand how easily prospectors' work clothes were damaged, he persuaded his nephews Clayton and Clinton Sweet to join him in starting a company to make high-quality off-the-shelf workwear.

The Sweet-Orr company started making overalls in Wappingers Falls, New York, in 1871. By the 1880s, it had an iconic advertising strategy: Representatives would hold events challenging groups of six men to play tug-of-war with a Sweet-Orr garment, showing the clothes' resistance to tearing. This was supposedly inspired by feedback from customers claiming that their lives had been saved by the strength of their Sweet-Orr clothing. This strategy soon made it into the company's logo.

This sign, depicting such a tug-ofwar, dates to about 1920. Although the original New York factory has closed, the Sweet-Orr company is still operating today.

. Pressed glass, also called pat-A tern glass, is a popular collectible. Pieces are usually inexpensive, but rare patterns by known makers can sell for hundreds, even thousands of dollars. Pressed glass sells well online, at general antiques shows and at small

local auctions, but if you are planning to sell the entire collection, you may want to find an auction that specializes in antique glass. Collectors' clubs can help you find more information and possibly connect you with buyers. The Early American Pattern Glass Society (www.eapgs.org) is a good place to start. Or look for a glass club in your area. There are many listed in the Business Directory on Kovels.com.

Treasurer's Office Recognized for **Achieving Accreditation**



TWO DPS SCHOOLS SURPASS STATE AVERAGES IN SOL PASS RATES, OTHER SCHOOLS SEE SIGNIFICANT GAINS IN STUDENT PERFORMANCE

The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) recently released the annual pass rates on the Standards of Learning (SOL) assessments from the 2023-24 school year, in which Danville Public Schools (DPS) saw improvements in achievement levels over the past several years. School Results

Galileo Magnet High School's pass rates for reading are 21 percentage points higher than the state average at 94%. Likewise, Galileo's math pass rates are 91%, 20 percentage points higher than the state average, and their science pass rates are 78%, 10 percentage points higher than the state average. Forest Hills Elementary School pass rates exceeded the state average in reading, math, and science.

Individually, some schools saw significant increases in their pass rates over the previous year. Compared to the 2022-23 school year, George Washington High School's reading pass rates increased to 69% from 60% and math pass rates to 68% from 34%. In 2023-24, O.T. Bonner Middle School increased its reading pass rate to 58% from 48% and math pass rate to 56% from 36% over the 2022-23 school year. Westwood Middle School also increased its science pass rate to 61% over 41% in 2022-23.

While not listed in the released pass rates by the VDOE since it is a program, the Activ8 STEM Academy saw exemplary student achievement in its first year with a 90% pass rate in both mathematics and reading. DPS also saw some movement in achievement among two student groups

The City of Danville Treasurer's office received its accreditation from the Treasurers' Association of Virginia (TAV) on June 24, 2024.



The Office Accreditation program is a voluntary professional certificate program overseen by the Treasurers' Association of Virginia. Seventy treasurer's offices received accreditation this year.

While it is not required for any treasurer's office to be accredited, receiving accreditation acknowledges that the office meets the statewide best practices for performance in treasury management.

As part of the accreditation process, offices must successfully pass an outside audit with no findings of material weakness. The rigorous accreditation process also requires proof of continuing education such as completion of an ethics course by the treasurer (or a principal officer) and educational requirements for all staff. Accredited offices are required to have written policies in place addressing areas such as personnel, customer service, and delinquent collections.

"These offices exemplify our Association's standards of excellence and integrity," says Treasurers' Association President Jody Acosta. "We are proud of the commitment and dedication shown by the 70 offices which received accreditation this year."

About the Treasurers' Association - The Treasurers' Association has 180 active members across Virginia's cities, counties, and towns. Their goal is to utilize education and networking to raise professionalism and fiscal leadership in Virginia's Treasurers and their staffs. The Association hosts multiple classes and conferences to support its members and enable offices to stay current in practices and standards. Members adhere to a strict code of ethics and to the highest standards of performance as they seek to administer faithfully the funds entrusted to them by the citizens of Virginia. in math: Black students at 12 percentage points higher over the previous year and Economically Disadvantaged students at 11 percentage points higher over the previous year.

In addition, several schools saw continued improvements in their reading and math scores, including Westwood, Galileo, Park Avenue Elementary, Schoolfield Elementary, and Woodberry Hills Elementary.

"Our schools have been working incredibly hard in previous years to increase student achievement," School Board Chair Ty'Quan Graves said. "We are excited to see that our schools are improving and excelling." **District Results**

As a district, pass rates for reading were 53%, a steady improvement over four years from 43% in 2020-21. DPS has not seen pass rates at this level since the 2017-18 school year. Likewise, district math pass rates were 49%, a steady improvement from 30% in 2020-21.

"While we still have work to do, we are proud of the gains we have been able to make, especially because we are seeing numbers we haven't seen in several years," Superintendent Dr. Angela Hairston said.

Other Improvements


DPS also continues to monitor data for students who are not yet SOL tested. Students in kindergarten through second grade receive the Phonological Awareness Literacy Screener (PALS), which monitors their knowledge of literacy fundamentals, including alphabet recognition, letter sounds, and spelling.

With data from the PALS assessments, the division can tell whether students are reaching their important benchmarks. Since the 2020-21 school year, the percentage of students on or above benchmarks in grades K-2 has increased, with 75% of kindergarten students reaching benchmarks in 2023-24, along with 64% of first graders and 65% of second graders Tutoring Efforts


This year, in accordance with Governor Glenn Youngkin's ALL In plan, DPS launched a rigorous tutoring program, which included before, after, and Saturday school tutoring. Through the tutoring programs, the division reclaimed approximately 12,715 instructional hours missed. In addition, the division saw a 23% reduction in students who were chronically absent, with Forest Hills Elementary, Galileo Magnet High, the Activ8 STEM Academy, the Virtual Academy, Park Avenue Elementary, Schoolfield Elementary, O.T. Bonner Middle, and Westwood Middle demonstrating excellent attendance during the 23-24 school year. Next Steps

Going forward, the division will continue to work on literacy, with further implementation of the Virginia Literacy Act and targeted work with Reading Specialists.

The Virginia Department of Education is expected to update division School Quality Profiles, including accreditation ratings and on-time graduation rates by the end of September




