# Little Emily Lake Park Crow Wing County's newest gem



Little Emily Lake Park is the perfect venue for a party,reunion, or a family day out. Your family will enjoy walking trails, playing at the playground, catching some sun at the beach, outdoor dining in the pavilion, launching your kayak and canoe or wetting a line at the pier. In the heart of Crow Wing County, a new outdoor paradise awaits adventurers and families alike. Little Emily Lake Park, recently dedicated by the county board, is poised to become a beloved local destination, and Tom Strack, supervisor of environmental services with the county's Department of Land Services, has the inside scoop.

It is located at 21571 Papoose Road, Emily. For those unfamiliar with the area, finding the park might take a little navigation.



As you head north on Highway 6 from Emily, keep an eve out for the iconic Wigwam Motel on your right and the Pickled Loon on your left. The park's tasteful sign signals the turnoff down a winding road, where visitors are greeted by a delightful surprise: a pristine lake surrounded by lush hardwood forests.

### **A Rich History**

The land that now hosts Little Emily Lake Park has an intriguing backstory. It went tax-forfeit in the 1940s, previously serving as a hub for timber management, public hunting, and recreation. Today, it's transformed into a haven for outdoor enthusiasts, with over 1,000 acres of public lands in the vicinity. "Our mission was to create another county park for residents and visitors to enjoy," Strack explains, highlighting the park's dedication to accessibility and natural beauty.



**Amenities That Shine** 

Officially opened in August 2024, Little Emily Lake Park boasts a variety of amenities designed to enhance the visitor experience. The centerpiece? A beautiful 150-foot swimming beach featuring a sandy bottom that beckons swimmers and sunbathers alike. Adjacent to the beach, a covered picnic pavilion, equipped with tables and

grills, invites families to enjoy

outdoor dining amid nature. For those seeking adventure, the park offers 3.25 miles of granite walking trails, perfect for leisurely strolls or energetic hikes. A fishing pier extends into (the approximately 99 acres) Little Emily Lake, ideal for casting a line and enjoying the tranquil surroundings. There's even a dedicated canoe and kayak launch, making it easy to ex-



plore the lake's serene waters.

### A Collaborative Effort

The park's development was a community effort, with local contractors such as Holmvig Excavating and Hy-Tec Construction contributing their expertise. The county staff took the reins on layout and design, ensuring the park met the needs of all visitors. Construction of the park began in August of 2023 and most of the work was completed by spring/ summer of 2024. The grand opening of the park was held in August 2024.

Notably, the park is exclusively non-motorized, encouraging a peaceful environment. Bicycles are not allowed on the trails. To accommodate motorized fun, the parking lot has a dedicated trailhead parking area for the Emily-Outing ATV Trail and users of the ATV Trail are encouraged to stop at the park and use the amenities.

### **Visit Before Winter Sets In**

Little Emily Lake Park is not just a spot for recreation; it's an ideal venue for small gatherings, reunions, or simply a day of fun with family. Whether you're walking the trails, playing at the playground, splashing at the beach, or enjoying a picnic in the pavilion, there's something for everyone.

Best of all, entrance to the park is free! Open from sunrise to sunset, it's a delightful Continued on Page 2


# Mille Lacs Lake hogs back open






