## Mayor proclaims April 3-9 National JA Week

"This is an exciting week for us, because it gives us a chance to thank all of the citizens of Jones County for supporting us in this work and to recognize our wonderful corporate sponsors who finance these projects," said JA of Laurel PR Chair Bryn Nasajpour. "The families and children we serve are so deserving and thankful for this assistance, and none of that would be possible without the support of the entire community."





## JCJC student newspaper earns 30 awards

Jones County Junior College's newspaper, the Radionian, received a total of 30 awards at the annual Better Newspaper Contest, held by the Mississippi Press Association's Education Foundation. This is the most the paper has ever received, surpassing its record-breaking 27 awards last year.

For the ninth consecutive year, the Radionian took the General Excellence Award for top community college newspaper in the state.

Jones swept the news and general interest column categories, taking first, second and third place in each. The newspaper also received first place for front page and first place for design.

JCJC competed against other community colleges in the state, and in the Investigative Reporting category, was pitted against universities and received third place, behind stories covering MSU's campus shooting scare and Delta State's removal of classes.

## 11 Mississippi counties added to federal disaster declaration for March floods

At the request of Governor Phil Bryant, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has amended a recent disaster declaration for severe storms and flooding that began March 9. Survivors in Clarke, Forrest, Greene, Jones, Marion, Panola, Perry, Quitman, Sunflower, Tunica and Wayne counties can now register with FEMA for disaster assistance through the Individual Assistance program. Survivors who sustained disaster-related losses in the designated counties can begin applying for assistance by calling FEMA's helpline at 800-621-3362, which is video relay service accessible. Survivors who are deaf, hard of hearing or who have difficulty speaking may call TTY 800-462-7585. The lines are open 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. local time until further notice. Online registration is available at DisasterAssistance.gov.

Assistance may include grants for temporary

housing and home repairs, and for other serious disaster-related needs, such as repairing or replacing damaged or destroyed personal property, medical and dental expenses. Low-interest disaster loans from the U.S. Small Business Administration may also be available to cover losses not fully compensated by insurance. Mississippi residents in the designated counties should register with FEMA even if they have insurance, but only if their property was damaged by the severe storms and flooding. FEMA cannot duplicate insurance payments, but under-insured applicants may receive help after their insurance claims have been settled.

Registering with FEMA is required for federal aid, even if the person has registered with another disaster-relief organization. Federal disaster aid does not affect other government benefits, such as Social Security and Medicaid, and is not considered taxable income. Only

one person per household is eligible to register. Survivors must use the name that appears on their Social Security cards when registering with FEMA. Applicants will be asked for the following information:

- Social Security number
- Address of the damaged home or apart-
- Description of the damage
- Information about insurance coverage
- A current contact telephone number • An address where they can receive mail
- · Bank account and routing numbers for direct deposit of funds

## Hattiesburg Habitat and Leadership Jones County partner for success

Hattiesburg Area Habitat for Humanity and Leadership Jones County are partnering to build a Habitat House on North 9th Avenue in Laurel, Mississippi. Leadership Jones County has provided Jones County with a network of current and emerging leaders who possess the skills and sense of commitment to improve our community. Class sessions focus on enhancing leadership skills and garnering a better understanding of the position of the region's essential assets. Class participants also design and implement group projects that address a need/opportunity in Jones

County. The 2016 Leadership class decided to conduct one joint project – funding a Habitat build for a deserving family in Jones County.

The project goal is to raise the \$80,000.00 necessary to build a four bedroom/two bath home for this family on a lot previously donated to Hattiesburg Area Habitat by Susie Kerce and QAR Residential Properties. A special Jones County Homeowner Orientation was held November 14, 2015, and the Diana Pickering family was selected. City of Laurel officials, Leadership Jones County representatives, Hattiesburg Area Habitat for Humanity staff, and other community leaders will be on hand Wednesday April 6 for the official groundbreaking ceremony. This event will kick off this partnership which has a goal of building a new home for Diana Pickering. The ceremony is scheduled to begin at 1:30 p.m. at 1012

North 9th Avenue in Laurel.

"I am just so excited," said Pickering, who will be on hand to speak at Wednesday's groundbreaking. "I think it's awesome that Leadership Jones County has adopted this build as their project and is providing this opportunity to make my dream of home ownership a reality."

Continued fundraising by Leadership Jones County will make construction of Pickering's home possible. The construction will begin in earnest once 75 percent of the funds have been secured. Habitat homes are built by volunteers and partner families from the community and sold at no profit with no interest loans. The mortgage payments made by homeowners are used to construct more houses. To provide construction costs for Pickering's home, Leadership Jones County is seeking financial donations, sponsorships, and gifts-in-kind. 

Free memory screenings are being offered Monday, April 11, at Laurel Family Medicine/Immediate Care - Laurel, located at 2313 Highway 15 North in Laurel. The screenings will take place from 9 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. and then 1 p.m. until 4 p.m. The screenings are free to the public, but space is limited and registration is required. While the 15-minute screenings are not intended to be diagnostic evaluations, they may help uncover early signs of memory impairment and/or dementia. Material and resources on Alzheimer's

disease will also be available for participants.

Experts say more than 5 million Americans may have Alzheimer's, and the disease is currently ranked as the sixth leading cause of death in the United States, according to the National Institute on Aging. These screenings are available through a partnership between the Mississippi Department of Mental Health, Memory Center at Hattiesburg Clinic and Laurel Family Medicine/Immediate Care - Laurel. # JCJC's first Legacy Tree dedicated to alumnus & former Ellisville mayor, Dick Anderson

"Legacy The first Tree" on the Jones County Junior College campus was dedicated in memory of Dick Anderson with many of his family and friends in attendance. The 1943 Jones County Agricultural High School and 1956 JCJC alumnus was the 1993 Honor Alumnus of the Year. As an active community member, he served as Mayor of Ellisville for 14 years and he was a Mississippi House of Representative for eight years. Current

Ellisville Mayor, Tim Waldrup remembers Anderson and said he proudly continues his legacy of service.

"Many of the practices and procedures put into place during his tenure as mayor and the example he set, are still followed today," said Waldrup. "Dick truly set an example that will be followed by everyone who will come behind him as mayor."

Anderson also served two terms as the president of the Ellisville Jaycees, winning the National SPOKE Award twice. He was the General Manager of the Nehi Bottling Company in Ellisville, manager of Ellisville Custom Canners, he served on the executive committee for the National Soft Drink Association for eight years, he was a member of the Ellisville Masonic Lodge and he was a member of Ellisville's First United Methodist Church. His service on earth ended last January, but his legacy lives on today.

"We're very proud of Dick," said his step-son, Grant Hedgepeth at the memorial dedication. "He never sought recognition; I think he would be embarrassed by this. But, he would also be very honored and proud inside. We want to thank JCJC and The Foundation, Buck and Tom Anderson, and everyone else that helped to do this. Thank

you from the bottom of our hearts."

JCJC Foundation Executive Director, Charlie Garretson shared he grew up around Dick Anderson on hunting trips near his home. After moving to Ellisville, Garretson said he became good friends with Dick, who was as an inspiration to him. In fact, Anderson's legacy has impacted the lives of several generations of JCJC students, faculty and staff. Hedgepeth said he is one of about five generations in his family who are grateful to Anderson for inspiring them to come to JCJC.

"He served others his entire life because he loved Ellisville, Jones County and Mississippi and he truly loved JCJC. From my grandmother Vera Graves to my mother and Dick Anderson who went to JCAHS, and JCJC, to our generation, I think all of us went to JCJC and now our children are going to school here. This is just such a wonderful campus, such a wonderful school."

JCJC Foundation Board President, Robin Robinson added, the live oak tree and plaque is only one way to honor his legacy at JCJC and abroad.

"Mr. Anderson was one who lived his life to learn and to love and because of you, to leave a legacy. This is the first legacy tree we have and our vision is to have other trees in memory of, or in honor of great people

## Remembering Patty Duke | Jana Graham awarded NPGA scholarship

It was sad news a few days ago when South Central Regional Medical Center's Linda Gavin, vice president of marketing and business development, and Karen Vanderslice, community health coordinator, heard the news about the death of Patty Duke. They reminisced about having Duke as the keynote speaker at the hospital's Women's Life Conference in 2007. Vanderslice said Duke's platform at the conference centered around her childhood, her rise to

fame and her struggles in life with bipolar disorder.

"She was ahead of her time," Vanderslice noted. "She was the first celebrity we had who talked about the importance of the diagnosis and treatment of behavioral health

"At the time she spoke at our conference and for years prior to that, there was a stigma associated with mental health related conditions, some which still remain today," added Gavin. "Patty Duke paved the way for open and honest communication, and I know thousands must have sought help as a result of her message. Patty Duke was one of my favorite actresses of all times. I rarely missed watching anything she did."

As noted in her biography on her public web site, Duke's career spanned six decades and she continued to thrive long after many of her contemporaries had retired. She conquered Broadway, film and television. In 1959 she made her Broadway debut in "The Miracle Worker," the powerful story of Helen Keller and her teacher, Annie Sullivan (portrayed by Anne Bancroft). The show ran for nearly two years and a twelve-year-old Patty Duke won the Theatre World Award as "Most Promising Newcomer."

Soon after "The Miracle Worker" closed on Broadway, Duke and Bancroft both reprised their roles in the motion picture version and each won Oscars. Patty Duke's win as Best Supporting Actress made her, at the time, the youngest Academy Award winner in history. Duke also won a Golden Globe Award for her performance. Coming off her Oscar win, she played genetically unexplainable identical cousins on "The Patty Duke Show" from 1963 to 1966. The show was a top-rated program and brought Duke her first Emmy nomination. Duke also entered the history books as the youngest person (16) ever to have a show bearing her full name. In addition she became a Billboard top-ten singer with the recording of her hit song, "Don't Just Stand There."

By 1967, Duke wanted to shed her good girl image. She won the part of cross-addicted Neely O'Hara in the camp classic "Valley of the Dolls." The film was a huge box office success and remains a favorite to this day.

Over the next several years Duke appeared in "Me, Natalie" (Golden Globe Award), and became the first actress ever to win an Emmy for a TV-Movie for "My Sweet Charlie." She won her second Emmy for "Captains and the Kings" and her third for her masterful portrayal of Annie Sullivan in the television remake of "The Miracle Worker." She received nine additional nominations for her roles in television movies. Duke also appeared in more than 90 TV and theatrical movies.

In addition to her acting, she became the second woman to ever be elected president of The Screen Actors Guild, which is the fifth largest labor union in the United States. She also became, twice, a New York Times best-selling author with the publication of her autobiography, "Call Me Anna," and its follow up, "A Brilliant Madness," both which detail her harrowing childhood, rise to fame and diagnosis of bipolar disorder. A television adaptation of "Call Me Anna" was later produced with Duke portraying herself.

She also starred in several stage productions including "The Glass Menagerie;" "Follies;" "Gypsy," and in a return to the Broadway stage, "Oklahoma," and recently finished a year-long run in San Francisco production of "Wicked" as Madame Morrible.

Duke loved teaching drama at the University of Idaho and enjoyed tutor sessions. She was honored to have received two PH.D's, the first from the University of North Florida and the second from the University of Maryland, Eastern Shores.

At 65 years old, she was still eager to play roles encompassing the aging process. Duke has directed a tremendous hit of the stage version of the Miracle Worker in Spokane at the Interplayers Theater. She continued to travel the country to speak about mental illness.

"The diagnosis and treatment of mental health related disorders is so important. It is like our certified professional counselor at South Central Behavioral Health Services, Rhonda McNair, has said many times: The brain is just another organ of the body. Sometimes it needs treatment just like the heart, lungs and kidneys," said Gavin. "So why then is it the last thing we seek care for when we know something is just not right?"

South Central has been recognized as a leader in community health and outreach programs for years. The Medical Center was the first hospital in the state to host a large women's conference featuring a celebrity speaker.


"Patty Duke will always be one of our favorite keynote speakers. She will be greatly missed," Gavin concluded.

South Central Regional Medical Center's first conference was held in 1990, and plans are being made now for the 2017 event set for the last Saturday in April at Jones Junior College.






