



Turkey Platter

With a colorful image of a majestic turkey, this platter is ready for Thanksgiving. Despite the all-American bird (Benjamin Franklin famously praised the turkey as "a true original Native of America" and "a Bird of Courage," although, contrary to popular belief, he did not suggest it as a national symbol), it was made in England, marked for Copeland Spode.

This mark came into use about 1833, when William Copeland purchased the Spode pottery firm in Stoke-on-Trent. By this time, turkeys were known in England, but, being an exotic foreign animal, they were limited to the tables of the wealthy.

This platter, which sold for \$352 at a Nye & Co. auction, was probably made later. Copeland made a series of plates with game birds in the 20th century, intended as accent pieces for an earlier pattern. About the same time, they made multicolor versions of earlier patterns that were originally made as single-color transfers.

Jalapeno Cornbread Mac and Cheese

Jalapeno Cornbread: 1/2 cup butter, melted,

pepper, to taste To make jalapeno combread: Preheat oven to 400 F. Butter 8-by-8-inch baking pan.

In mixing bowl, combine cornmeal, flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt. In another bowl, whisk butter-

milk, eggs, 1/2 cup melted butter, corn and jalapeno. Add half the liquid ingredients to dry mixture, stirring just until

blended. Add rest of liquid and stir until just blended. Pour batter into prepared pan and bake 30-35 minutes, or until knife inserted in center comes out clean. Set aside to cool.

To make mac and cheese: Bring large pot of water to boil. Add macaroni and cook according to package directions. Drain under cold water and set aside.

Preheat oven to 350 F. Butter 9-by-9-inch square baking dish. In heavy saucepan, melt 2 tablespoons butter. Add flour and whisk over low heat 3-5 minutes, making

sure not to brown. Whisk in milk and cook over medium heat, whisking often until mixture thickens, about 5 minutes.

Stir in mustard and cheese. Add salt and pepper, to taste. Add macaroni and stir until noodles are coated with cheese mixture. Pour mixture into prepared pan. Use back of spoon or spatula to even out mixture in pan.

Bake 25 minutes until mixture is bubbly.

Remove from oven, turn oven to broil and place rack on second from top. Break up about 1/3-1/2 of the cornbread into small pieces; place even layer of broken-up cornbread over top of mac and cheese. Put mac and cheese under broiler until lightly browned. Serve immediately with remaining cornbread or make ahead and warm before serving.

Tip: For spicier cornbread, keep some jalapeno seeds intact.

POST-PARTY CLEANING TIPS

- 1. Don't be afraid to ask for help, especially from your partner or children.



What shall we do with the extra \$50?

Social Security payments are going up 2.5% starting in January, which comes to an average \$50 increase for the 72 million recipients. That's less than the increase for 2024, and the previous year, and the previous year.

Your 2025 statement detailing your specific amount should arrive in the mail in early December. Read it to be sure you don't spot any mistakes.

Medicare cost is getting a bump, from \$174 to \$185. (Keep an eye out for your annual booklet "Medicare & You" to come in the mail.) Remember: Upon reaching age 65, you still need to sign up for Medicare within 3 months of your birthday.

Social Security fraud is still a big problem. If you suspect someone has tried to scam you, call the Inspector General's Fraud Hotline at 800-269-0271 and report it.

If you're scrambling and watching your savings dwindle because of the rising cost of, well, everything and you know that the Social Security increase won't make a dent, give your finances a good hard look.

Some ideas: Put off buying a new winter coat for one more year. Buy food in bulk and split with a friend or neighbor. Look for community rabies/distemper shot events to lower the cost of vaccines for your pet. Put clear plastic on the windows to block chilly breezes. Ask for discounts everywhere you go and shop on seniors discount days. Apply for energy, phone and internet assistance money. Consider a part-time job one day per week. If you can pay for the whole year on your auto or homeowner insurance, you might get a significant discount. Review your subscriptions and cable TV extras and see if you can delete any of them. Try out cheaper store brands. Explore GoodRx and America's Pharmacy for reduced prescription costs.

In short, look for spare dollars anywhere you can find them, because that extra \$50 isn't going to go very far.

There's no shortage of ways to prepare chicken wings, but fans who like their game day grub to have a little kick can try this recipe for "Spicy Soy Chicken Wings" courtesy of Andrew Schloss's "Cooking Slow: Recipes for Slowing Down and Cooking More" (Chronicle Books).

Spicy Soy Chicken Wings Makes 4 servings

4 lbs. chicken wings, cut into sections at the joints, tapered wing tips trimmed and discarded

Coarse sea salt and freshly ground black pepper

2/3 cup soy sauce

2/3 cup firmly packed dark brown sugar

teaspoon dark sesame oil

1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper

1/8 teaspoon hot chili powder, preferably habanero

2 garlic cloves, minced

Combine the chicken wing pieces with a generous amount of salt and pepper in a large zippered plastic bag. Close the bag tightly and refrigerate for at least 12 hours or up to 24 hours.


Preheat the oven to 225 F. Transfer the chicken to a baking dish in a single layer without crowding. In a small saucepan, stir together the soy sauce, brown sugar, sesame oil, cayenne, chili powder, and garlic and heat to a simmer, stirring to dissolve the sugar. Pour over the chicken. Cover the baking dish with aluminum foil and cook until the chicken is nearly falling off the bone, about 3 hours.

Raise the oven temperature to 450 F and continue baking until the chicken browns and the sauce thickens into a glaze, about 10 minutes longer. Watch carefully near the end of the cooking time to avoid burning. Toss the wings in the sauce to coat and serve.

Variation: In a slow cooker:

Follow the recipe, cooking the chicken in a 6-quart slow cooker on high for 3 to 4 hours, instead of a baking dish in the oven. When the wings are cooked through, transfer to a bowl. Simmer the sauce with the lid of the cooker off until it thickens, about 10 minutes longer. Toss the wings in the thickened sauce and serve.

- * "I have to wear my hair tied back for work.
