We are thrilled to let you know that we are having another free microchip clinic through the courtesy of the John B. and Elizabeth Hall Animal Rescue Fund at the shelter from 11 a.m.-1 p.m. on Saturday, April 12th, in conjunction with our Easter Bunny photo event. We even register the chip for you!

Lots of circumstances cause a dog or cat to be lost, independent of actions of the owners. For instance, gates are left open by accident, they dart out of an open door, they may wiggle out of a collar attached to a leash, etc.

Millions of lost dogs and cats enter shelters each year, and relatively few are returned to the owner, unless that owner has been diligent about providing an easy way home for the animal.

What is the best way an owner can help ensure their lost animal (dog, cat) can return home?

The answer is a simple one – microchip that animal. Shelters and veterinary clinics scan for microchips and many animals are reunited with their owners.

A tiny transponder, called a microchip, the size of a grain of uncooked rice may solve many of these problems. This is a permanent identification system implanted under the animal's skin and read by a chip scanner. Implantation is done with an injector that places the chip under the loose skin between the shoulder blades.

The advantages are numerous.

The process is quick and no more painful than a vaccination. The chip does not get lost, and a simple procedure with a scanner alerts a shelter that a microchip has been inserted. The owner's name and address can be registered on a national or regional database.

A registered microchip can be a way to help your animal come home, and it can also be proof that the animal belongs to you.

Currently, microchips do not function as a GPS device, although it would be wonderful if they had that capability.

This will be for residents of Danville and Pittsylvania County and there will be a limit of two per household. You will need to sign a statement that this is your animal and you are not going to advertise it for sale or giveaway.

Bread Boxes

Many of us have a bread box in the kitchen. It's usually a simple, purely utilitarian affair made of metal or plastic; nothing as fancy as a carved panetiere like this one that sold for \$1,408 at Neal Auction.

Panetieres were made and used in the Provencal region of France by the 1600s. Like the bread boxes of today, they kept loaves of bread safe from pests while allowing air to circulate to prevent mold. Unlike the humble bread box, they were made from wood with decorative carvings. This one features a carved and painted lyre door, turned posts, scrolling supports and a carved crest and apron.

Recall the cultural significance of bread in France, and the fancy panetiere is perfectly fitting. After widespread hunger and extreme inequality fueled the Revolution, a law made in 1793 required bakers, under the penalty of imprisonment, to make the same type of bread for the rich and poor alike. In 1993, a decree declared that only four ingredients could be used for traditional French bread: water, salt, wheat flour and yeast or starter. UNESCO granted the most famous type of French bread, the baguette, world heritage status in 2022. An antique panetiere is certainly fit for a cultural treasure.

Q: My brother has an old Lone Ranger lamp from when he was little. Can you tell us the value of it?

A: "The Lone Ranger" radio show made its debut in 1932. The first movie was made in 1938, and the television show ran from 1949 to 1957. Toys and memorabilia remained popular after the show ended and are collectible today. We have seen multiple styles of Lone Ranger lamps. There is one with a figure on horseback on the base and one shaped like a covered wagon. There is also a Lone Ranger "Chuck Wagon" lantern that was made as a toy but could work as a real lantern if fuel was added. (The packaging

for the lantern warned kids to leave that part to the grown-ups!) Early Lone Ranger toys often sell for over \$100. The exact value of your lamp will depend on which one it is and its condition.

TIP: A brisk rubbing with olive oil will remove most alcohol stains from wood.

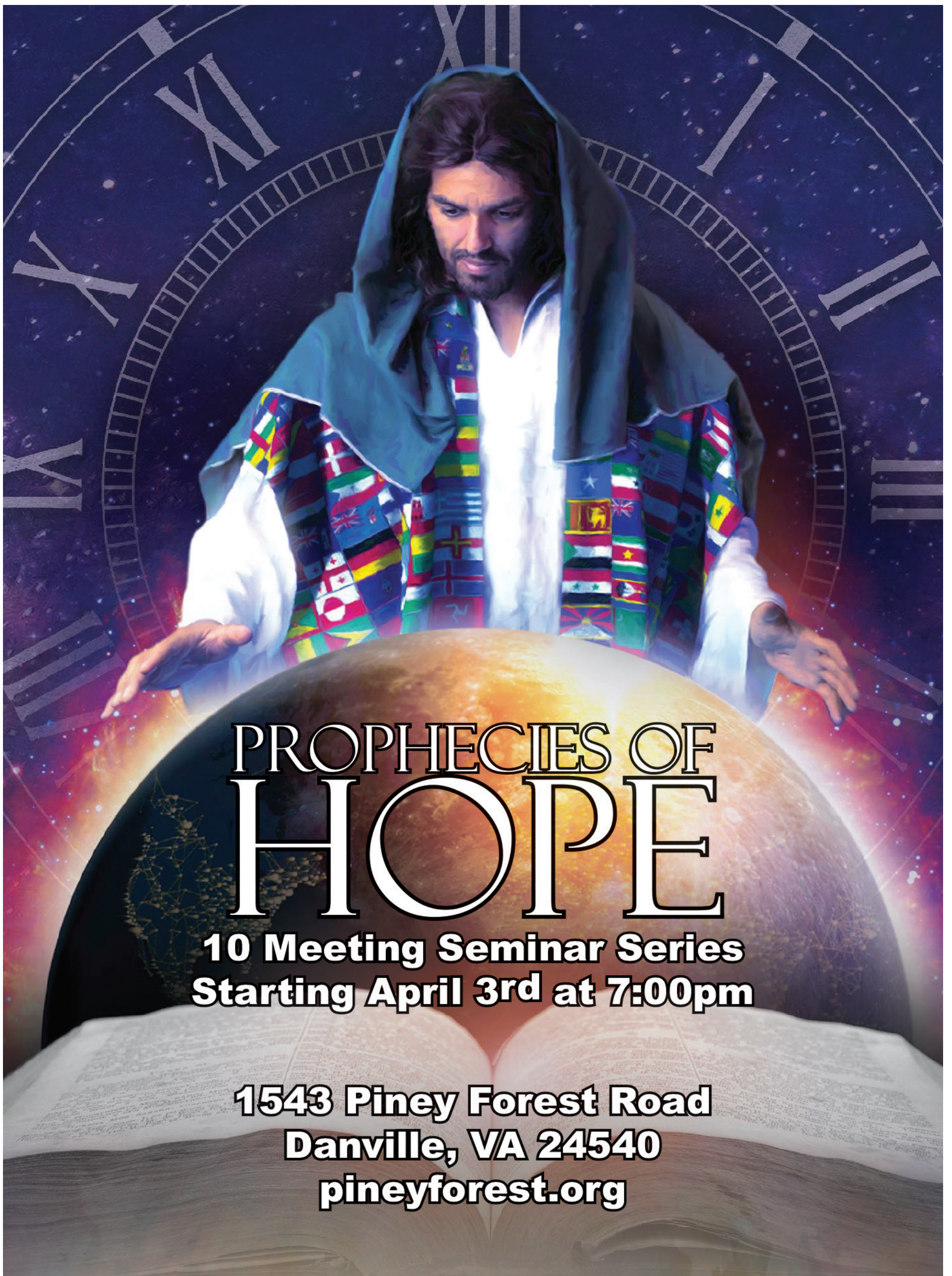

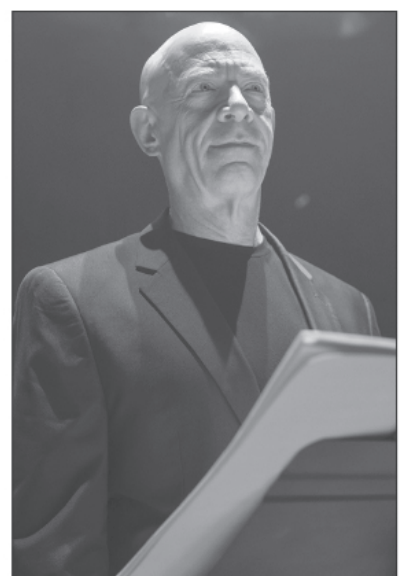
HOLLYWOOD by Tony Rizzo

QUICK SKILLET CHEESY FAJITA NACHOS



INGREDIENTS

- 1 teaspoon olive oil
- 1/2 cup sliced red or yellow onion
- 1 bell pepper, any color, seeded and sliced or diced
- 1 cup fresh or frozen corn kernels
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 (15-ounce) can black beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 cup chopped Roma or cherry tomatoes
- 1/4 cup chicken broth
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1 tablespoon fresh lime juice
- 3 cups cooked chopped chicken, (or leftover turkey!)
- 2 cups shredded Monterey Jack or sharp cheddar cheese, or a combination
- Tortilla chips
- Optional toppings: sour cream, salsa, olives, fresh cilantro, avocado, or any other topping you like

INSTRUCTIONS

In a 12-inch nonstick skillet, heat the olive oil over medium heat. Add the onions, bell pepper, corn, salt and pepper. Sauté the vegetables, stirring occasionally, for 3-4 minutes until they have softened and onions have turned translucent. Add the beans, tomatoes, broth, cumin, and oregano. Bring the mixture to a gentle simmer, and cook for 5 minutes, stirring occasionally to prevent sticking. Stir in the chicken and lime juice. Cook until heated through, 1-2 minutes. Season to taste with additional salt and pepper, if needed. Sprinkle the cheese over the top of the mixture and cover with a lid or foil until the cheese is melted, 2-3 minutes. Serve the fajita mixture over tortilla chips with any taco/fajita toppings you like.

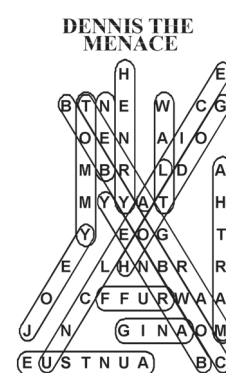
