Competitive Edge follows dramatic growth to new location in St. Joseph

A Stevensville company that serves clients all over the nation will be moving a few miles North on Red Arrow Highway/Lakeshore Drive to an existing building in St. Joseph, helping facilitate its continued growth in an industry that has changed dramatically over a few years.

Competitive Edge, the promotional products company headed by Owner/CEO Mary Jo Tomasini, will vacate its attractive headquarters office building in a park-like setting at 5924 Red Arrow Hwy, Stevensville, and relocate to a newly remodeled office/warehouse facility near the corner of Hawthorne Road and Lakeshore Drive in St. Joseph.

Tomasini sat down with MoodyOnTheMarket.com to detail her plans for the next chapter at the highly successful Competitive Edge:

"We had an investor from Chicago approach us about buying our building and we were feeling at that time that we needed a different space because it was configured for how we operated 30 years ago. In recent years, we had to rent several other small warehouses off-site to make everything work based on how our business is growing. So, it was an opportunity to sell the building and kind of 'dream a new dream' of what a different space could look like for our future."

Mary Jo said she found the perfect fit in a building that's very different from CE's current headquarters, working with The Southshore Companies, the locally based owners of many office and industrial buildings in Michigan's Great Southwest and several other states.

"So, we started down that road. We also knew that we wanted to lease instead of constructing a building. So, we started looking at what was available in the market and went through a lot of different properties. And we settled on the Southshore Companies property at Hawthorne. Southshore actually persuaded a couple of tenants to move into a

#### 2024 YEAR IN REVIEW

As 2024 draws to a close, I would like to take a moment to reflect on a year of substantial progress, collaboration, and impact for the Southwest Michigan Regional Chamber. Together with our members, partners, and community stakeholders, I am proud to say we have addressed challenges, seized opportunities, and laid the groundwork for a stronger, more connected region.

The year began on a high note with our Annual Business Recognition Breakfast at Lake Michigan College's Grand Upton Hall. The event broke all historical records for attendance, welcoming over 630 business and community leaders who gathered to honor outstanding individuals and industry leaders throughout our region. We anticipate surpassing that attendance at our next breakfast on February 21, 2025, where we'll unveil more exciting new initiatives. Tickets are already available, and we hope you'll join us.

This enthusiasm carried throughout the year, as we went on to host more than 6,000 attendees across 70 events in 2024. These gatherings provided opportunities to celebrate milestones, build connections, and strengthen our business community. At the same time, we executed an ambitious program of work on behalf of our members. Below some highlights within each of our four pillars of service:

**Leadership Development:** Developing future leaders continues to be a core focus of our work. This year, our *NextGen* program fostered connections and growth among area young professionals, creating a vibrant network of young talent in our area. Meanwhile, 30 emerging leaders completed the *Leadership Accelerator*, a seven-month immersive program delivered in partnership with LMC. Designed to prepare participants for impactful leadership roles, the program continues to shape the next generation of changemakers who will drive our region forward.

**Business Development:** Speaking of which - the next generation took center stage at our newest business development offering. 2024 saw the launch of *HYPE - Highlighting Young Professional Excellence -* a Shark Tank style pitch competition that provided 16 budding entrepreneurs a platform to bring their www.MailMaxOnline.com ideas to life. After two competitive rounds, we awarded over \$60,000 in cash and in-kind prizes to four impressive entrepreneurs, furthering our commitment to fostering innovation and supporting small business growth. We look forward to hosting this event again next year.

**Economic Development:** We're pleased to help our affiliate, the *Bridgman CGA*, drive targeted growth and attract investment to their community. In less than a year, they have achieved "Engaged" status with the Redevelopment Ready Communities program, submitted over two million dollars in grant applications for the development of a small business incubator, helped install new wayfinding signage throughout town, and hosted a half a dozen ribbon cuttings. Their many accomplishments have inspired other communities to partner with us and adopt CGA models of their own.

Community Development: Workforce, housing, and childcare also remained top priorities this year. In collaboration with LMC, Berrien RESA, and the Greater Niles Chamber, we launched the Berrien Talent Collaborative, establishing the state's first countywide youth apprenticeship program. A new *Soft* Skills Bootcamp with LMC further bolstered workforce readiness, equipping our talent pool to meet future demands. We proudly hosted a two-day Housing Summit where over 150 leaders joined Strong Towns, a nationally recognized nonprofit, to address affordability and availability challenges. On childcare, we advanced regional solutions in partnership with the W.K. Kellogg Foundation, aiming to better support working families and strengthen the local workforce.

This year also ushered a new era of growth for the Chamber, marked by the formation of two 501(c)3 subsidiaries: the *Regional Chamber Foundation* and *Discover Southwest Michigan*. The Foundation supports our four pillars of service and expands our capacity for impact, while Discover Southwest Michigan, our new talent attraction, relocation, and regional marketing initiative, was selected by the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) to serve as a pilot program for growing our state's population.

With new initiatives and entities, it's no surprise our organizational growth has been equally remarkable. We welcomed 50 new members this year and, through strategic planning and resource development, we doubled our budget. These resources were invested directly into enhancing our programming and expanding our team to better serve our community - and we're just getting started.

As we wrap up 2024, it's clear that our focus on leadership, business, community, and economic development is making a real difference. Thank you to our members, partners, and supporters for being part of this journey. Together, we're shaping a brighter future for Southwest Michigan.





First, make sure all your necessities are taken care of. By necessities, I'm talking about food, clothing, shelter, transportation and utilities. Then, get current on anything you owe, or make payment arrangements for past due bills. After you've done this, it's time to take your very first Baby Step.

You've already mentioned getting \$1,000 in the bank for a starter emergency fund. That's Baby Step 1. After that comes your debt snowball, which is Baby Step 2. Here,

you'll pay off all your debts from smallest to largest–except your home. Attack the first balance on your list by paying as much as you can each month, while making minimum payments on the other debts. When you've paid off the first one, add what you were paying on it to the payment on your next debt and start attacking it. As the snowball continues to roll over, you're picking up more and more money to apply to your debts.

In Baby Step 3, you'll save money and increase your emergency fund from \$1,000 to a full three to six months of expenses. You're going to be surprised how fast you can save money when your income isn't flying out the door to pay off debt every month.

Now, it's time to really start looking toward the future. In Baby Step 4, start investing 15 percent of your income for retirement. College funding is next in Baby Step 5 for any kids you have, or plan on having one day. And here's a big one. Baby Step 6 is where you pay off your home early. How great will that feel?

But Baby Step 7 is the real deal. Now, you start building wealth and giving with outrageous generosity. When you've completed all the other Baby Steps, and are able to do these two things, you've achieved the pinnacle of smart money management. Or in other words, you've reached the point of financial peace.

different space and that allowed us to have the space that we needed that backed up to a warehouse. So, our main warehouse will be contiguous with the offices, which is a beautiful thina."

Tomasini acknowledged that her new building will not compete in a 'beauty contest' with the old CE offices that overlook Lake Michigan, just South of the Grande Mere Inn. However, from a business perspective, she's excited for her employees and the future.

"We won't have the view that we have here. You know, that's probably the saddest part about moving. But we'll have a warehouse, which I know is not as pretty as Lake Michigan, but it will make our efficiencies a lot better. A portion of the building has a warehouse-height ceiling as it goes back from the street and then another Southshore warehouse is built onto that. So, it's one of those buildings that, from the street, you don't realize how deep it goes."

Tomasini explained that her 29 employees will have plenty of space to carry out changing responsibilities.

"It's roughly about 11,000 square feet total in our new building. The warehouse is

50-something and the office is 50-something And then we have flex space available from Southshore of up to 50,000 square feet, maybe more, because there's extra space that we can expand into if we have a temporary project or if something large comes along that we need space for a period of time."

Tomasini said there have been huge changes in how promotional products orders are handled and shipped-'fulfillment' as they call it in the industry.

www.MailMaxOnline.com "The fulfillment projects that we do are just very different post-2020. It used to be that a lot of your promotional things went to a company's door or loading dock. They got 2,000 things to hand out to their employees. They took it from there. Now, with remote work and other changes, a lot of times those 2,000 things are going to each employee's home. That's 2,000 different places!"

#### Put a logo on a rose petal

Mary Jo told us the array of promotional items that CE can offer has become almost mind-boggling.

"The product offering has grown exponentially. I remember a while ago -- this is my 40th year in the business -- I remember saying, 'We have a hundred thousand different things we can offer people.' And we were so proud. A hundred thousand seemed like such a large number. And then at some point it was a quarter of a million items. Well now, it's well over a million items!"

Tomasini says technological improvements have made so many promo ideas possible.

"A lot of the reasons that has changed is because imprinting capabilities have changed substantially. I remember 30 years ago doing beach towels for the Venetian Festival, where they had a complex, multi-color logo, and you

had to make giant screens, and the minimum was very high. I mean, there was no running 50 towels. Or the Krasl Art Center used to want to do custom art mugs, and you'd have to buy 588 or whatever, and now you can print one of those mugs if you want to. And it's because imprinting capabilities have changed so tremendously. That's really one of the biggest changes that we have the ability to more affordably print using diverse techniques to get an imprint on different products.
