#### Identifying Glass

Glass can be notoriously difficult to identify. Signatures, if there are any, can be faked, molds can be reused, and glassmakers often imitated one another's decorations. Stiegel-type glass is an excellent example.

We know that Henry William Stiegel came to Philadelphia from Germany in 1750. We know he had a glasshouse in Manheim, Pennsylvania, from 1763 to 1774. Confirming that a piece of glass came from his glasshouse is nearly impossible. To begin with, the glass he made was similar to what was made in Germany at the time: thinwalled, mold-blown glass decorated with enamel or engraving. The same type of glass was made by other American glassmakers and imported from Europe.

In the 20th century, copies were made as giftware. To further complicate matters, some collectors doubt that Stiegel actually made any multicolored enamel glass, like this cologne bottle that sold at the Conestoga Auction Company Division of Hess Auction Group for \$312. The auction described it as "Stiegel-type" instead of attributing it to Stiegel or any other glassmaker.

Both Verick and Hartnack were highly regarded microscope makers in the 1860s and '70s. Antique microscopes with a known maker can sell for about \$250 to \$500 at general antiques auctions. Usually, the more information (maker, date, etc.), the higher the value. The original box, slides and other "extras" also increase the value. If there are any antique shops

or auction houses in your area, check to see if they sell microscopes or related antiques like binoculars, scientific instruments or medical equipment. You can search online or check ads in antiques publications for collectors or clubs specializing in antique microscopes or scientific or optical tools. You can also check medical supply companies; some of them also deal in antique equipment.



More than just a place to live, The View at Franklin is designed to provide residents with both comfort and convenience, nestled in a scenic setting with easy access to major highways and downtown. We're thrilled to bring this vision to life and to be part of Danville's continued growth."

The first phase consists of five apartment buildings, each with 27 units, offering a mix of:

- 45 one-bedroom apartments (852 sq. ft.)
- 75 two-bedroom apartments (1,200 sq. ft.)
- 15 three-bedroom apartments (1,376 sq. ft.)

Each unit features 9-foot ceilings, stainless steel appliances, spacious balconies or porches, and kitchen islands with break-fast bars.

The date of April 6 was chosen because the Declaration of Arbroath, the Scottish Declaration of Independence, was signed on April 6, 1320. This was one of the greatest and most important statements of human rights ever written, and our own Declaration of Independence was modeled on this inspirational document.

Project Imagine equips participants with tools to build productive lives through mentorship, goal-setting, and strength-based assessments using Casey Life Skills and Clifton Strengths tools. These resources help place youths on a path toward achieving goals such as avoiding law enforcement contact, improving grades, completing school, and securing employment.

Each participant is also assigned a dedicated outreach worker who provides mentorship for at least one year.





T1 wedge leftover cooked cabbage Kosher salt Pepper 2 Tbsp. olive oil 1 medium onion, chopped 8 oz. leftover sliced or deli corned beef 1 clove garlic, finely chopped 1/2 cup chopped fresh flat-leaf parsley 1 cup heavy cream 1Tbsp. Dijon mustard 1lb. russet potatoes, sliced

6 oz. Gruyère cheese, grated

### INSTRUCTIONS

Heat oven to 375 degrees F. If using fresh cabbage, bring a small pot of water to a boil. Add 2 teaspoons salt and the cabbage and cook for 5 minutes; drain and squeeze out any excess moisture.

#### Step 2

Heat the oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add the onion and 1/4 teaspoon each salt and pepper and cook, covered, stirring occasionally, until tender, 8 to 10 minutes. Add the corned beef and garlic and cook, stirring occasionally, for 4 minutes. Remove from heat and fold in the



#### Step 3

Coat a deep 8- by 8-inch square baking dish with oil. In a bowl, whisk together the heavy cream and mustard.

#### Step 4

Lay a third of the potatoes in the baking dish, slightly overlapping them. Top with a third of the corned beef and cabbage mixture (about 1 cup) and sprinkle with a third of the cheese (about 1/3 cup); repeat once. Top with a last layer of potatoes and cabbage mixture. Pour the cream mixture into the dish.

### Step 5

Cover the baking dish with foil, place on a rimmed baking sheet and bake for 45 minutes. Uncover, sprinkle with the remaining cheese, and bake until the potatoes are tender and the top is golden brown, 25 to 30 minutes more. Let rest for 10 minutes before serving.
