





Piedmont Pets

Cold temperatures and wind chill can threaten a pet's life; the following measures can help ensure your pet will have a comfortable winter:

Low temperatures are especially hard on shorthaired, young, and older animals.

All cats should be kept inside.

Salt and chemicals used to melt snow can burn a pet's foot pads and even the mouth when the pet licks the paws. After an outdoor walk, wipe your pet's feet with a damp towel.

Warm vehicle engines attract cats. Bang on your vehicle hood to scare away any cats before starting the engine.

Antifreeze is deadly poison, but the sweet taste attracts many animals. Make sure that animals do not have access to the antifreeze.

When it is snowing, pets can lose the scent of home. Keep pets under close supervision, and make sure your pet wears an identification tag.

Winter air can dry out animals' skin and make them itchy. Add a small amount of vegetable oil (with your veterinarian's approval) to the pet's diet.

It is prohibited in the City of Danville to have any companion animal tethered when the temperature is 32 degrees or below.

For outside dogs, a solid doghouse must be provided. The opening needs to be covered, either with a commercial door or a heavy, fabric flap. The house needs to be raised off the ground at least 2 inches. Cover the floor with cedar shavings to control parasites and to help retain the skin oil. The doghouse should be large enough to allow the dog to enter, turn around, and either sit or lie down comfortably. However, the house needs to be small enough to hold the pet's body heat in.

Owners of outside dogs must provide more food in the winter, because keeping warm depletes energy. Water bowls should be checked frequently to make sure the water has not frozen.

If you know of an animal that does not have adequate protection from the weather, we urge you to call us before conditions are too bad.

Puzzle Mugs

Collecting ceramics may be seen as traditional, even old-fashioned, but there is plenty of room for eccentricity. This puzzle mug by George E. Ohr is an unusual piece by an unconventional artist. There are holes in its sides; if you try to fill it and drink from it like an ordinary mug, the liquid spills out probably onto you. Puzzle mugs usually have a hollow portion, often in the handle, that works like a drinking straw. The trick is to know which holes

to cover and which to drink from. A puzzle mug is a fitting piece for Georg Ohr, who had a flair for the unusual. Ohr, known as "the Mad Potter of Biloxi," was born in 1857 and started working on his own as a potter in 1883. He made his pottery from very thin clay in twisted, folded shapes, glazed in rich colors. Ohr loved self-promotion and considered himself "the best potter in America," but sold little of his pottery and faded into obscurity. As if making up for lost time, Ohr's pottery now sells for high prices. This mug sold for \$2,250 at a Rago auction.

• I have this odd \$20 bill with markings and I don't know who to take it to for a value that I can trust. Can you please help me with this?

A. The markings on your bill look like part of the word "TELL-ER." They are probably from a teller stamp. When bank tellers bundle bills together to go into the vault, they wrap the bundle with a paper strap, then stamp the strap and add their initials to verify that they counted the bundle. Your bill was probably on top of a bundle where the teller's stamp slipped and partly missed the strap. On one hand, this does not make the bill rare or worth more. On the other hand, it is still legal tender and can be spent like any valid \$20 bill. We would recommend taking the bill to a bank to verify this. They will probably exchange it for a clean bill.

TIP: To be collectible, trunks must be in good condition. Refinishing destroys the trunk's value as an antique. Trunks in poor condition can be refinished to be attractive and useful as pieces of furniture, but they will no longer be of interest to serious trunk collectors.



Learn To Adjust Your Body to a New Sleeping Schedule

DEAR DR. ROACH: I just retired from working the graveyard shift for 40 years. I am hoping you can share some information on how to safely learn to sleep at night once again. -- E.H.

ANSWER: Changing your body's circadian rhythm isn't always easy, and after such a long time, it will take longer for you. But it shouldn't be as difficult as you might fear. When people fly to the other part of the world, they need to get accustomed to a new sleep schedule, and it usually doesn't take more than a week or two for them to get accustomed. For you, it will be difficult learning to be up during the day, which is more of a behavioral issue than a circadian-rhythm issue.

The first advice I give is to push your internal time clock forward, not backward. Try to stay up two hours or so later each day until you get to a bedtime that works with your family (if appropriate) and goals. Your body has an easier time moving forward than backward.

Bright light can be your friend or your enemy. You want bright light when you wake up, not right before bed. Computers, phones and tablets all put out light that signals your brain to wake up, so don't use these before bed. Making sure that your bedroom is dark when you want to sleep is something you probably have already done, but it's still worth mentioning.

Caffeine is very helpful to a lot of people, so if you partake, do so when you awaken, not before bedtime. Some people metabolize caffeine slowly, so if you do, don't have any caffeine for at least 8 hours before planning to go to sleep.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Recently, I had COVID and was given Paxlovid. I am a 74-year-old woman with a 25-year history of a fibromyalgia-type disorder, along with rheumatoid arthritis and a few other problems. I was expecting to feel worse after taking Paxlovid, but I was quite surprised that I felt much better. The COVID symptoms were gone in 24 hours, and for the first time in years, I had energy. The fibromyalgia symptoms were gone, too.

This lasted for four days, then it was back to reality. Once I stopped Paxlovid, the symptom relief halted as well. Have you ever heard of this? -- F.P.

ANSWER: Yes, this is well-reported among the fibromyalgia community. It's not at all dissimilar to what I have heard from some patients about feeling better after getting antibiotics for an unrelated condition.

As far as I know, nobody has a definitive answer as to why this happens. I doubt very much that it is an effect of Paxlovid. Many people have tried using antivirals or antibiotics for fibromyalgia, but it does not seem to be helpful. Some authorities have speculated about it suppressing other viruses, but this isn't likely either. It seems that not only do people feel relatively better after being very sick with COVID, people report being able to do activities that they hadn't been able to do before.

I'm sorry that I don't have an answer as to why this happens. A diligent search doesn't lead me to any great insight. Obviously, a better understanding of these types of conditions would be great if it could lead to more effective treatments.





Hot Fudge Pudding Cake {9X13-inch Pan}



INGREDIENTS

Topping:

³/₄ cup granulated sugar 1/2 cup natural unsweetened cocoa powder

Cake:

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 cup sugar

½ cup natural unsweetened cocoa powder

1tablespoon baking powder

½ teaspoon table salt

1 cup milk, preferably not skim

½ cup butter, melted

2 large egg yolks

1 tablespoon vanilla extract

1 cup semisweet chocolate chips

2 cups boiling water

<u>INSTRUCTIONS</u>

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray a 9X13-inch baking dish with cooking spray.

For the topping, whisk the sugar and cocoa powder together until well-combined. Set aside.

For the cake, whisk the flour, sugar, cocoa powder, baking powder, and salt in a large bowl.

To the dry ingredients, add the milk, butter, egg yolks, and vanilla and whisk together until just com-

Add the chocolate chips and stir to combine evenly; the batter will be fairly stiff.

Spread the cake batter evenly in the prepared pan. Sprinkle sugar/cocoa topping evenly over the top of the cake batter.

Carefully pour the boiling water over the top. Do not stir.

Immediately bake the cake until the top is puffy and slightly cracked, sauce is bubbling and a toothpick inserted into cakey area comes out with moist crumbs attached, about 22-25 minutes.

Over baking may result in a very thin or nonexistent pudding layer, so keep an eye on the baking time. Cool the cake for 10-15 minutes. Serve warm with vanilla ice cream.


