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GREEN VELVET CAKE

Ingredients:

Cake:

- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder (not Dutch process)
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon fine salt
- 1 1/4 cups buttermilk, well shaken
- 1 tablespoon green liquid food coloring
- 2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- · 2 cups granulated sugar
- 1 cup (2 sticks) unsalted butter, at room
- temperature
- 3 large eggs, lightly beaten

Frosting:

- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 cups milk
- 1 1/2 cups (3 sticks) unsalted butter, at room
- temperature
- 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
- 4 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- Pinch fine salt
- Green liquid or gel food coloring, optional
- Green candies and sanding sugar for decorating,

Directions:

- 1. For the cake: Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F. Butter three 8-inch round cake pans, line with parchment and butter the parchment; set aside. Whisk the flour, cocoa powder, baking powder, baking soda, and salt in a medium bowl; set aside. Whisk the buttermilk, food coloring, and vanilla in a spouted measuring cup; set aside.
- 2. Beat the granulated sugar and butter in a stand mixer (or a large bowl if using a hand

mixer) on medium speed until very light in color and fluffy, about 5 minutes, scrape

down the sides of the bowl as needed. With the mixer still running, slowly add the eggs and

beat until fully incorporated. Reduce the mixer speed to the lowest speed; with it running,

add 1/3 of the flour mixture, then 1/2 of the buttermilk mixture, then 1/2 of the remaining

flour mixture, then the remaining buttermilk mixture, then the remaining flour mixture

Scrape down the sides and beat until well mixed. Divide the batter evenly among the three

prepared pans. Bake until slightly puffed and a toothpick comes out clean when inserted in

the center, 20 to 25 minutes. Let cool for 15 minutes in the pan, then turn out to cool completely.

3. For the frosting: Put the flour in a small saucepan. Vigorously whisk in about 1/2 cup

of the milk, making sure to get the whisk into the edges of the pan, until you have a

smooth, thick paste. (This step keeps the flour from clumping.) Slowly whisk in the

remaining milk until fully incorporated and the mixture is smooth. Cook over medium heat,

whisking continuously, until the mixture is very thick, about 5 minutes. (Toward the end of

the process, the mixture will become a thick paste; it may seem to be forming lumps, but

whisk vigorously and the lumps will disappear.) Scrape the frosting into a bowl, press plastic

wrap onto the surface and refrigerate until cool, about 45 minutes.

4. Using a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment (or a hand mixer), beat the butt

and granulated sugar on medium speed until very light and fluffy, about 5 minutes. Add

the cooled flour mixture a tablespoon at a time and beat until smooth. Switch to the whisk

attachment (or continue with the hand mixer), add the vanilla, salt, and 3 to 5 drops of food

coloring if using, and whip until very light and fluffy, like thick whipped cream, up to

minutes with a stand mixer or 12 minutes with a hand mixer.

5. To assemble: Place one layer on a cake plate, spread frosting on top, and repeat with the

2 remaining layers. Frost the sides and decorate with candies and sanding sugar if using.







FUDGY & CREAMY BROWNIES

Ingredients

- 1 box fudge brownie mix plus eggs water and oil listed on the package, prepared according to box directions
- 8 oz pkg cream cheese, softened
- ½ cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 Tbsp all-purpose flour
- 1 Tbsp vanilla
- green food coloring I used 12 drops

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray a 9 x 13 inch baking dish with non-stick cooking spray.

Pour prepared brownie batter into the prepared 9 x 13 inch dish.

In a bowl, beat the cream cheese and sugar together with a hand mixer until well blended.

Beat in the egg, flour, vanilla, and food coloring until well blended and smooth.

Drop cream cheese mixture by tablespoonfuls evenly on top of batter.

With knife, cut through mixture a few times to marble. Bake as directed on brownie mix box or until toothpick inserted in center comes out almost clean.

Cool completely, about 1 hour and cut into squares. Store in refrigerator. Serves 15.

FUDGE

Ingredients

- 1- 14 ounce can Sweetened Condensed Milk
- 3 cups white chocolate chips
- 1.5 tsp vanilla extract
- make green using food coloring, and add sprinkles for garnish if desired

Instructions

- 1. In heavy sauce pan, mix sweetened condensed milk, chips, and vanilla on medium low heat, stirring until it melts together.
- Stir in food coloring to make it green for St. Paddy's Day!
- 3. Line a 9x9 pan with parchment paper
- 4. Pour fudge mixture into pan
- 5. Wait for it to set up either in the fridge or on the counter
- Cut and enjoy!
- 7. If using sprinkles to garnish, push them into the top once almost set up.

COOKIES

Ingredients

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 5 teaspoons baking powder*
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine
- ¼ cup shortening

ST. PATRICKS DAY

- ¾ cup granulated sugar
- 4 eggs
- 2 teaspoons anise extract can use vanilla or lemon extract instead
- 2 cups confectioners' sugar sifted
- 2-4 tablespoons milk
- Colorful spinkles optional

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375°.
- In a mixing bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder and salt. Set aside.
- 3. In a microwave safe bowl, melt butter and shortening. Add the sugar and melted butter mixture to a mixing bowl; mix well. Add the eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Mix in the anise extract. Add the dry ingredients and mix just until blended. If the dough is too sticky to roll in the palm of your hand, add flour until firmer, but it should be very soft.
- Roll dough in ¾" balls and place on ungreased cookie sheets.
- Bake for 8-10 minutes (the bottom should be lightly browned but the tops should remain light). Remove cookies to wire rack and cool completely before glazing.

Glaze

 Gradually mix milk into confectioners' sugar to make a thick glaze...make sure to keep it on the thick side. Dip top of each cookie into glaze. Sprinkle with sprinkles while glaze is still wet.

SHAMROCK PIE

Ingredients: Crust:

- 1 ¼ cups graham cracker crumbs
- 5 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
- 2 tablespoons white sugar

Filling:

- 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
- 4 large egg yolks
- ½ cup key lime juice
- 2 tablespoons key lime zest
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 2 drops green food coloring, or as needed

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Set a rack in the middle of the oven.

Stir graham cracker crumbs, butter, and sugar together in a bowl until combined. Press the magical creation into the bottom and sides of a 9-inch pie plate.

Bake in the preheated oven until set, about 10 minutes. Let crust cool on a wire rack; leave oven on.

Whisk condensed milk and egg yolks together in a bowl until well combined. Add key lime juice and zest; mix well. Whisk in honey to combine. Add food coloring gradually, whisking until filling is green enough for you. Pour filling over the crust. Bake until nearly set, 16 to 18 minutes. Let cool completely on the wire rack so pie can set fully, at least 30 minutes. Cover and refrigerate, 8 hours to overnight.

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



not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit. (NIV)


We need a clear connection to the Holy Spirit to have

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

WHO AM I?

Who Am I?

"So they said to him, "Who are you?" Jesus said to them, "Just what I have been telling you from the beginning." (John 8:25). I can hear them now. Have you ever been asked in an arrogant, derogatory manner, "Just who do you think you are mister

goody- two-shoes?" That's the scornful attitude the Pharisees had anytime they questioned Jesus. Jesus' response, "from the beginning" could be referring back to what's been said earlier that he was the light of the world, which he continued to testify; or of his speaking before the Sanhedrin, when he affirmed that God was his Father, (Luke 22:70), and went on with many strong arguments that proved his divine sonship. It could also refer to his ministry, with miracles as well as doctrines, he made that he was he that was to come, the true Messiah. (John 4:25-26). Or, it could one of the more mysterious utterances in the Old Testament, God's self-



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revelation to Moses during the burning bush scene in Exodus 3:14, "I am that I am"; an expression of his self-existence. The three things God says about Himself in Exodus 3:13-15 are: "I Am Who I Am" (3:14a) "I Am has sent me to you" (3:14b) "This is my name forever[Yahweh]" (3:15). When God gives a name for His

people to call Him it conveys His dominion over all things, the source of His power, and His eternal nature: I AM. He is the self-sufficient, self-sustaining God who was, who is, and who will be. This eternal nature is conveyed better in the Hebrew than in the English. Yahweh means, "I Am".

I wonder if on some level the Pharisees and Sadducees had an inkling that Jesus was who he said he was. As the ruling class they were afraid of losing their power, so they refused to believe. I believe that is also the problem today with people believing in Jesus. Are you afraid of not being able to do what you want? Or, will you believe the "I Am"? (John 14:6; John 3:16).

Kind of scary when the weatherman is the closest one to telling the truth on the news these days.




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
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

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
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CLAYBANK MASTER GARDENERS March 2025
