





Almost everyone who has ever loved and been loved by an animal will tell you that they not only believe, but know, that that animal is an emotional, sentient

We know that animals have emotions; however, it is difficult to gauge, or even know, how deep animals' emotions are. It is even hard for us to completely understand what another human is feeling because of our different spheres of reference. Since we cannot communicate orally with animals, and their natural behaviors and characteristics may not be like ours, we simply cannot know the depth of their emotions. Perhaps their happiness or their sadness isn't on the same level as ours. However, we do any animal a grave disservice when we assume that since we do not understand their emotions, the emotions do not exist. After Hurricane Katrina in 2005,

we received several animals that had been sheltered in Louisiana. We went to a city about two hours away to get them. We saw a dog that had no hair, probably because of stress and standing in the germ-infested flooded areas. She exhibited signs of emotional trauma and we expressed willingness to take her, but we were told that a potential adoptive home had been found for her. A couple of days later, we were asked by the rescue group if we would still like to have her. The

back to Danville, it started to rain and she started shaking and whining. Her fear was evident. She was like that all the way back to Danville.

When we arrived back at the shelter, we learned that it had been raining in Danville for hours. We saw that all of the hurricane animals (even the cats in the cat room with no view of the outside) were shaking, cowering in their cages, and making pitiful noises.

We had no idea what trauma they had experienced, but there was no denying they had deep feelings associated with their time in the hurricane. Recently, my three cockatiels stayed in my shelter office

during my time away for surgery. When I went into my office after being gone for two weeks, all three of them flew to the side of the cage where I was standing and sang to me. When I sat at my desk, they changed sides and got as close as they could to me. I was touched that they

The only place he's been able to work recently is Europe, where he filmed "Jeanne du Barry" (2023) and "Modì, Three Days on the Wing of Madness" (2024). Hollywood producers just don't think he's bankable anymore.

Also attempting a comeback from scandal is James Franco in the Italian-made "Hey Joe," which screened at the Rome Film Festival. Where once he was an Oscar nominee for "127 Hours" (2011) and portrayed "Oz the Great and Powerful" (2013), now he's speaking road-company Italian in second-rate "La Dolce Vita" movie palac-



Make Turkey Salad From Thanksgiving Leftovers

Hosting the Thanksgiving feast usually means a variety of leftovers get tucked away in the refrigerator for building pilehigh sandwiches. If you're ambitious, you might even make soup or a casserole with the good and seasoned food.

Here's another tasty option that will please your family and weekend guests: Make a big, savory, crunchy, nutrient-packed turkey main-dish salad and serve it at a weekend brunch with croissants and fresh fruit on the side.

If you are like me and contribute dishes to the Thursday feast but don't host the gathering, no worries about not having turkey leftovers. Just put a fresh turkey breast in the oven on Friday and roast it for this seasonal recipe. When I stir the salad together, I remember that my kids aren't mayo-lovers, so I compromise with half mayo, half Greek yogurt for the dressing. I use dried cranberries without added sugar. If the spirit moves me, this recipe is also delicious with a crisp, chopped local apple added just before serving.

Enjoy it topped over mixed greens, or spoon it between a halved croissant for a delectable sandwich.

TURKEY SALAD

Serves 8


- -4 cups cubed, baked turkey — 1 tablespoon chopped red onion
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper — 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup Greek yogurt - 1 cup chopped celery
- 1 1/2 cups seedless red or green grapes, halved — 1/2 cup dried cranberries
- 1/2 cup roasted pecans, loosely
- 1/2 crisp apple, chopped (optional)
- 1/2 fresh lemon



In a large bowl, combine turkey, onion, salt, pepper, mayonnaise and yogurt. Add and stir together celery, grapes, cranberries and pecans. Add apple, if you wish, and a few squeezes of lemon juice just before serving.

Saving money in 2025

In a few weeks, those of us on Social Security will be getting approximately 50 extra dollars in our monthly benefit. Minus the \$10 increase in Medicare Part B, that brings the average increase down to \$40 per month.

How shall we spend our windfall?

If food prices are going to come down after the recent election, it won't be instantly. We need to continue to shop carefully and get the best possible deals for our dollar. Look for senior discount days, coupons, loyalty perks and, yes, the food bank.

If you can spring for a Walmart+ membership (\$98 per year, minus \$20 if you're also an AARP member), each time you shop you can end up with rewards dollars added to your account for buying certain products. Look for other benefits such as free shipping, discounts on fuel if your local store has a gas station, access to the TV streaming service Paramount+, prescription delivery and a lot

For the first time in 15 years, the membership cost of AARP is going up in 2025. The new price of \$20 will take effect after your current membership expires. If you extend your membership now, it will be at the current rate. Meanwhile, take advantage of AARP's savings and discounts on a wide variety of products and services, ranging from dining out; insurance; travel, including car rental and vacation packages; gym memberships; and so much more.

Ask your cable and internet provider for a reduced fee. It could be that by dropping down one plan level, you could save considerable money by cutting out the channels you never watch anyway.

Investigate Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) for help with fuel and heating costs, one of our biggest expenses. Start by calling the Community Action Agency in your state or the Area Agency on Aging.



Easy Strawberry Pound Cake



For the Cake 16 oz. boxed white cake mix 3 Tbs. flour 3 large eggs 3/4 cup water 1/2 cup vegetable or canola oil 1-3 oz. pkg. strawberry flavored gelatin may use sugar-free gelatin, if preferred 1 cup chopped fresh strawberries may use frozen

INGREDIENTS

strawberries, if preferred 2-3 Tbs. finely chopped strawberries for garnish, optional

For the Glaze, optional but delicious 3 Tbs. butter, melted 1 cup powdered sugar 3 Tbs. milk 1tsp. vanilla extract tiny pinch of kosher salt

INSTRUCTIONS

Prepare and Bake the Cake

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. Spray a 10-inch angel food cake pan or Bundt pan with nonstick cooking spray; reserve. **FTR, I usually use a Bundt pan, because I think the finished cake turns out prettier.

In large mixing bowl, combine all the cake ingredients, including the chopped strawberries. Using an electric mixer on low speed, beat the ingredients just until combined, then beat on high speed for 2 minutes; pour the batter into the prepared pan.

Bake, uncovered, on the center oven rack for 35-40 minutes or until toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean.

Remove the baked cake from the oven; cover the cake pan tightly with aluminum foil. Place the covered cake pan onto a cooling rack; allow the cake to cool completely in the pan.

Once the pound cake is completely cooled in the pan, use a butter knife (or any knife that has a rounded tip) to loosen the cake by sliding the knife down the side between the cake and the pan, all the way around the outer edge of the cake. Also be sure to loosen the cake around the center of the pan using the same technique.

Place a cake platter over the opening of the cake

Using two hands, flip the cake pan over keeping the platter tightly secured against the pan until the cake pan is fully inverted.

At this point, the cake should slip out of the pan and onto the platter so that it is now right-side-up on the platter. Voila!

Prepare the Glaze

While cake is baking and cooling, make the glaze by combining the butter, powdered sugar, salt, and vanilla in a medium mixing bowl, adding the milk as needed, to get the consistency you desire for the glaze, whisking until smooth.

Glaze the Cake

Drizzle the prepared glaze over the top of the pound cake, then garnish with chopped strawberries, if desired, allowing some of the strawberries to fall down onto the cake platter around the cake. Serve at once or allow the glaze to set up a bit before serving.


