Motorized enthusiasts weighed in at open house for Solana Forest plan

About 50 people, in favor of allowing motorized off-highway vehicles in the Solana State Forest, were present at a DNR open house in Aitkin last week.

"We don't yet have a trail change plan (called a proposal), but we are in the midst of the trail planning process for Solana State Forest," said Molly Lou Pintok, a principal DNR planner. "In

Aitkin last week, we gathered public input for the future of Solana's Forest trails," Pintok said in an interview.

The Solana State Forest covers about 68,000 acres in southeast Aitkin County in the Malmo and McGrath areas and near Mille Lacs Lake. Permitted uses now are hiking, OHV riding, camping, hunting, trapping, foraging, fishing, snowmobiling, skiing, snowshoeing

the west end.

Some parts of the forest are marked as forbidding motorized use.

The DNR is attempting to gather data on how the public currently uses the forest land and trails now and what they want to see in the future. Now begins a six-month to 24-month process of making a draft trail plan for the forest. Motorized uses are allowed only where designated in Solana State Forest. Some trails are planned now, but not developed.


In this interdisciplinary process, guided by legislation passed in 2003, public comments are sought by the DNR, other state agencies and the Aitkin County Land Department. After comments

are received (the first deadline was October 30) a draft plan will be compiled. "How long it takes to draft the plan depends on myriad factors," pointed out Pintok. "It will take a minimum of 6-12 months to finish the draft plan. For example, if an endangered species is found on the site it could slow down the process."

The public will be invited to weigh in again once the draft trail plan is proposed. "How should the designated trails in the forest change?" is one of the questions to be pondered.

Another consideration in developing the plan will be connecting to ATV, snowmobile and other local trails. Once the second batch of public data input is incorporated after the draft proposal is presented, the DNR commissioner will review and sign the completed trail plan for the forest.

"About 50 people came to the open house in Aitkin and they were in favor of continued motorized use," said Pintok, who has a statewide position.






