GOAL OF THE RFP

This RFP seeks a private sector business to operate the seasonal camp store concession for the patrons of Lakeside State Park, maintaining an inviting atmosphere and affordable product offerings for all patrons to enjoy. Licensee shall be responsible for all insurance, maintenance, and upkeep of the Premises in accordance with the License Documents contained in the RFP.

Historic Annual Park Attendance: ± 106,871

Historic Annual Camping Attendance: ± 73,002



Lakeside State Park offers an outstanding panoramic view of Lake Ontario and surrounding farms and fruit orchards. No swimming is allowed, but 274 campsites, four miles of hiking and biking trails, fishing along the lake front, picnic grounds, a disc golf course and playing fields bring thousands to the park. Winter activities include hiking, cross-country skiing, and snowmobiling. Lakeside State Park Shore Winds Disc Golf Course encompasses 2, 18-hole, disc golf courses dubbed Wind Rush Alley and The Beast. These well-designed courses are challenging while providing one of the most scenic views of any disc golf course in the United States.

The camp store concession is located in the center of the campground, next to the recreation building. The concession is approximately 1,708SF and includes a retail store area, storage area, employee bathroom, and laundromat, which is required to be operated by the Licensee. More info regarding the Premises and operation can be found in the RFP.

TERMS: License Term: Three years with possible extensions up to two (2) additional years. License Fee: Minimum \$500 annual flat fee. Utilities & Trash Removal: Licensee shall pay to State Parks \$600 annually for reimbursement of the cost of electricity. Licensee shall pay to State Parks \$275 annually for the reimbursement of the cost of trash removal and recycling services.

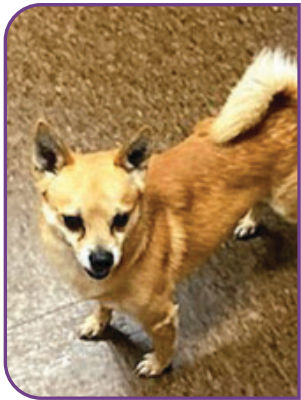

ORLEANS COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

PRESS RELEASE

On September 29, 2024 the Orleans County Sheriff's Office arrested a 14-year-old student of the Albion School District in connection with making a terroristic threat. The arrest took place following an investigation that began after a complaint was made to local authorities.

Upon receiving the complaint, Deputies and Investigators with the Sheriff's Office worked swiftly to assess the situation, interviewing witnesses, and gathering evidence. The investigation determined that the threat was made via a Snapchat post during a conversation with peers over a week ago.

The student was taken into custody without incident and is facing the charge of Making a Terroristic Threat, section 490.25 of the NYS Penal Law, a Class D Felony. The Sheriff's Office has been in contact with the Albion School District Administration to ensure that appropriate measures are in place to maintain a safe learning environment.

While this incident is concerning, the Sheriff's Office wants to reassure the community that swift action was taken to address the situation, and we encourage parents and guardians to have open discussions with their children about the seriousness of threats and the importance of reporting any concerning behavior.

Due to the restrictions of NYS law, the juvenile was released to the custody of the parents on an appearance ticket.

Tips for better job hunting

Follow these tips to increase your chances of getting a job offer:

- Update your resume. Having a solid resume is one of the most important parts of finding a job because it's an employer's first impression of you. Make sure all of your information is current and accurate. Double-check for any grammar or formatting errors and have another person look it over, too.
- Tailor your resume and cover letter. Your application materials should always be specific to the open role. You can start with one generic copy of each and then make changes based on the responsibilities and qualifications of the job you want. Search a job posting for keywords that you can add to your resume.
- Be prepared for anything. Throughout your job search, you may be surprised by what can happen. For example, if a company is urgently hiring, they may ask for an interview right away. Likewise, a company may get back to you with a job offer months later. Being flexible and ready for the unexpected can help you improve your chances of being hired.
- Act kindly to everyone. When entering a business, be kind to everyone you interact with. You never know if they will have input on an employer's hiring decision.
- Apply to jobs you are underqualified for. Although you should direct your focus on jobs you're qualified for, still feel free to apply to jobs where you may not check off every single requirement. If you think you are a good fit for the job, the employer may decide to give you an interview.
- Send follow-up emails. After talking to a recruiter or having an initial interview, always send a follow-up thank-you email the next day. Explain that you are still interested in the position and enjoyed speaking with them. This shows employers that you are courteous and professional.
- Keep track of your job applications. Keep an updated spreadsheet of the jobs you applied to and when. This way, you won't accidentally apply to a job twice and you can remember when to follow up with an employer.
- Learn job keywords. Since search engines and career websites use keywords to help you find jobs, learn which keywords correspond to the kind of job you want. Play around with different job titles that are similar to find a wider range of job postings.
- Ask for informational interviews. Reaching out to companies for informational interviews is a great way to show your interest and get to know more about their organization. By making a good impression during this meeting, they may remember you when they have a job opening.
- Be mindful of your online presence. Some hiring managers look at an applicant's social media to learn more about them. Always be mindful of the type of content you share on social media. Keep it courteous and professional. If you don't want an employer to see your postings, make sure to set your profiles to private.

Community Action honored by Chamber for myriad of services to local residents Superintendent Retires

An organization which exists to help people in challenging situations is being honored by the Orleans County Chamber of Commerce with their Community Service Award.

Community Action of Orleans and Genesee is under the leadership of Renee Hungerford, who the organization appreciates being recognized.

"I feel privileged to lead an agency that makes such a positive difference for our community," Hungerford said. "Our dedicated staff truly care about the people we assist and are focused on giving people the hope, support and services they need to become self-sufficient and overcome the ravages of poverty. We are grateful to the volunteers and donors who support our agency and make what we do possible. I am thrilled that our agency is being recognized by the Orleans Chamber of Commerce and has given us the opportunity to inform the community about the important work we do."

Community Action began 60 years ago, and has continued to grow and add programs and services to help needy families, while focusing on helping them become independent and self-sufficient.

Programs include ACT (helping youth ACT responsibly), Stone Soup Success/Food Rx (educating to prepare healthy meals), Child Care Resource and Referral, Early Head Start and Head Start, Weatherization and Energy Services, Main Street Thrifts, Gifts and More store, a Credit Recovery Program for Albion seniors, Emergency Services, holiday meals and gifts and the Eastern Orleans Community Center, which provides daily meals, a clothing depot and food giveaway.

At the agency's annual in-service day this summer, officials reported that during the previous year Community Action served 4,021 individuals, a 28% increase over the previous year and 75% more than 2021. In their goal to fight hunger, 1,541 individuals utilized one of their three food pantries, 914 individuals utilized a pop-up pantry distribution, 314 individuals received 5,405 prepared meals at the Eastern Orleans Community Center in Holley and 657 households received holiday meals.

In housing, another 311 individuals received assistance to avoid eviction and 129 individuals received assistance to avoid utility shut-off.

Head Start had 149 children enrolled, while 81 were in Early Head Start.

During the in-service event, Hungerford shared their goals looking ahead. She said their agency will make major improvements in many areas going forward, while continuing to focus on helping people become self-sufficient.

- 3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
