

Can you share your favorite outdoor activity in the county and why you love it?

I have to say the Lake County Captains. Games are a blast and there's something to be said for a relaxing night at the ballpark, forgetting the everyday stressors in your life for a few hours, and having a cold beverage and locally-made, Five Star Brand hot dog while watching the Cleveland Guardians of tomorrow.

What local food or drink do you recommend for visitors to truly experience Lake County? For wine drinkers you absolutely must visit a couple of the 30 wineries in the Grand River Valley. For the masses, a true Lake County dining experience would be a great dinner at The Pompadour in Fairport Harbor followed by a short walk up the street to the Fairport Harbor Creamery for the best homemade ice cream you'll ever have and a Lake Erie sunset second to none.

Are there any hidden gems or lesser-known spots that visitors would enjoy?

A super cute hidden little corner of Lake County is along Lake Erie on the eastern part of the County at Madison Township Park. This small, lakefront park has breathtaking views of Lake Erie sunsets and you can walk next door to northeast Ohio's newest winery, lakefront restaurant and boutique hotel – Vincent William Wine. Plan your trip and catch a great theater performance just down the road at Rabbit Run Theater – one of the nation's few remaining Barn Theaters.

What aspect of Lake County do you think surprises visitors the most?

With a population of over a quarter-of-a-million people, a robust retail and manufacturing base and so many attractions, restaurants, historical landmarks, parks, and wineries, locals and visitors alike are always surprised when they find out Lake County is the smallest of 88 counties in the state by land area. This makes visiting all the great spots in Lake County very easy as you're typically less than 15 minutes away from everything!

What local food or drink do you recommend for visitors to truly experience Lake County?


If you're a taco enthusiast, you have to explore the Lake County Taco Trail! It's a fantastic way to experience some of the best local flavors while discovering the area. The taco trail offers diverse options, featuring classic Mexican restaurants and spots that put a unique twist on tacos—there's something for everyone. You can enjoy everything from Tex-Mex-inspired restaurants to authentic carnitas at charming family-run taquerias. A stop at La Mexicana in Painesville is always a great choice if you're craving something delicious—it's my favorite!

How would you describe the local culture and community spirit to someone from out of town?

Lake County strikes a perfect balance between small-town charm and modern flair while fostering a strong sense of community. The people here are friendly and genuinely care about supporting one another, whether through local businesses, schools, or community festivals. There's a deep pride in the area's history and agriculture, with many families living here for generations, giving everything a homegrown feel. Whether you're visiting a local winery or chatting with shop owners in downtown Willoughby, the laid-back atmosphere makes you feel like part of the community, even if you're just passing through. Additionally, with its proximity to Lake Erie, there is a strong love for outdoor activities. The community truly comes alive when the weather is nice, with boating, fishing, hiking, and so much more!

What advice would you give first-time visitors to make the most of their trip?

Take the time to explore the lakeside! Lake County, Ohio, is filled with beautiful spots to enjoy. Mentor Headlands Beach Park is a fantastic place to relax by Lake Erie. If you enjoy hiking, Lake Metroparks offers stunning trails where you can experience a different side of the area. Remember, the best way to appreciate the region is to take it slow—explore the quaint shops, try some local cuisine, and soak in the community's vibe. Lake County's charm truly shines when you're not in a rush!



What is the most unique attraction in Lake County that visitors shouldn't miss?

The Holden Arboretum, as it is the LARGEST Arboretum in the country! Holden holds a special place in my heart as that was one date location my high school sweetheart, and now husband, used to visit all the time! You always leave feeling lighter after experiencing Holden, no matter the season. You can choose your experience, whether that's exploring the various trails on the ground or rising to new heights on the Canopy Walk or Emergent Tower.

What local food or drink do you recommend for visitors to truly experience Lake County? I've been visiting the wineries out in the Grand River Valley with my mother for many years now! Several of my favorite spots are Grand River Cellars for their White Fox white wine and beautiful patio and Cask 307 for their artisan charcuterie board!

What advice would you give first-time visitors to make the most of their trip?

I would encourage first-time visitors to follow along with one of our seasonal bucket lists that highlight many of our local attractions! There is a little something for everyone and you can plan an itinerary around several tasks!

What aspect of Lake County do you think surprises visitors the most?

There is so much history in Lake County. When you learn about the Unionville Tavern near Madison, Ohio and the connection with the Underground Railroad, or climb the Fairport Lighthouse Marine Museum Lighthouse and discover "The light that shone for 100 years," you begin to feel a part of Lake County's story during your visit. Just down the street, the Painesville Railroad Museum is dedicated to the restoration of the NYC Painesville Depot. One of my favorite locations is the Madison Seminary that once functioned as a school, hospital, and as housing for the families of those killed in the American Civil War. It is notably one of the most haunted locations in Ohio and first opened in 1846!

Beach Days + Lake Erie Sunsets at the Perry Bluffs. Fairport Harbor Beach is the perfect spot for our family because it not only offers perfect beach views of Lake Erie and sandy spots for castles and picnic lunches, but the snack stands, bathrooms (kids!), playground, and close parking all help make the day go smoothly. We also love catching the beautiful water-kissed sunset along the lake from up high on the Bluff Observation Tower or down below along the shoreline where you can look for beach glass too!

Are there any hidden gems or lesser-known spots that visitors would enjoy?

A recent "hidden gem" we can't go a few weeks without is the the chocolate-dipped, fruit-topped popsicles at Mmm Yummy located in the square in Downtown Painesville. Our girls love trying new fun toppings like pineapple or cheesecake bites while I stick with my go-to frozen strawberry with double chocolate dip, chocolate sprinkles, and two fresh strawberries.

How would you describe the local culture and community spirit to someone from out of town? So welcoming! We moved here three years ago and every shop owner and community member we've met along the way has never been anything but kind, helpful, and ready to offer recommendations on where to go and what to see.

What advice would you give first-time visitors to make the most of their trip?

First-timers; check the events calendar on our website and plan your trip around an outdoor festival or concert. Live music outdoors on a summer evening is a great way to get immersed into our communities while relaxing, keeping everyone entertained. If your family loves the beach like we do, plan a weekend to Fairport Harbor during one of the many summer events hosted in town and at the historical Lighthouse. This small town offers family fun all day from the beach to mini-golf, ice cream, arts and crafts and historical tours.

Kirtland Temple

Visit First Latter-day Saint Temple

Built by Kirtland Latter-day Saints out of their poverty from 1833 to 1836, this is the first temple of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Today it is a National Historic Landmark, and a site held sacred by millions. Tours of the historic temple—named one of 100 holiest places in the worldbegin every half hour. 

Growing the Grand River Valley

t might come as a shock to many consumers that Ohio was America's largest wine producer in the late 1800's. It will surprise even more people that over 50% of Ohio's grape output and a large portion of its first-quality fruit is currently grown in the Grand River Valley, a region bordering Lake Erie, 45 miles

This region now contains more than thirty wineries with over 1,300 acres of prime vineyards and is producing award-winning products.

east of Cleveland.

The Grand River Valley American Viticultural Area (AVA) is a subregion of the three-state Lake Erie (AVA). It was established in 1983. after a petition

was submitted to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms by Anthony P. Debevec, past President of Chalet Debonne Vineyards, Inc. Where appropriate soil and climate meet, passionate grape growers and winemakers soon follow.

When Ohio was America's largest wine producer, they were focused on Catawba, Concord and other native and French/American hybrid grapes, with much of the fruit going to make sweet wines and grape juice. Prohibition in 1920 shut down the industry in the vibrant Grand River Valley, though the introduction of

> cold-tolerant grape varietals resulted in a resurgence of the region.

Arnuff Esterer of Markko Vineyard, guided by Russian viticulturalist Dr. Konstantin Frank, grew top-quality Vinifera grapes successfully along Lake Erie and helped spread their use to other producers. The

Grand River Valley AVA is now known as a premium wine region of Vinifera varietals that have been winning prestigious awards in major wine competitions.

The glaciers were vital to quality Vitus Vinifera wine grape production in Northeastern Ohio. They carved

out Lake Erie and the Grand River. essential in the winter survival of the vines. Lake Erie extends the short growing season with its fall warmth, helping the vines ripen their fruit in a cool climate. Glaciers mixed and positioned various soil types into porous layers in southeastern-facing slopes for the vines to catch morning sunlight.

Before the lake freezes, it protects the vines by encouraging insulating snow production. It prevents early bud break in the spring by being colder than the land. Breezes formed by the lake's influence prevent frosts in the fall and spring and mildew during the growing season. Having the Grand River nearby increases the impact of water. The hills aid in cold air drainage to protect against frost. Excess rainfall is also removed, encouraging concentration in the wines.

Some history and observations by a few of our wineries:

Debonne Vinevards – Anton Debevec immigrated from Yugoslavia, purchasing a Madison fruit farm in 1916 and expanding the vineyards with son Tony Sr. The winery was founded in 1972. They are Ohio's largest grape grower. Owner Tony Debevec Jr. states, "Grand River's uniqueness is similar to cooler climate regions in Europe, with varied vintage character but good quality wines every year."

Ferrante Winery - In 1942 the Ferrante's grandparents bought the farm for its Concord vines, opening their winery in 1973. Nick Ferrante states, "We are fortunate to have





the river and lake in close proximity, working together to produce a unique meso-climate."

Laurello Vineyards – Grandfather Laurello immigrated to Ashtabula in 1917, purchasing a grape farm in 1991. The family opened their winery in 2001. Laurello states, "On still nights with frost, the flowing river creates air movement, protecting our vines. Improved

vineyard and cellar practices have dramatically increased the region's wine quality."

M Cellars - Owners Matt and Tara Meineke saw the potential in the Grand River after a trip to Niagaraon-the-lake, founding M Cellars in 2008. Meineke states, "Lake Erie moderates our climate and cold air gets caught in the river valley, protecting our vines."

Kosicek Vineyards - Tony Kosicek converted the 3rd generation family farm to a winery in 2012, after his parents passed, not wanting to deal with the numerous taxes involved. He states, "The Grand River Valley is a special place. There aren't many regions in the world that can grow cool climate, high quality grapes."

Cask Three Oh Seven – Founded in 2019 by Debevec Farms Estates to experiment with new varietals, winemaking techniques and showcase the Grand River's best potential. Winemaker Mike Koller states, "Our region's wines are balanced and quite food friendly. They are perfect for daily consumption."

Baci Winery – Dominic and Shelly Piunno purchased the former St. Joseph Vineyard in 2021. Winemaker Lauren Fiala states, "I see excellent quality potential in the Grand River. Numerous wineries are growing award-winning wines with refreshing acidity."

In the last decade, the number of quality Grand River AVA wineries has grown dramatically, due to the awareness of the region's potential for fine wine production. New producers include Hundley Cellars (2014), Laurentia Vineyard & Winery (2015), Silver Crest Cellars (2018), Stonegait Winery (2019), Rosabella Winery (2020), Day Dream Farm Winery & Mead (2023), Vincent William Wine (2024) and Fossil Creek Winery (2024).

While complex, dry wines define the appellation, one of their rising stars is ice wine. Grapes hang well beyond normal harvest and are picked and pressed while frozen, concentrating flavor, sweetness and piquant acidity. The AVA's ice wines rival the finest global releases.

ainesville may be one of the oldest communities in the Western Reserve and the State of Ohio, but it is not showing its age in this Historic City. Painesville is becoming younger, with a median age of 31. Young families and professionals are drawn to the city due to its low cost of living and proximity to

the lake. In recent years, Painesville has experienced significant economic growth, with several major projects underway that will transform this charming county seat of Lake County.

"One of our main goals is to improve the quality of life for our residents and become a destination in eastern Lake County."

said Doug Lewis, Painesville City Manager. In 2024, Painesville opened its first city splash pad in Kiwanis Recreation Park, a new dog park near the Grand River, and two new youth soccer fields. "We are looking to make additional improvements to Rec Park, including a potential zip-line park, pickleball courts, and upgrading our skatepark," added Lewis.

"The splash pad is a perfect getaway for summer afternoons, where families can bring their young

ones in a safe environment and relax," said Public Lands Director Michelle LaPuma. "Both the dog park and splash pad were highly suggested amenities by residents when we conducted surveys and asked for feedback. I think it's a wonderful use of public land."

In 2024, a significant project was completed: the new student housing at Lake Erie College, located on the southern side of Painesville Square. This project was a collaboration with Renew Partners, transforming the former Chase **Bank Building** at the corner of Liberty Street and S Park Place into modern living quarters for undergraduate students. The revitalized building has

retained much of its mid-century modern architecture and now houses 171 students. Additionally, it features a fitness floor, shared study spaces, and two new restaurants set to open on the ground floor.

The Tower's restaurants, El Paladar de Mexico (offering Mexican cuisine) and Pho Sunshine (serving Vietnamese cuisine), are the latest dining options to join the city. Another addition in 2024 was Zapp's

Custard and Mustard on S State Street, which revitalized a previously forgotten corner into a neighborhood hotspot. LayR, a new, elegant event venue in the charming Main Street area, opened its doors in 2024 as well. The venue boasts 5,675 square feet of event space and can host weddings and events for up to 150 people. Crowley's Dive Bar, known for its award-winning smash burgers, is set to open on S St. Clair Street in 2025. Meanwhile, the City's Economic Development Office is working to bring a new brewery to the downtown area. While these new establishments contribute fresh energy to previously underutilized areas, Painesville is primarily renowned in the region for its outstanding authentic Mexican restaurants, five of which are part of Lake County's Taco Trail.

Renew Partners is undertaking several projects around Painesville Square, including revitalizing the large 191,000–square-foot Victoria Place building. This former mall, converted into an office space, will be transformed into a mixed-use development featuring 75 to 80 market-rate apartments on the upper floors and commercial office space on the first floor.

office space on the first floor.
"The renovation of Victoria Place will be a great addition to Painesville by attracting new residents to our downtown and providing additional office space for new tenants," said Lewis.

Painesville Square is undergoing significant changes, and the Main Street area is no exception. Marous Brothers is moving forward with plans to build a new 149,000-square-foot apartment complex, including a restaurant and an outdoor seating area overlooking Kiwanis Recreation Park, situated off the Main Street hill. This project will connect to a new city-owned amphitheater that will be constructed on the hillside, providing views of both the park and the Grand River.

"We are thrilled that developers and builders are showing interest in Painesville. We also deeply appreciate the support from our Lake County Commissioners and our state and federal elected officials. By collaborating, we have made significant improvements," said Lewis. "Exciting things are happening in Painesville! We invite visitors and Lake County residents alike to come and explore."

I grew up in Lake County, graduated from Lake Erie College, moved to Cuyahoga County for a while, and moved back a few years ago, which I am ecstatic about! I have really come to appreciate Lake County so much more.

What would be some advice you would give to people who have never kayaked before and would like to try?

If you've never kayaked before, I suggest three things: find a place that rents the gear (don't buy a kayak before you try it), go with a buddy or a guide, go out on flat (easy) water. Also, remember that you need energy to paddle back so don't go crazy far before you know your limits.


Where are your typical weekend plans? I get outside most weekends, year-round. Whether it's one of the many trails in Lake Metroparks, Headlands Beach State Park, or playing tourist in one of the many quaint towns, I love to explore outside.

Her GO-TO Kayak Hot Spots

- 1. Grand River Landing Park (no rentals available) in Fairport Harbor because of the diversity you see along the Grand River in this section. You go from quiet, wildlife viewing, to the party atmosphere of the marinas and Pickle Bills, then through the industrial side before you paddle into Lake Erie.
- 2. Chagrin River Kayak (rentals available) for similar reasons to Grand River Landing. You kayak through neighborhoods and it's usually pretty festive and lively along the banks. There are some quiet spots too and it's so beautiful through the little inlets.
- 3. Mentor Lagoons Nature Preserve and Marina (rentals available) This is one of my favorite places for birding. It's a great place to paddle if you want quiet, solitude, and a chance to take some bird photography. The wildflowers are incredible, too. I highly recommend going for a sunrise paddle here.

A familiar face in Fairport Harbor, Justin has been married to his wife, Jenny, for 12 years, and together they raise two energetic children, Liz and Lou.

Justin's involvement with Fairport Harbor Arts and Culture Alliance (FHACA) began as a founding member, inspired by a shared vision of bringing the arts and cultural events to the forefront of Fairport Harbor. The idea to form the organization took shape in late 2019 when the Fairport Harbor Concert Series changed hands between various community members. The founding members of FHACA saw an opportunity to build a new 501(c)(3) non-profit organization with the concerts as the foundation, and a commitment to supporting Fairport Harbor Schools as a key beneficiary. While the early days of planning were interrupted by the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, the team was undeterred.

"Even with the setbacks, we stayed focused on our goal," Justin recalls. "We've continued to host family-friendly, arts-centered events that bring the community together and attract visitors from far and wide."

What makes FHACA truly unique is its 100% volunteer-based, community-driven approach. Comprised of small business owners, community leaders, and local volunteers, the executive team of FHACA work tirelessly to organize events. Through collaboration and a deep sense of civic pride, FHACA has become a driving force in energizing the local arts scene.

One of the most exciting events spearheaded by FHACA is the annual Port Plunge, a fun and frosty way to kick off the new year while raising funds for the community. Inspired by a suggestion from FHACA member Lee Negrelli, owner of Rabbit Food, the inaugural Port Plunge took place on New Year's Day 2024. What started as a crazy idea quickly gained momentum, with over 100 participants taking the plunge into the frigid waters of Lake Erie, all in the name of supporting the Fairport Harbor Concert Series.

The first plunge was a resounding success, with participants braving the cold waters and a crowd of supporters cheering them on from the shore. "We were overwhelmed by the response," Justin says. "It went from 20 people to over 100 in just a few days, which shows how strong the spirit of our community is."



This year, the second annual Port Plunge promised even more excitement, with safety as a top priority. Participants registered online and are given group numbers to ensure a smooth and organized plunge into the lake. The event is family-friendly, with fires burning on the beach to warm up after the dive, hot coffee from Julbean's Coffee and Crêpes, and pizza from Rego's Brickhouse Pizza to refuel.

At the heart of FHACA's mission is a commitment to supporting the local community and small businesses. Justin emphasizes the importance of shopping, marketing, and collaborating with local vendors whenever possible. "We're deeply invested in our town," he says. "Rather than relying on outside donations, we purchase raffle prizes from local businesses and actively seek partnerships to help make our events possible."

In 2024 alone, FHACA collaborated with over 25 small Lake County businesses, holding six successful one-day public events. Additionally, the organization donated art supplies to the local elementary school and supported various local sports teams and school groups.

"We prioritize local businesses, and we know that by supporting them, we're helping our community thrive," Justin adds. "It's about building an ecosystem where everyone-residents, business owners, and visitorsbenefits."

For Justin, volunteering with FHACA has been a transformative experience. "I never imagined how much this small village could give back," he says. "Seeing my children grow up with such a strong sense of community and service has been inspiring. I've gained a deeper love for volunteering and a real appreciation for what we're doing here in Fairport Harbor."

Through his involvement in FHACA, Justin has found a renewed sense of purpose. The collaboration with local business owners and community members to make a real difference has been fulfilling, and he's excited to see the positive changes.

As Fairport Harbor continues to flourish, it's clear that organizations like FHACA, led by passionate individuals like Justin, are making a profound impact. From the arts to recreation, from supporting small businesses to fostering a sense of togetherness, FHACA is at the heart of it allensuring that this lakeside community remains a vibrant, welcoming destination.






