Even though watching shows on streaming services continues to increase in popularity, the Spirit Lake Public Library still has a large selection of DVDs available for checkout. Go "old school" and come check out some Informational videos this week?

To help you get ready for holiday entertaining, we have several instructional baking videos: five on breadmaking, including sourdough; muffins; breakfast baking; and pizza making. Yum! If you want to feel guilty after all those carbs, you can watch 'Fed Up" or "Blood Sugar Rising." There's another cooking video called "Iowa Ingredient" where you can go on a foodie adventure through the state to learn where Iowa ingredients come from and how to cook delicious dishes with them.


Speaking of Iowa, if you are having company from out of state this holiday season, you could check out some videos that spotlight the Hawkeye state. There's Best of Iowa with Dan Kaercher, A Century of Iowa Architecture, Historic Buildings of Iowa: Des Moines, Iowa Outdoors, Iowa's Century Farms, and The Sidey Report: Life and Times of an Iowa Icon.

Applications Open for Homegrown Talent Initiative Grant

The Iowa Lakes Corridor Development Corporation (Corridor) has announced the application period for the new Homegrown Talent Initiative grant program starting December 10, 2024 through January

31, 2025. The Home grown Talent Initiative is a new program by the Corridor to encourage former

Loans Now Available to Agricultural Producers

DES MOINES, Iowa, Dec. 4, 2024 - Agricultural producers of perishable commodities including fruits, vegetables and are can now get funding for controlled atmosphere storage through Farm Storage Facility Loans (FSFL) offered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA). Controlled atmosphere storage regulates the concentrations of oxygen, carbon dioxide and nitrogen in a storage room to increase the shelf life of crops.

In addition to now supporting controlled atmosphere storage, FSFLs also provide low-interest financing to help producers build or upgrade storage facilities and to purchase portable (new or used) structures, equipment and storage and handling trucks.

The low-interest funds can also be used for controlled atmosphere storage monitoring equipment, designed to notify facility owners immediately if potential atmospheric concerns are detected. Producers may renovate existing storage facilities to include controlled atmosphere storage monitoring equipment. Authorized loan terms for FSFL renovations are three and five years only

To assist with monitoring gases and particle concentrations for controlled atmosphere storage, the following equipment, but not limited to, is eligible for an FSFL:

Optical oxygen sensor.

Low power CO. sensor

Air quality sensor.

Air temperature and relative humidity sensor. Water activity meter.

Temperature stabilized water activity analyzer. Precision and performance humidity and temperature transmitter.

Loans of up to \$50,000 can be secured by a promissory note/ security agreement, loans between \$50,000 and \$100,000 may require additional security and loans exceeding \$100,000 require additional security.

FSFL borrowers do not need to demonstrate lack of commercial credit availability to apply. The loans are designed to assist a diverse range of agricultural operations, including small and mid-sized businesses, new farmers and ranchers, operations supplying local food and farmers markets, non-traditional farm products and underserved producers

Crop Advantage Series Returns to Northwest Iowa in January 2025

The 2025 Crop Advantage meetings will give producers a solid foundation of current research-based crop production information

to help make smart, informed decisions for their farming operation. The meetings are an opportunity for farmers and crop advisers to hear current research and crop production information from

CROP ADVANTAGE

Iowa State University. Iowa State University Extension and Outreach specialists will travel to 12 locations

around Iowa from January 2-29, providing updated management options and recommendations on crop production issues facing Iowa growers. The Okoboji Crop Advantage meeting will take place January 14, 2025.

Meetings include continuing education credits for Certified Crop Advisers and pesticide applicator recentification. All sites offer private pesticide applicator continuing instruction for an additional fee of \$30. "There is no other program in our erop production education year where we are able to bring this many Iowa State University Extension and Outreach specialists together to sites across the state. We're excited to provide the quality, in-person education farmers and retailers have come to expect," said Gentry Sorenson, local field agronomist with ISU Extension and Outreach based near Algona. Program topics vary by location and are selected for regional issues. Examples of topics this year include crop markets, com sweat and 2025 weather outlook, soybean aphid resistance, tarspot, nitrification inhibitors, tiling and water quality, farm transitions, panels on crop production and conservation and more. "Our goal is always to prepare producers to manage potential issues when they arise, or even before they arise, by sharing the most up-to-date scientific knowledge from Iowa State University researchers," said Leah Ten Napel, local field agronomist with ISU Extension and Outreach based near Le Mars. "Each location's program is unique as content is driven by local needs and production issues."

Early registration for each location is \$75; late registration made less than seven days prior to the meeting, or on-site, is \$100. Registration includes lunch and CCA credits.
