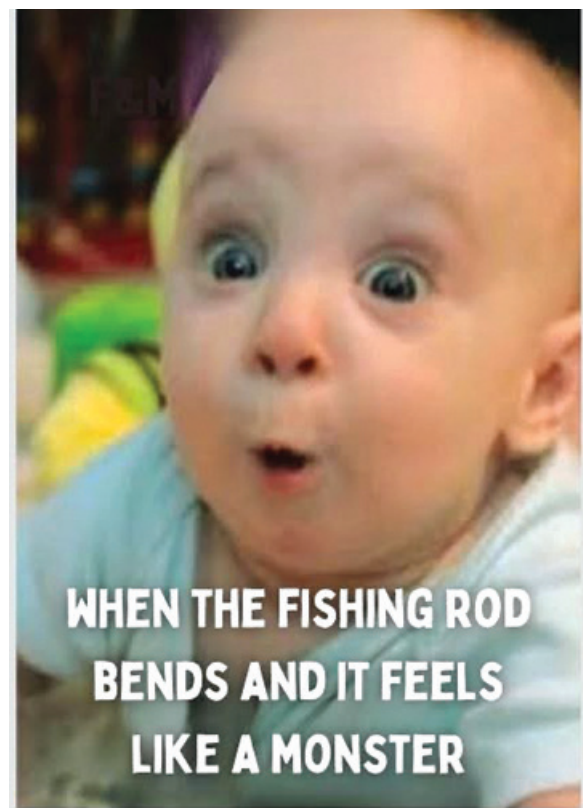

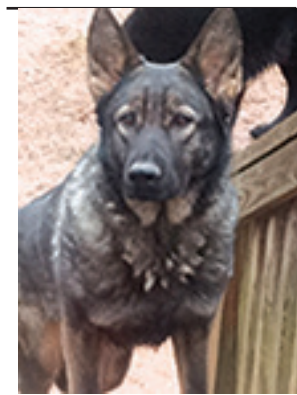

Last month, we said good-bye to a woman, Freda Cousins Burton, who was a dedicated volunteer for decades. She was the sister of Joan Schwarz who helped found the Danville Area Humane Society.

Joan and her husband, Bill, worked tirelessly to help animals. They were responsible for the negotiations with the City in 1983 for us to build an addition to the shelter (the first of several) and then operate it. When Bill died in 1998, we named our animal award the William Schwarz Animal Hero of the Year Award and we added Joan's name to the award after her death.

It was our honor to present Freda with the newly-changed award in late 2024. It was right that she would be the first recipient of the award William and Joan Schwarz Animal Hero of the Year Award.

Freda was a go-getter on the fundraising committee. She had spent her life serving as a registered nurse and when she retired, she dedicated her time to the animals.

I always knew that whenever we posted a picture of a sweet beagle or hound mix that I would receive a text from her – "I love her, I want her!"

Through the years, Freda logged in thousands of hours volunteering at dog washes, the yard sale, and Community

Market events. We always knew that she would sell hundreds of raffle tickets for the wreath the Gingerbread House donated to us. She would make dozens of calls to people, encouraging them to volunteer at our events. Her organizational skills for the yard sale were to be envied.

She and her three grown children – Doug, Mary, and Jennifer- adopted dogs from us and provided them wonderful lives. Mary and Jennifer now serve on the Board.

She was our friend and we miss her. A lesson remains.

It is a lesson woven throughout all of her service to the Danville Area Humane Society and the animals. She never wanted her picture taken and never wanted her name mentioned.

She was the epitome of serving quietly with no thought of any accolades.

Well done, Freda. Well done.

Stick Clocks

In 1905, Albert Einstein published his theory of special relativity, teaching the world that time is relative. In the science fiction novel "The Hitchhiker's Guide to the Galaxy," author Douglas Adams declared that "Time is an illusion, lunchtime doubly so." And in March of every year, Daylight Savings Time begins, reminding us again that time isn't absolute as we set our clocks ahead an hour.

Historically, there have been many ways to track time and account for the changes in daylight hours that come with the seasons. In some systems, the length of an hour could vary with the time of the year. In 19th-century Japan, stick clocks kept track of days and nights, each divided into six units called "toki."

In spring and summer, a day toki lasts longer than a night toki, with the opposite in fall and winter. Clocks, therefore, had to be adjustable. Some had interchangeable front plates that could be removed and replaced at different times of the year. Others, like this one, which sold for \$5,700 at Cotton Auctions, marked the toki with sliding plates. To a casual viewer, the set of thirteen plates down the front of the clock may not be as noticeable as the pierced scrolls and painted flowers and patterns that decorate it. A close look would show that those plates are numbered, and what's more, they are not evenly spaced.

painted glass, or plastic; you would never see them in an authentic Tiffany lamp. Take a close look at the glass. Authentic Tiffany glass will have tiny specks of color, called confetti glass. TIP: A damaged porcelain clock face is difficult to repair. It will lower the price of a clock by 20 to 30 percent.

Q: How can I tell if my Tiffany's lampshade is an original?

A: Louis Comfort Tiffany's lamps are some of the most famous and desirable pieces in American decorative arts, and they sell for high prices. Unfortunately, this also means that there are many reproductions and forgeries on the market. There are a few ways to check to see if your lampshade is authentic Tiffany. First, check the metal parts for a mark. Authentic Tiffany lamps are marked "L.C. Tiffany" or "L.C.T." in capital letters. Check for materials like zinc, resin,

Q: What ever happened to the character of Daphne who was so central to the first season of "Bridgerton"? Is she ever coming back? — A.W.

A: Yes, there is a "Legally Blonde" project in the development stages at Amazon MGM Studios. Reese Witherspoon's production company Hello Sunshine is behind the project, but it's not known what kind of on-screen presence, if any, she'll have since originating the role of Elle Woods in 2001. The series is actually a prequel, and another actress will play young Elle. Lexi Mine-ree ("The Murdering Murders") recently secured the role.

There were plans for a "Legally Blonde 3" starring Witherspoon, but it's been delayed since 2022. No word on whether it will see the light of day or if they'll just focus on the prequel series.

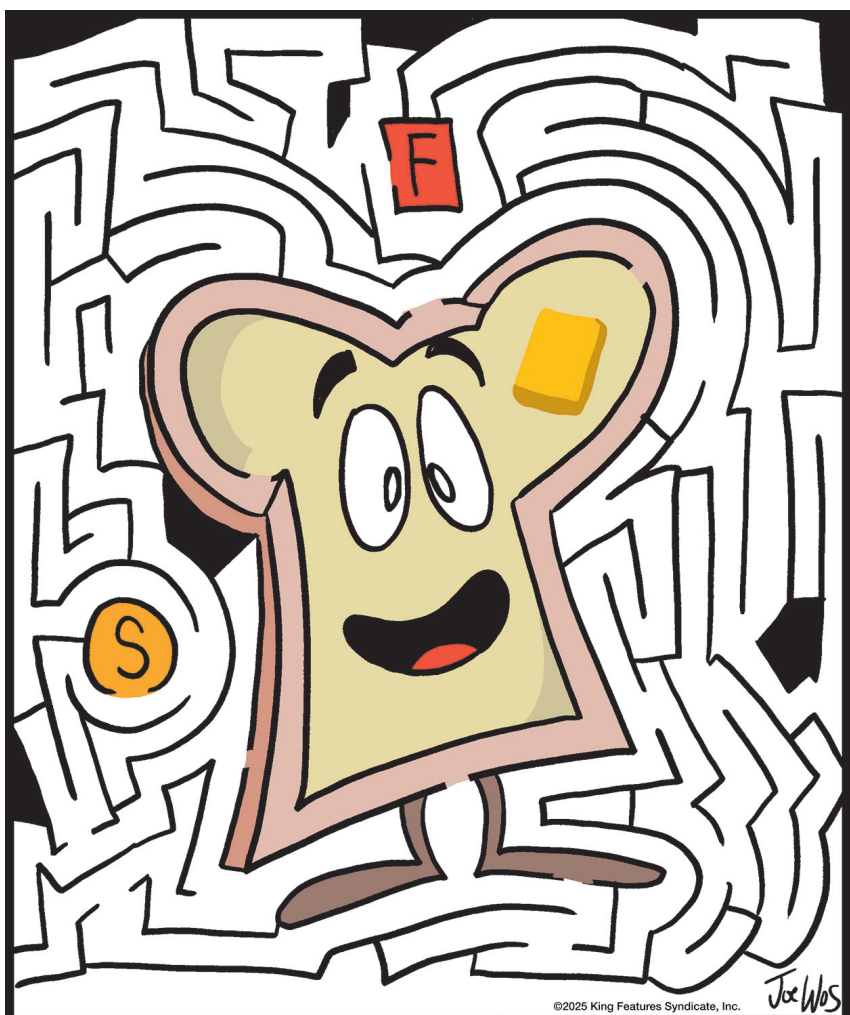

Robert David to be honored for government innovation



Robert David, the City of Danville's violence prevention manager and head of Project Imagine, has been named winner of the 2025 Excellence in Virginia Award for Innovation in Government from the Virginia Commonwealth University L. Douglas Wilder School of Government and Public Affairs. The award will be presented at a ceremony on April 8 at the Omni Richmond Hotel.

"This award speaks to the work that we do and the model that we have put together," David said. "This model works. We reach kids early, providing the resources, mentorship, and opportunities they need to change. They want a better path—we just have to give them the support to take it."

Project Imagine is based on Cognitive Behavioral Therapy principles, helping participants visualize and pursue a life free from gangs and crime. Teens enter the program through referrals from law enforcement, courts, schools, and parents. Since its launch in 2018, 187 youths have completed the program. David said the Project Imagine model is the culmination of the 30 years that he has served in the criminal justice field. "This model not only works, but it is sustainable." He encouraged others in the field to keep working. "Looking at my years of experience in this field, this award is a testament to everybody who does this work and does not feel as if they are being seen. You do not always get noticed for the work that you do. I hope this award sends a message to others to 'don't quit.'"

David is one of six award recipients, with others honored for lifetime achievement, community enhancement, leadership, freedom expansion, and heroism. "These awards recognize outstanding work at all levels of government in Virginia and honor dedicated public service, innovative approaches and commitment to excellence," said Susan T. Gooden, Ph.D., dean of the Wilder School, named after L. Douglas Wilder, the first African American elected governor in U.S. history.

Rapid Heart Rate Persists for a Decade Without Evaluation

DEAR DR. ROACH: I'm a 75-year-old woman who, for at least 10 years now, has been experiencing a rapid heart rate. In fact, doctors are usually surprised at how good my blood pressure is since I am borderline obese and slightly diabetic.

During this past physical, my doctor did mention my rapid heart rate but didn't recommend treatment or referral to a cardiologist. Should I insist on a referral to a cardiologist, or would this only bring me to more unnecessary testing? — M.R.

ANSWER: I unfortunately hear about people (more commonly women) having a potentially serious medical condition that gets ignored for many years, and I fear this is the case with you.

In a person with a persistently fast heart rate (over 100 bpm), an electrocardiogram (EKG) is an essential first step. I suspect you may have had this done, but if you haven't, this clearly needs to be done. Atrial fibrillation and some less-common heart rhythms need to be excluded.

It's likely that you have "sinus tachycardia," meaning that the impulse comes from the sinus node but is persistently too fast. The heart rate is supposed to be fast if you are exercising, and a fast pulse can often come on as a response to an infection or a loss of fluids. But I think that, after 10 years, you most likely have a condition called inappropriate sinus tachycardia (IST).

Since you are writing to me, I assume that this is bothering you. Most people with IST note palpitations, but loss of endurance and decreased exercise tolerance are other common symptoms.

Before getting treated, it's important to make sure that there isn't some long-standing cause, such as anemia or thyroid disease.

It's also necessary to exclude the diagnosis of postural orthostatic tachycardia syndrome, which can overlap with IST and seems to be much more common now, especially after a COVID infection.

I have had some success in prescribing exercise for carefully selected patients with IST. The cardiology literature recommends beta blockers or ivabradine to reduce symptoms and improve exercise ability.

Referral to a cardiologist is appropriate given your 10 years of not being evaluated. Even if you decide against therapy, making sure that there isn't a serious problem is very wise.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I'm a 61-year-old male in excellent physical health. However, out of nowhere, I started having severe anxiety attacks when driving over 60 mph on the highway. I now have to frequently exit the highway in order to calm down, and I'm constantly worried about having additional attacks while driving. Do you have any insight on how to treat this? — P.R.

ANSWER: According to the reading I did, some people will develop a fear of driving on the highway after an accident, but it also may come out of nowhere. Highway driving does tend to be more problematic as there is greater danger due to faster speeds — but even more so because of a higher perceived danger that is sometimes blown out of proportion.

From what I have read, cognitive-behavioral therapy is one treatment, while exposure treatment (sometimes using virtual reality) is another. The sooner you begin treatment, the more likely it is to be successful.

Since it sounds like you are having panic attacks, SSRI medications like sertraline may also be helpful, but some other medicines for panic attacks are inappropriate for people who drive.

Herbs for stuffy heads

Bring a few cups of water to a boil, then pour carefully into a large heat-safe bowl. Gather some fresh herbs such as basil, chamomile, eucalyptus, lavender, mullein leaf, oregano, mint, rosemary, sage, thyme, tea tree or yarrow, and place directly into the bowl of steaming water. Cover the bowl and let it steep for 10 minutes; then, being cautious of the hot steam, place your face over the bowl and cover your head with a towel to keep the steam in. Close your eyes and slowly breathe in the herbal steam, then gently breathe out. This helps moisturize the nasal passageways and loosen up any mucus in the chest and sinuses. — Brenda Weaver

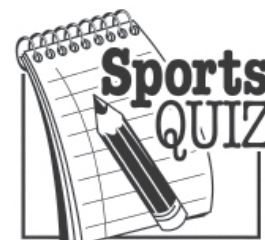
