





Although originally brought the colonies German settlers, this art form gradually disappeared until Adams County, Ohio brought it back in 2001. To

things going Regina here, contacted Hood, Bob Executive Director of Galia County Ohio Visitors Bureau. He said, "I've been to other quilt barn trails, and I have seen the impact that can have bringing tourists and people spending monev.

Regina's next was to get in touch with Joel Dickerson, head of the Lauderdale County Farmers Federation. Joel thought it was a fantastic idea. With his go ahead, Regina looked to Alfa and Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) for funding. They were generous with their assistance.

The project continued without a snag. She next contacted the University of North Alabama Art Department, hoping they had an artist interested in undertaking such a project. They immediately thought of Naomi Skye, a recent graduate with a B.S. in art.







grandfather and designed to hold hay on the upper level and house cows below. It's still doing that job today. The beautiful square was mounted by Mr. Cupp, Mr. Balch, and two Allen Thornton Tech students.

The third barn boasting quilt art here is on a barn by Charlie and owned Cynthia Thompson in Lexington. The barn was built in 1923 by Cynthia's great-grandfather. It has three rooms – a large one in the middle with a loft and two smaller ones on each side. Apparently, the smaller rooms were used for farm implements and the larger one for livestock.

Regina says this is just the beginning. "We need barns, donations, and artists," she said. "I love old barns. They bring me back to my country roots. In today's environment the farm and our rural heritage are often pushed into the background. We can change that with Quilt Trails that promote agritourism, art, architecture, culture, and history."



in Charlotte, following passage of a North Carolina law that prevents cities from creating nondiscrimination policies based on gender identity."

Interesting phrasing. The measure North Carolina's State House and Senate passed overwhelmingly last week simply said that a person has to use a bathroom based on his or her biological sex. There were five groups of women that became the backbone of our men in the five services of the Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, Marine Corp, and Navy. According to the Women in Military Service for America Memorial Foundation, that number stood at about 400,000. This exceeded the total men troop strength in 1939.

Quite a few served in combat positions. They earned Purple Hearts, Bronze Stars, and Legions of Merit. Some were held as prisoners of war and some died in service to their country. My point is that those in charge of who gets interred in Arlington are off of their

"We're putting back the excitement in tournament bass fishing," Harrison said. "You don't have to weigh-in a fish every hour. 

I purchased a 2011 Ford F150 pickup truck from a local used car dealer. The truck looked very nice and the questions that I asked about the truck were answered to my satisfaction and it only had 24,000 miles on it and seemed to be well taken care of. A little over a week after I bought it the transmission began to fail and it would cost about \$4000 to fix or replace. The place where I bought the truck said they would see if they could help me find a transmission at wholesale and that's all they were willing to do. I obviously bought a lemon and I think Alabama has a lemon law. Does it apply in this case?

Unfortunately, you only get the warranty that you agree upon when you purchase a used vehicle unless it is still under the manufacturer's original warranty. A

car bought "as is" has no warranty.

Alabama does have a lemon law and it is found at Alabama Code §8-20A-2 but it only applies to new vehicles.

For the lemon law to apply the motor vehicle has to be out of service and in the care of the dealer for a cumulative total of 30 calendar days due to repair attempts. The dealer gets three repair attempts plus one additional attempt by the manufacturer to fix the car.

If, after reasonable attempts to fix the car have been made, either by repairing or correcting the condition of the motor vehicle which occurred within 24 months or 24,000 miles whichever first occurs, the manufacturer shall, at the option of the consumer, replace the motor vehicle with a comparable new motor vehicle or shall accept return of the vehicle from the consumer and refund the following: full contract price, sales tax, license and registration fees and all finance charges incurred by the consumer after he first reported the nonconformity.

When buying a used car, you do have the option of having a pre-purchase inspection by a reputable mechanic. You also have the opportunity to ask for a period of time in which you can return the car. You could also ask for a 30 day warranty.

I have dealt with cases years ago where people would buy commercially available for used cars. The limited experience that I can share is that, at least for the ones I saw, they were completely useless. That's not to say that there may be some commercially available warranty for used cars that may be reputable and give good service if needed.

Remember that Alabama's Lemon Law only applies to new vehicles. If your bill of sale indicates that you bought the car with the agreement and understanding that it was purchased "as is" there is no warranty.

Buckle up and drive safely.

BUG BOMB?

Not so fast. Going nuclear with antibiotics can cause bigger problems than it solves

hat's the first thing you do when you're feeling sick or your pet has diarrhea? Is it to ask your doctor or the veterinarian to prescribe antibiotics to knock down whatever it is quickly?

That's a common request in human and veterinary medicine, but it's not necessarily the right one. From urinary tract infections to dental disease, antibiotics seem to be the easy answer, but their overuse in animals and humans is creating resistant bacteria. Instead of being killed off by the drugs, bacteria continue to multiply, becoming stronger than ever. That makes them ever more difficult to treat. And oftentimes, they're not even necessary.

"Lots of ailments that we see are caused by viruses, which antibiotics won't do anything for," says Tony Johnson, DVM, an emergency and critical-care specialist. "Lots of ailments that we see are going to go away on their own without antibiotics. We prescribe antibiotics for things that there's absolutely no need for. If a dog gets hit by a car and doesn't have a mark on it, he doesn't need antibiotics. If a dog has a cut less than the size of a dime, it'll heal on its own; he doesn't need antibiotics. Veterinarians are as guilty of this as the general public."

A review of antibiotic use in dogs, published in June 2011 in the Journal of Small Animal Practice, found that there was a confirmed infection in only 17 percent of the prescriptions. In 45 percent, infection was suspected; for instance, the patient had an

open wound or discharge from the eyes or nose. In 38 percent, there was no documented evidence of infection. In those cases, the antibiotics were often given for "preventive" reasons, such as after surgery.

A better practice is to culture the skin, blood, urine or other tissue to confirm an infection and pinpoint the type of bacteria causing it. That allows the most appropriate antibiotic to be prescribed.

"If we see a big, infected wound or if we have a dog with pneumonia, we can culture that, find out what the bug is and what antibiotic will specifically target it, as opposed to using an overly broad-spectrum antibiotic that isn't needed," Dr. Johnson says.

But cultures can be expensive. While the cost of a culture is often worth it, not everyone is willing or able to pay for it. That leaves veterinarians guessing at the best way to proceed. If they guess incorrectly, the dog or cat is in discomfort longer than necessary, and they are potentially contributing to the problem of bacterial resistance to antibiotics.

What's the answer? The World Health Organization and other institutions are calling for antibiotic stewardship: using the drugs only in cases with a definite diagnosis, ruling out viral and fungal infections, parasites and other conditions that don't respond to antimicrobial therapies.

For instance, antimicrobials aren't indicated

for viral upper respiratory infections such as feline herpesvirus or canine influenza unless they are accompanied by secondary bacterial infections. Most cases of feline lower urinary tract disease don't involve bacterial infection. Treatments such as a change in diet or stress relief techniques are more effective. And some wounds may simply require cleaning with a topical antiseptic solution.

"If your dog or cat or child is not in pain and it's not life-threatening, let their body deal with it, whatever it is," Dr. Johnson says. "Antibiotics are a very powerful tool, and they save lives, so you don't want to not use them when necessary, but the main thing to understand is that they are not a cure-all."

But until recently, spectators at dogfights got off lightly. In 24 states, the act of attending a dogfight is only a misdemeanor, carrying penalties of a small fine and no jail time. With passage of the Animal Fighting Spectator Prohibition Act, included in the 2014 Farm Bill, it is now a federal misdemeanor to knowingly attend a fight as a spectator and a federal felony to bring a minor under the age of 16 to a dogfight or cockfight.

using their facilities. This brings the issue back to Pay-Pal. According to its CEO Dan Schulman, "Becoming an employer in North Carolina where members of our teams will not have equal rights under the law is simply untenable."

One feels his chest inflate with righteous indignation just reading this stentorian affirmation, right?

Maybe not so much in light of Schulman's recent trip to Cuba with President Obama. As reported in *Fortune* Magazine, Schulman said, "PayPal will start allowing money transfers to and from Cuba later this year ... the opportunity for expansion is huge in Cuba where \$2 billion in cash is sent from the U.S. to Cuba annually."

Well, well. Apparently, Mr. Schulman's moral unction knows national boundaries. Schulman consider the following from the readily available 2015 Annual Report of the U.S. Commission on International Religious Freedom:

Serious religious freedom violations continue in Cuba despite improvements for government-approved groups. religious government continues to detain and harass religious leaders and laity, interfere in religious groups' internal affairs, and prevent democracy and human rights activists from participating in religious activities. Despite constitutional protections for religious freedom, Cuban government actively limits, controls, and monitors religious practice through restrictive a of laws system and policies and governmentauthorized surveillance and harassment.

Additionally, regardless religious affiliation, political repression is part of the Cuban government's stock-in-trade continued unabated during the President's trip to the island nation last month. USA Today reported, "Just hours before President Obama landed Sunday in Cuba for his historic visit to the communist island, Cuban authorities arrested more than 50 dissidents wno were marcning demand improved human rights." The dissidents were part of the Ladies in White group which began after the government Communist arrested, tried, sentenced scores of male journalists and others for demanding greater freedom in the early 2000s. Voice

According to of the Martyrs (VOM): While President Obama was watching baseball (in Cuba), Pastor Mario Felix Lleonart Barroso was sitting in a police station. Barroso, a Baptist pastor, blogger and friend of VOM, was thrown to the ground, handcuffed and detained



year after picking up her first tennis racket in 1941, Gibson was winning local tournaments. She would become the first black player at what is now the U.S. Open and at Wimbledon. Gibson became the first black champion at Wimbledon in 1957 and was the first champion to receive the trophy personally from Queen Elizabeth II. Gibson was also the first black woman to appear on the covers of Sports Illustrated and *Time*.





Termites!

The word can strike fear in the heart of any homeowner (or Realtor!). Our region, the southeastern U.S., is especially prone to subterranean termites. I sat down with my buddy Jeff Henry of Guaranteed Pest Control to find out what we should all know about these pests.

First of all, termites do in fact swarm. The swarmers are the reproductive members of the colony, and they come out in spring. Their activity is usually how people find out they have a termite problem. Interestingly, the swarmers do not actually do damage. They swarm, drop their wings, burrow in the ground (if outdoors) and start new colonies. The actual damage is done by worker termites, and they are protected by soldier termites. All of these little bugs can cost you a lot of money if they decide to make themselves at home in your house. The subterranean termites that live in our area do not create sawdust. In fact, if you are in your crawlspace and see pin-sized holes in the floor joists or subfloor, those are the work of powder post beetles. Those insects are second to termites in cost of damage done by insects to homes in our

The good news is, state law mandates that every new home built in Alabama must be pretreated for termites. This pre-treatment is good for three to five years, or however long the carrier of the bond guarantees. From then on, the bond simply has to be renewed on time. You can also choose to add a termite bond to an existing home at any time, and the cost of a bond is usually far less than repairing

The bad news is, termite damage is not covered by homeowner's insurance. If you're not covered and an active termite colony is found in your home, you not only have to repair the damage done, but also pay for treating the home and securing a bond. It is also important to remember that any time a slab is being poured within about 12 feet of your house, the form boards must be removed when the concrete is dry. If they are simply covered with dirt, that is an open invitation to termites.

It is spring in Alabama---for a few days, anyway. If you don't have termite protection, look into it. You may be surprised how inexpensive peace of mind can be. - mr



(I Corinthians 6:11) May God help us to love each other enough to teach the truth about homosexuality, and lead those caught up in this evil practice to the fullness of a pure life in the grace of Jesus Christ.
