SIGNPOSTS AS YARD ART



Tumbleweed Smith

Danny Bollinger of Dallas is a popular figure at Canton's First Monday Sale where he has five stalls. He's had them for years. Each stall is full of junk.

"Yeah, I collect junk," says Danny. "You wouldn't believe how many people love junk. I have trailers full of it. It's real junk and Tumbleweed Smith people buy it."

A few years ago, Danny did something unusual.

"During the Covid shutdown, which lasted a lot longer than I thought it was going to, I would hang out in my front yard," says Danny. "So, for years and years, I would always ask people what their home town was. I had this idea, you know in the TV series MASH where they have the signposts like Seoul, 500 miles or whatever it is. I said I'm going to do that.

When people get a new fence, they put the old fence on the curb for the trash people to come get it. So I went around my neighborhood and I got the wood from the old fences. Then I went to Home Depot and I got eight 4 by 4s that were eight feet tall, spaced them out and planted them in my front yard. People walk by my house that is right by White Rock Lake. The area neighborhoods lead right by my house to get to the lake. Nobody was working at that time so they were walking, walking their dog or their kids and I would just ask them 'what's your home town?' I would sit on the tailgate of my pickup and paint the name of their hometown on a fence board in different colors and nail it to the signpost and it ended up, there were 278 different hometowns.

There were a lot of people in my neighborhood from all over I would put an arrow on some of the boards indicating the direction of the town and how many miles it was. There are a lot of funny stories that came out of there. I put Hell on one of the boards, painted it in red and put an arrow down. That one really upset some people. Then I put Heaven with an arrow up."

The signs were three inches by three feet. There were about 34 or 35 per pole. Someone didn't like it so they called the city and made a complaint. The city inspector came out to investigate.

"The woman inspector knocked on my door and I talked to her and she's like, 'look, here's the thing, you know they complained about your yard but it's art, so you can have art in your yard all you want.' So I said thank you. I had art in my yard. She loved it. I told her what it was, she had no problem with it."

Danny had a vard sale and a man came by and bought the entire display.

"He lived about three blocks away and he put them on his barn, his shed in his back vard so they're all on his shed. Dang, I wish I had them back."

Danny published a magazine about basketball, had a variety of jobs and ended up as a photographer for the Dallas Mavericks for eighteen years.
