Cornerstone Alliance joins focus on area housing needs

The new president of local economic development group Cornerstone Alliance has big plans for how to restart the economic engine in Southwest Michigan and it starts with a familiar focus across the United States – adequate housing for the area's workforce.

Marla Schneider officially started in her new role as President and CEO of Cornerstone Alliance in early January and nearly one month in, she's been busy meeting with area leaders, hearing a lot of discussion about the gaps between where the region is and where many want Southwest Michigan to be.

"If you look at Berrien County in comparison to its neighboring counties... we are the only county that has been losing population since the late 70s. We need jobs. We need places for people to live," -- Schneider during an interview on the WSJM Morning Show with Ken & Friends.

Schneider said she wants to focus on housing, in part because businesses looking to locate here or expand existing operations need a workforce able to live in the communities where they work.

"We need a countywide housing study," said Schneider. "There is data out there that is public right now for the county and it is great data. I also think we need some supplemental reporting and data collecting done that we can get into each community and dig down a little bit deeper to see what their individual needs are."

Schneider said she was involved in a similar data-gathering exercise in Muskegon County where community partners helped with the financial cost.

"Collaboration is huge for me. And so that's something that will be a tenant of how we move forward. We need to be better collaborators and good stewards of that with our partners so I'd like to formulate a housing study that partners are involved in. We commission this for the county, we share information publicly with everyone, we then need to figure out how... we develop a resource for workforce housing in collaboration with our partners and municipalities to drive forward housing." 

Dave Says Safe and Easily Accessible

Dear Dave,

I recently stopped contributing to my 401(k) temporarily to help us build an emergency fund a little faster. Things are going slowly, though, and I'm getting worried. My wife and I are both 46, have no debt except our home and we have a combined household income of \$100,000 a year. We have \$20,000 in a single stock, and I was wondering if we should cash out that stock and use the money for our emergency fund.

Dear Doug,

That's exactly what I'd do. I'd cash out that stock as soon as possible, and put the cash in a simple money market account with check writing privileges and no penalties for early withdrawals.

Basically, your emergency fund is in stock right now, and that's a bad place to keep it. You never know when life will throw unexpected expenses your way, or when the stock market will go down. You always want your emergency fund to be safe and easily accessible. Remember, your emergency fund is insurance-not an investment.

After that, make sure you keep pushing forward and jump back into Baby Step 4. That means start pouring money into your 401(k) again.

The Tortoise and the Hare

I'm trying to get out of debt and start handling my money better. Should lower the amount I'm contributing to my 401(k) so I can pay off my car and house faster?

Dear Dave,

I can tell you're excited about the idea of getting out of debt. And that's a good thing! But I don't want you to get ahead of yourself when it comes to gaining control of your finances.

Here's my Baby Steps plan. The first thing you should do is set aside a beginner emergency fund of \$1,000. That's Baby Step 1. Next comes Baby Step 2, which means paying off all your debt, except for your house. This would include your car. During this time, you should temporarily stop any kind of investing and retirement contributions, so you can attack your debt with a vengeance.

Once your mortgage is the only debt you have, it's on to Baby Step 3. This means you start saving money to grow your beginner emergency fund into a fully-funded emergency fund of three to six months of expenses. After that, it's on to Baby Step 4, which is investing 15 percent of your pre-tax income for retirement. In your case, that would mean re-starting contributions to your 401(k).

The rest of the plan goes like this. Baby Step 5 is putting money into your kids' college funds, if you have kids. Baby Step 6 is focusing on paying off the house early, and then comes the real fun. Baby Step 7 is where you build wealth and give like crazy.

It may take a little time in some cases, but there are millions of people out there who will tell you this-following the Baby Steps works! Dave

Housing has been at the forefront of recent high-profile discussions across the county, most recently at a countywide forum led by the Southwest Michigan Chamber of Commerce. The two-day housing summit featured the nonprofit Strong Towns and looked at incremental development, housing-friendly zoning policies, and collaborative action planning.

"Our region's housing challenges remain complex, and any meaningful solutions will require a united effort. That's why we hosted the summit -- to get us, Cornerstone Alliance, the Southwest Michigan Association of Realtors, and others together with major employers, municipal leaders, developers, lenders, and landowners to agree on real solutions," -- Arthur Havlicek, President and CEO of the Southwest Michigan Chamber of Commerce.

Contractor hired for new park in Benton Township

The Benton Township Board of Trustees is moving ahead with the development of a new park.

At its regular meeting on Tuesday, the township board approved a professional services agreement with MCSA Group out of Grand Rapids for Euclid Avenue Park. The Southwest Michigan Planning Commission's Marcy Hamilton told trustees MCSA was one of two bidders, and the firm has experience working with the Berrien County Parks Department.

The new park will be located near the intersection of Euclid and Laurel avenues

behind the former Martindale Elementary School on a roughly ten acre parcel. Benton Township Supervisor Cathy Yates told us the plan orginally included a splash pad, but that's proven too expensive.

"We wanted to splash pad, but water might be a problem," Yates said. "We do not have direct water there. And to put in a well there would probably take too much of our funds."

And construction costs, in general, have gone up. Nevertheless, Yates says the plan calls for a playground and a pavilion.

A public meeting found nearby residents want a park in the area, and Yates says it's a thrill to develop one.

"To me, that's a dream come true, especially for those people in that area, because I thought it was going to be really River Park, our main park, but no, the votes were all out

there. When I went and looked at it, they do need that area, the children need something to do."

Benton Township has been awarded a \$1 million Spark Grant for the project. Hamilton told trustees the grant funds have to be spent by the fall of next year. Therefore, the park has to be designed, the plans approved, and the construction done by then.
