A FISHING TRIP TO REMEMBER

You never know what's going to happen when you go fishing In Alaska. Some fishermen up there are set netters.

"They set their nets out," says Joe Bob Brewster who ranches around Crystal Falls just outside of Breckenridge. He calls his ranch NPR, No problem Ranch. He had an oil field supply business in Alaska for thirty

"In other words, they run the net out, like in the ocean. They run it out with a boat and they have something anchored out there that they hook the net on and they sit for two hours, ten hours, whatever. As the fish swim they get hung up in the net. Then they take the salmon out, throw them in the boat, take them to the shore and sell them."Joe Bob was never too busy with his business to go fishing.

"My brother-in-law and I were out there fishing one time in the middle of nowhere along the Naknek River when this lady drove up with her daughter and asked us if we had a can opener. We told her that we had one and asked if we could help her.

"She had a can with her, handed it over and asked if we could open it. She told us she had the remains of her husband in there, and that he had wanted to be cremated. He had been a set netter out here on he Naknek River and died during the winter. They couldn't dig a hole to bury him because it was frozen. The lady said 'I didn't know what to do with him so I just canned him. Like we can fish. I figured since we preserved fish, we'd just preserve him.'

"So we opened the can full of the woman's husband's ashes. She took it and she and her daughter went down to the river, had some sort of little service and Ker plunk, you know, and poured out the ashes into the river. Then they came back, thanked us and took off.

"We went down to the river and saw a circle of gray ashes where they had poured out the remains of her husband. About that time a guy came up and was going to clean his fish. He was a set netter. He asked us what we were doing. "We told him we were just fishing ad asked him not to clean his fish where those gray ashes were because the woman had just buried her husband. We told the man that the woman's husband had been a set netter. The man pondered a moment and said 'I wonder if I knew him. What's his name?' We told him his first name was George but we didn't remember his last name.

"So this guy goes out there, looks into the river and sees that gray circle. He came back up and said 'one thing about it, I'll have to say that I don't recognize him.

"The man then said 'out of respect I'll go down the river a little ways to clean my fish."

Joe Bob says that is sure one fishing trip he'll remember for a long time.





Dancing With The Stars

Mark Alexander Ballas Jr. (born May 24, 1986) is an American dancer, choreographer, singer-songwriter, musician, and actor.

Ballas is a professional ballroom dancer on the ABC program Dancing with the Stars. He began competing on the show in season five during the fall of 2007 and was nominated for an Emmy for Outstanding Choreography in 2011. Ballas released his first solo CD HurtLoveBox in March 2011.

Ballas was born in Houston, Texas, the son of dancers Corky Ballas and Shirley Ballas . His paternal grandparents were of Mexican, Spanish, and Greek background, and his mother is originally from the United Kingdom and is of English heritage. His paternal grandfather, George Ballas, was the inventor of the Weed Eater lawn-trimming device. His Greek paternal great-grandparents, Karolos ("Charles") Ballas and Maria Lymnaos were immigrants to the United States from Greece.

Ballas is a member of singer-songwriter duo Alexander Jean along with his wife, BC Jean. The two became engaged in November 2015 after three years of dating, and were married on November 25, 2016, in Malibu, California.

CAREER

Early life

Ballas attended Rosemead Preparatory School in South London. At the age of 11, he earned a full-time slot at the Italia Conti Academy of Theatre Arts in London, as well as earning a full scholarship. In 2005, he was awarded "Performer of the Year". He then moved on to win championships at The British Open to the World, The US Open to the World, and The International Open to the World. With his former partner Julianne Hough, he won the Junior Latin American Dance Championship and the gold medal at the Junior Olympics.

ACTING

Ballas in 2013

As an actor, Ballas played the lead role of Tony in the musical Copacabana and was the lead dancer in the UK national tour of the Spanish musical Maria de Buenos Aires. He was also the understudy for the role of Ritchie Valens in the UK national tour of Buddy, The Buddy Holly Story. Ballas played an extra in Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone as part of the Hufflepuff House. In October 2008, Ballas made a guest appearance on the season premiere of Samantha Who.

On September 6, 2016, it was announced that Ballas would be the final actor to portray the role of Frankie Valli in the Broadway cast of Jersey Boys before it closed in 2017. On May 26, 2018, it was announced that he would play the role of the Teen Angel in the 2018 Toronto revival of Grease in a limited engagement from June 7–10. From September 11, 2018 to November 18, 2018, Ballas portrayed Charlie Price in the musical Kinky Boots on Broadway.

Dancing with the Stars

On the fifth season of Dancing with the Stars, Ballas was partnered with Cheetah Girls star Sabrina Bryan. On October 30, 2007, the pair was voted off the show. They have been the only couple invited back for an exhibition dance.

Ballas's partner for season 6 of Dancing With The Stars was Olympic Gold Medal-winning figure skater Kristi Yamaguchi. They won the series.

On August 25, 2008, ABC announced the cast of the seventh season of Dancing with the Stars, with Ballas paired with reality television star Kim Kardashian. They were the third couple eliminated, finishing in eleventh place, on September 30, 2008.

For the eighth season of Dancing with the Stars, Ballas was paired with Olympic gold-medal winning gymnast Shawn Johnson, winning that season's competition on May 19, 2009.

He was partnered with actress Melissa Joan Hart for the show's ninth season. They were voted off in week six and came in 9th place.

For season 10, Ballas was partnered with actress Shannen Doherty. They were the first couple eliminated, on March 30, 2010. Despite that, Shannen & Mark hold a higher average than a few celebrities who lasted longer than they did.

For season 11, Ballas was partnered with Bristol Palin, daughter of former Alaska governor and U.S. Vice Presidential candidate Sarah Palin. They made it to the finale and finished in third place.

For season 12, Ballas was partnered with Disney Channel star Chelsea Kane. They made it to the finals where they finished in third place. For his choreography with Kane, specifically the Jive ("I Write Sins Not Tragedies"), Viennese Waltz ("Hedwig's Theme") and Waltz ("My Love") dances, Ballas was nominated for that year's Primetime Emmy Award for Outstanding Choreography.

For season 13, Ballas was partnered with reality star Kristin Cavallari where they were the 3rd couple eliminated finishing in 10th place.

For season 14, he was partnered with Classical Singer Katherine Jenkins. They made it to the finale where they finished as the runners-up, losing to Donald Driver & Peta Murgatroyd.
