



I want to be a leader someday, but how do I get there?

Being a leader is not easy. Being a leader means taking people and organizations to places where they wouldn't go on their own. It's "leading" others to a better place, better conditions, better performance, and a better life. To be a leader you must do more work than the average employee and it involves making decisions, which invite risk and criticism into your life. Being a leader means leading your organization, your people,

In a nutshell, leading is not for everybody because it can be one of the hardest things in life to do.

But it also provides substantial rewards. For example, you can positively impact others lives. You can help your organization become better. You can take care of customers better than ever. Your pay and benefits are typically higher. Overall, your impact can be greater as a leader versus an individual contributor.

If you are up for the challenge, being a leader is worth it in my opinion. But let's be clear, it's not just a title, label, or a position in an organization chart. It's the way you serve others, customers and employees in particular

There are 5 areas I would focus on developing if I was just starting out to be a good leader, and then 5 additional suggestions. The first 5 are from the book "Leadership Challenge" by

1. Model the Way – live your life with integrity and know your values. Be ready to defend them.

2. Inspire a Shared Vision – Bring everyone together to aim for the same goal. Clarify the vision over and over.

3. Challenge the Process – Never stop improving. There is always room for continuous improvement. This is where courage sometimes comes into play as you challenge organizational norms.

4. Enable Others to Act – It's not enough to have a vision for your company. You must put in place what employees need to do their life's finest work. Sometimes this is taking action on your behalf, other times it's getting out of the way, and the wisdom to know when to do each.

5. Encourage the Heart – We are human beings. We respond to inspiration and motivation. To lead people, as their leader, your employees need to know that you care about them before you move on to other things.

The 5 additional suggestions from my own experience in leadership over 35 years are:

1. Work Hard – be ready to do the extra work required. Be intentional about your time and make the best use of it to allow you to do more in every hour. Avoid the trap of being busy but not productive.

2. Manage your energy, not just your time. A lot of emphasis is placed on time management. But it's not enough. You must manage both your time, and your energy, to be successful as a leader.

3. Work/Life balance- as you work hard at being a leader, don't forget to live a good life and seek fulfillment in the journey. Avoid the trap of prioritizing your work over your family and personal time.

4. Leadership is not formulaic. Management is more typically formulaic and there are certainly administrative aspects to a leader's job. But the highest and most valuable parts of being a leader are sometimes unknown until the moment arrives. Imagine leading the response to the COVID epidemic? Imagine navigating your business experiencing 4 feet of floodwater? Imagine a key employee leaving and suddenly your organization has a gap? Leading in these moments are what puts the "lead" in leadership.

5. Find a mentor. Learn from someone who has been there and done it. In general, the best way to accelerate your development is to use other people's experience vs. having to figure it out all on your own.

Lastly, every leadership role has its unique aspects that speak to the needs of the firm, or the challenges of the day. Be open to explore these challenges and meet them head on. If you want to be a leader, then volunteer to take on a problem, run towards conflicts, and be the light in everyone's day in some way.

Doing this over and over will forge you into the leader you want to be, and along the way you will discover your ultimate

Top 10 Adult Non-Fiction Of 2024 By Jill Jennings

Today I'm highlighting the Top 10 Adult Non-fiction books checked out from the Spirit Lake Public Library last year. Two notable discoveries: half of these books were published before 2024, and Daniel James Brown has two on the list!

The number ten most checked out book was The Secret Lives of Booksellers and Librarians: True Stories of the Magic of Reading by James Patterson. Number nine was Create Your Dream Home on a Budget by Daniel Jett. In eighth place was An Unfinished Love Story: a Personal History of the 1960s by Doris Kearns Goodwin.

At number seven was The Boys in the Boat: Nine Americans and Their Epic Quest for Gold at the 1936 Olympics by Daniel James Brown. This is SUCH a good book! The Demon of Unrest: a Saga of Hubris, Heartbreak, and Heroism at the Dawn of the Civil War was number six. It was written by Erik Larson, who is an excellent non-fiction author. Bill O'Reilly comes in at number five with Confronting the Presidents: No Spin Assessments from Washington to Biden.

Number four sounds good, but concerning: The Anxious Generation: How the Great Rewiring of Childhood is Causing an Epidemic of Mental Illness by Jonathan Haidt. The third most popular title is Wild Bread: Flour + Water + Air: Sourdough Reinvented by Mary Jane Butters.

Daniel James Brown comes in at number two with Facing the Mountain: A True Story of Japanese American Heroes in World War II. And finally, at number one, Hillbilly Elegy by J.D. Vance. This book was on the NYT best seller list for several months beginning in 2016 when it was published. Last July, after Vance was named Trump's running-mate, it shot back up on that list again and stayed there for several weeks.





Southern-Style Buttermilk Fried Chicken

- 2 cups buttermilk
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- whole chicken, cut into pieces
- 2 cups all-purpose flour 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 1 tablespoon garlic powder
- 1 tablespoon onion powder
- 5 cups vegetable oil for frying

Whisk together buttermilk, mustard, salt, pepper, and cayenne in a bowl. Pour buttermilk marinade into a resealable plastic bag. Add chicken pieces, coat with marinade, squeeze out excess air, and seal the bag. Marinate in the refrigerator for 2 to 8 hours. Combine flour, baking powder, garlie powder, and onion powder in another resealable plastic bag; shake to mix thoroughly. Working with one piece at a time, transfer marinated chicken to the dry ingredient bag, seal the bag, and shake well to coat. After all chicken pieces are coated, repeat the process by dipping them in buttermilk marinade and shaking in the dry coating again. Then heat oil in a large frying pan over medium-high heat. Place chicken on the pan. Fry chicken in batches in hot oil, turning chicken occasionally, until golden brown and juices run clear. An instant-read thermometer inserted into





Protecting the island at Triboji Beach

When I mention Triboji Beach on the northwest corner of West Lake Okoboji, I often get the response, "Oh, you mean where that boat ramp is that has the island and the goats on it?' Most certainly, that's the one!

Also known as Lazy Lagoon, the area is the quieter access on West Okoboji. The entire Triboji Beach development was owned by Alex Percival and included 178 acres. In May of 1928, Percival and the Sioux City Journal entered into an agreement to develop the area that included 2000 lots. In September of 1928, the lagoon was dredged with an island in the middle. The island was originally called Island Park, and the dredged "donut" area was known as the \$5,000 Harbor.

Over the years, the Triboji lot/homeowners formed the Triboji Beach Betterment Association. According to Steve Brennan, president of the association, "Up until 2020, the Percival family still owned the island. As a board, we approached the Percival family about their ownership of the island and if they would be willing to deed the island over to the Triboji Beach Betterment Association, with the idea that we would maintain and preserve the integrity of the island." In 2020, the Percival family deeded the island to the association.

The renovation work begins

Over the previous 90+ years, the island had been left to itself with Triboji residents, Boy Scouts and others trying to tend to the island. In recent years, it became the summer home for as many as eight goats, whose job it was to keep the plant growth in check. At the same time, there was also significant concern about the severe erosion damage that had occurred to the perimeter of the island over the years.

Brennan says, "The erosion was very significant, and we knew something needed to be done. We worked with Mike Hawkins at the Spirit Lake Hatchery to get his ideas. He felt the best option was to armor the island with field rock. In order to do this, we had to get permits from the US Army Corps of Engineers and the Iowa DNR. Once they were approved, in 2022, we put out bids for the project. Diamond Concrete of Spirit Lake was awarded the bid of \$55,000."

Members of the Triboji community donated \$35,000, which was approximately 65% of the bid. Brennan says, "Diamond Concrete has been great to work with and continued completing the project as we continue to raise the rest of the money."

The project renovation was actually completed by the end of January. Construction workers used a backhoe to dig down along the outside edge of the island where it had eroded. According to Brennan, "This helped make a good base for the rock, while the fill was used on the island itself. They constructed a great barrier, and it really looks good."

Fundraiser

With \$20,000 needed to complete the project, the board chose to enlist the help of well-known fundraising artist, J. D. Speltz from Armstrong, to produce a print entitled Lazy Lagoon, that captured both the history and the beauty of the island.

According to Brennan, "We met with J.D. and showed him the island and gave him photos taken over the years. It was important to us to include the geese and ducks that are always there in the late spring, the huge cottonwood trees, a tent that represents the

boy scouts of the 1950s, the beauty of West Lake Okoboji to the east and, of course, a pair of goats on the island."

The response to Lazy Lagoon has been extremely positive. Brennan notes, "I couldn't be happier with the

painting. J. D. put his God-given talents into creating something

beautiful and thank him for that." In visiting with Speltz, he reflects on this most recent painting. "I've been doing these types of projects since 1980 and have done 1,700 paintings for groups and organizations across six states. I call this industrial wildlife because it combines man and nature together in harmony. This project for the Triboji Beach Betterment Association is near and dear to my heart because I spend a lot of time over around West Okoboji!

The Triboji Beach Betterment Association began offering the prints for sale in late January. Cost is \$75 for the print, and an additional \$77 to have the print matted and framed.




