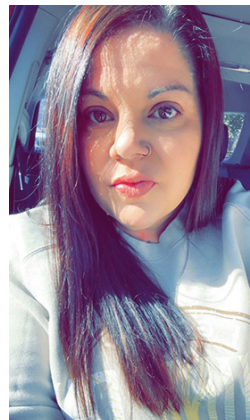

In the Danville and Pittsylvania County area, there are three animal organizations or shelters: the Danville Area Humane Society, the Pittsylvania Pet Center, and the SPCA of Pittsylvania County.

Each one is different. The Danville Area Humane Society is a non-profit with a contract to operate the public animal shelter for Danville, the Pet Center is operated by the county, and the SPCA is a non-profit, foster-based rescue.

While each entity has its own policies and procedures and while there may be some disagreement in philosophies, there are two things that all agree on: 1. Spaying and neutering is absolutely necessary, and 2. Foster homes are needed.

We started using foster homes in 2000. At that time, we used them for special needs cases. Our first one was a very pregnant beagle. A family wanted to adopt her and were willing to foster her until her puppies were weaned.

Through the years, our foster program has evolved. The one constant is always that foster homes are in short supply. The reason for that is primarily because so many foster families wind up adopting the animal! That is a very good thing.

A few years ago, the family of Annette Nolen Ferguson established a foster fund in her

memory. This fund helps pay for food and veterinary treatment for animals in foster homes. Most people, however, tell us they are happy to pay for the expenses.

Our biggest need involves litters of kittens and puppies who come to us without their mother need to be in a home where they can be bottle-fed, taught basic puppy/kitten skills, and then brought back to us for adoption when they are able to eat solid food. We currently have seven kittens who were in foster homes and then came back to be adopted!

Antique glass

Identifying antique glass isn't always easy. If you're lucky, a piece may be marked, like this Phenomen vase, which is signed "Loetz Austria" on its pontil (the spot on the base where the blown molten glass was attached to a pontil for shaping).



Loetz is one of the most famous European glassmakers of the late 19th to early 20th centuries. This vase is from its popular Phenomen line.

Proof of its maker, not to mention its complex shape and silvery iridescent sheen, brought its price to \$4,940 at a Rago/Wright auction. But glass isn't always marked. While it can take an expert to authenticate glass, it's helpful to be able to recognize some of the characteristic shapes and colors made by particular glassmakers.

Loetz received patents for iridescent glass in 1895 and 1896, shortly after Tiffany launched the fashion with its famous Favrite glass. Loetz produced several lines of iridescent glass, and Phenomen was its triumph, winning a Grand Prix award at the Paris Universal Exposition in 1900. It combines the beauty of iridescence with the technical expertise required to create its organic shapes and silvery pulled threads.

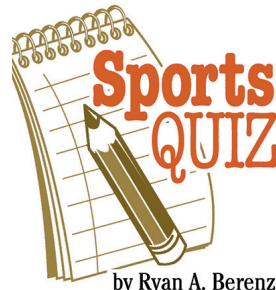

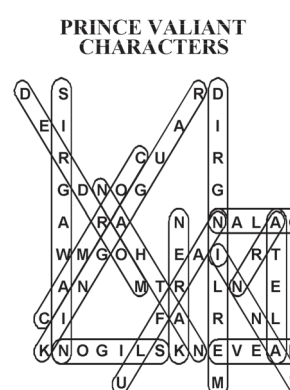
