When does the new "Mat-. lock" series that stars Kathy Bates release? Also, is her character related to the original Matlock, played by Andy Griffith? - C.U.







- * To fix a hole in drywall that requires a healthy helping of joint compound, you can cut a piece of screen slightly bigger than the hole and tack it to the inside of the drywall. You also can wad up a piece of aluminum foil and shove it in the hole, pressing it in a bit to create a recess for the compound. The foil will keep the compound at the site of the hole, allowing it to set up instead of fall down.
- * "I recently did a little work on my car, and afterward I washed and waxed it. My tools got pretty grimy, so I cleaned them too. Since I had the wax out, I used it on several of them to keep them from rusting in storage." -- via email
- * Add a softener sheet to your vacuum bag or canister when you change it. While you clean, you will distribute the good smell throughout your home. You also can use a cotton ball scented with your favorite essential oil or even perfume.
- * If you have trouble threading needles, try spritzing some hairspray on your finger, and twist the end of the thread. It will keep the fibers together and stiffen it enough to be easily threaded.
- * It is possible to save a bit of money on car maintenance if you can't change your own oil. Learn common add-ons you will be offered at oil and lube places. Air filters are surprisingly easy to replace on your own, and so are windshield wipers. Very often, the staff of auto-supply chains will lend you tools or even assist you right in the parking lot.
- * Got bug bites? Try these for some relief from the itching of insect bites: apple cider vinegar; a paste of baking soda and water, allowed to dry on the bite; a similar paste of meat tenderizer and water; or antiperspirant.



Cinnamon Roll Cake



INGREDIENTS

Cake:

2 cups (284 g) all-purpose flour 1 ½ cups (318 g) granulated sugar ½ teaspoon baking soda

2 teaspoons baking powder ½ teaspoon salt

1 1/3 cups (302 g) light or regular sour cream 3/2 cup (151 g) salted butter, softened

1 teaspoon vanilla

3 large eggs

Cinnamon Swirl:

34 cup (170 g) salted butter, very soft (but not melted)

34 cup (159 g) light brown sugar

1 tablespoon flour

1 tablespoon ground cinnamon

Glaze:

2 cups (228 g) powdered sugar 4-5 tablespoons milk ½ teaspoon vanilla

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Lightly grease a 9X13-inch baking pan with nonstick cooking spray and set aside.

For the cake, in a large bowl, combine all the cake batter ingredients and mix well. Spread the batter evenly in the prepared pan.

For the swirl, in a medium bowl, stir together the butter, light brown sugar, flour and cinnamon until well-mixed and smooth. Dollop the cinnamon swirl mixture by heaping spoonfuls over the cake batter.

Use a butter knife to swirl the cinnamon mixture into the TOP of the cake batter (don't press the knife all the way to the bottom of the pan - swirl just into the top half of the cake batter). Try not to over swirl or over mix. A few generous loops through the batter should be just fine. Bake the cake for 30-32 minutes until the top springs back lightly to the touch and a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean or with a few moist crumbs.

For the glaze, whisk together the powdered sugar, milk and vanilla until smooth. Pour the glaze evenly over the warm cake.

Serve the cake warm or at room temperature.


