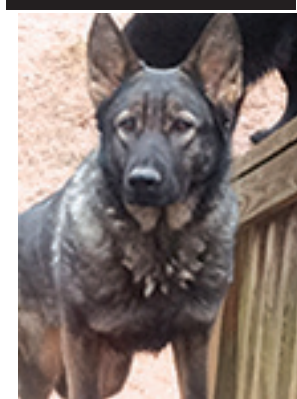

Identifying Glass

Glass can be notoriously difficult to identify. Signatures, if there are any, can be faked, molds can be reused, and glassmakers often imitated one another's decorations. Stiegel-type glass is an excellent example.

We know that Henry William Stiegel came to Philadelphia from Germany in 1750. We know he had a glasshouse in Manheim, Pennsylvania, from 1763 to 1774. Confirming that a piece of glass came from his glasshouse is nearly impossible. To begin with, the glass he made was similar to what was made in Germany at the time: thin-walled, mold-blown glass decorated with enamel or engraving. The same type of glass was made by other American glassmakers and imported from Europe.

In the 20th century, copies were made as giftware. To further complicate matters, some collectors doubt that Stiegel actually made any multicolored enamel glass, like this cologne bottle that sold at the Conestoga Auction Company Division of Hess Auction Group for \$312. The auction described it as "Stiegel-type" instead of attributing it to Stiegel or any other glassmaker.

You can search online or check ads in antiques publications for collectors or clubs specializing in antique microscopes or scientific or optical tools. You can also check medical supply companies; some of them also deal in antique equipment.

TIP: Shallow nicks and rough edges on glass can sometimes be smoothed off with fine emery paper.

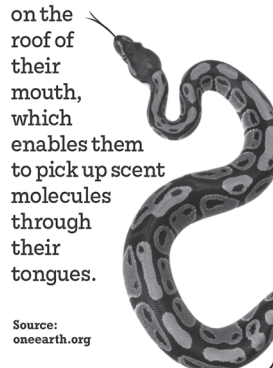

Ribbon cutting celebrates The View at Franklin's new housing development

Mayor Alonzo Jones, members of Danville City Council, and city staff joined developers recently to celebrate the ribbon cutting for The View at Franklin, a large-scale, market-rate multifamily community at 340 East Franklin Turnpike.

"The developer is experimenting with a new rental product in the community that has generated a lot of interest from real estate professionals and other developers," McCulloch said. "It's great that the units are already filling up."

Colin Wolfe, developer of The View at Franklin, expressed excitement about the project's impact on Danville's housing market:

"Today marks a transformative moment for housing in Danville as we celebrate the ribbon cutting and grand opening of The View at Franklin," Wolfe said. "This community introduces a new standard for market-rate living, offering top-tier amenities and modern, resort-style finishes—something truly unique to the city. More than just a place to live, The View at Franklin is designed to provide residents with both comfort and convenience, nestled in a scenic setting with easy access to major highways and downtown. We're thrilled to bring this vision to life and to be part of Danville's continued growth."

The first phase consists of five apartment buildings, each with 27 units, offering a mix of:

- 45 one-bedroom apartments (852 sq. ft.)
- 75 two-bedroom apartments (1,200 sq. ft.)
- 15 three-bedroom apartments (1,376 sq. ft.)

Each unit features 9-foot ceilings, stainless steel appliances, spacious balconies or porches, and kitchen islands with breakfast bars.

A second phase will add 105 more apartments to the community, further expanding Danville's market-rate housing options.

The City of Danville supported the project with real estate tax and residential grants from the Industrial Development Authority.

The auditorium will also be filled with displays on Scottish culture including information on the Highland Clans and their tartans, ancient dress, crest badges, coat of arms, and ancient territories. House of Representatives Resolution 41 on March 9, 2005. It became official with a Presidential Proclamation by President George W. Bush on April 6, 2008. The date of April 6 was chosen because the Declaration of Arbroath, the Scottish Declaration of Independence, was signed on April 6, 1320. This was one of the greatest and most important statements of human rights ever written, and our own Declaration of Independence was modeled on this inspirational document.

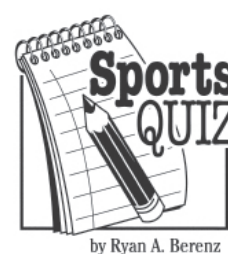

Baked Corn Beef and Cabbage Hash



INGREDIENTS

- T1 wedge leftover cooked cabbage
- Kosher salt
- Pepper
- 2 Tbsp. olive oil
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 8 oz. leftover sliced or deli corned beef
- 1 clove garlic, finely chopped
- 1/2 cup chopped fresh flat-leaf parsley
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 1 Tbsp. Dijon mustard
- 1 lb. russet potatoes, sliced
- 6 oz. Gruyère cheese, grated

INSTRUCTIONS

Heat oven to 375 degrees F. If using fresh cabbage, bring a small pot of water to a boil. Add 2 teaspoons salt and the cabbage and cook for 5 minutes; drain and squeeze out any excess moisture.

Step 2
Heat the oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add the onion and 1/4 teaspoon each salt and pepper and cook, covered, stirring occasionally, until tender, 8 to 10 minutes. Add the corned beef and garlic and cook, stirring occasionally, for 4 minutes. Remove from heat and fold in the cabbage and parsley.

Step 3
Coat a deep 8- by 8-inch square baking dish with oil. In a bowl, whisk together the heavy cream and mustard.

Step 4
Lay a third of the potatoes in the baking dish, slightly overlapping them. Top with a third of the corned beef and cabbage mixture (about 1 cup) and sprinkle with a third of the cheese (about 1/3 cup); repeat once. Top with a last layer of potatoes and cabbage mixture. Pour the cream mixture into the dish.

Step 5
Cover the baking dish with foil, place on a rimmed baking sheet and bake for 45 minutes. Uncover, sprinkle with the remaining cheese, and bake until the potatoes are tender and the top is golden brown, 25 to 30 minutes more. Let rest for 10 minutes before serving.

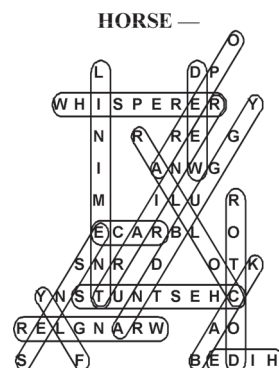

* Have your carpets cleaned. High-traffic areas may require it as much as every three or four months, but bedrooms can go as long as 18 months. Use runners and area rugs to safeguard spots that may be vulnerable, like under a vanity or by your sofas.

* "I had some residue on my bathroom ceiling from hard water condensation. I happened to have a set of crutches lying around. I used a hair elastic to secure a hand towel to the arm rest of one crutch. Then I sprayed it with water and used it to scrub the ceiling. It worked really well.
