Get Into The Spooky Spirit THIS HALLOWEEN

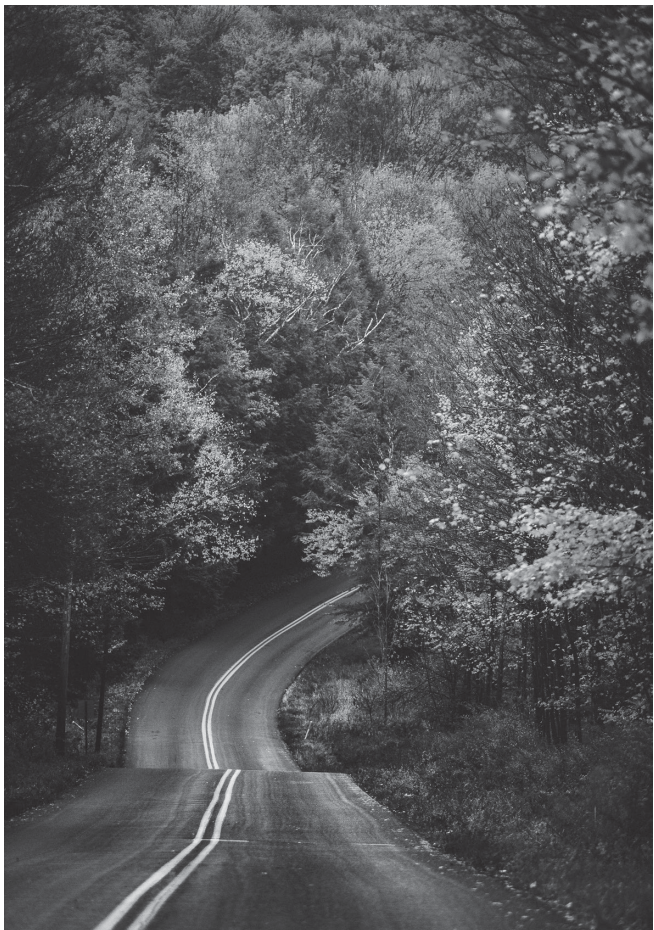

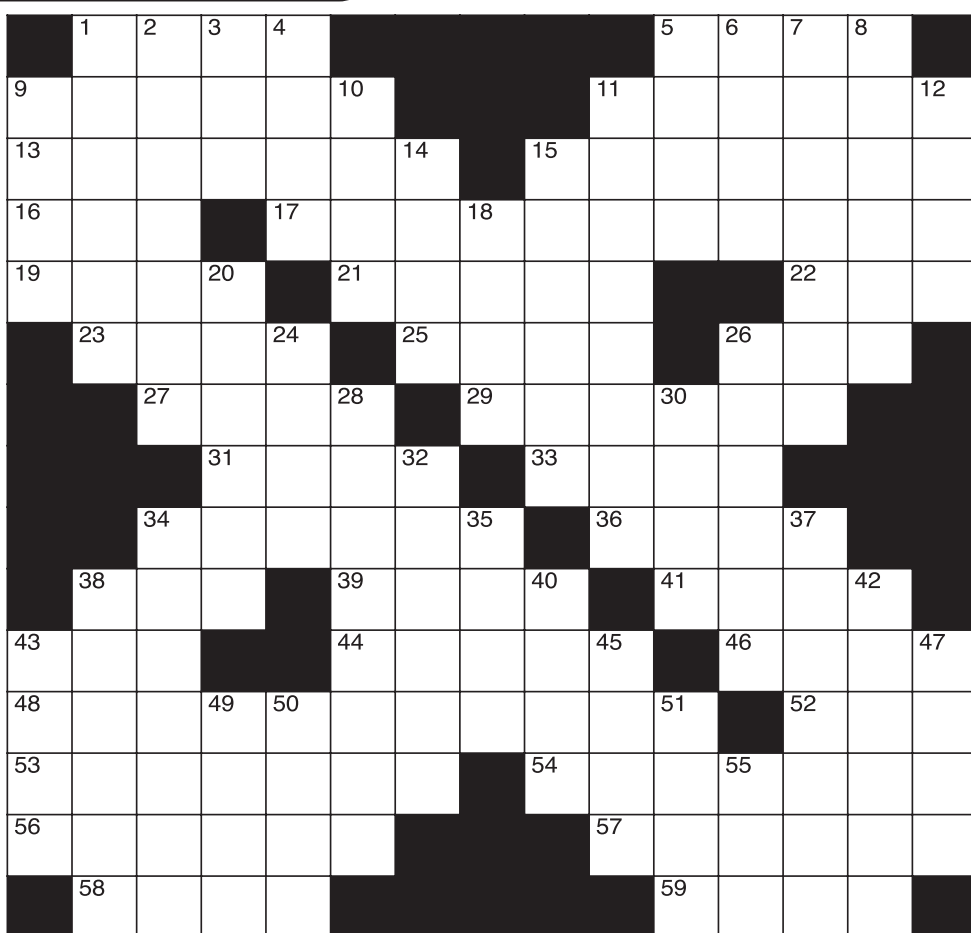

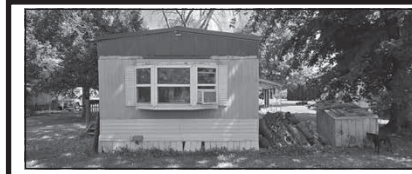
