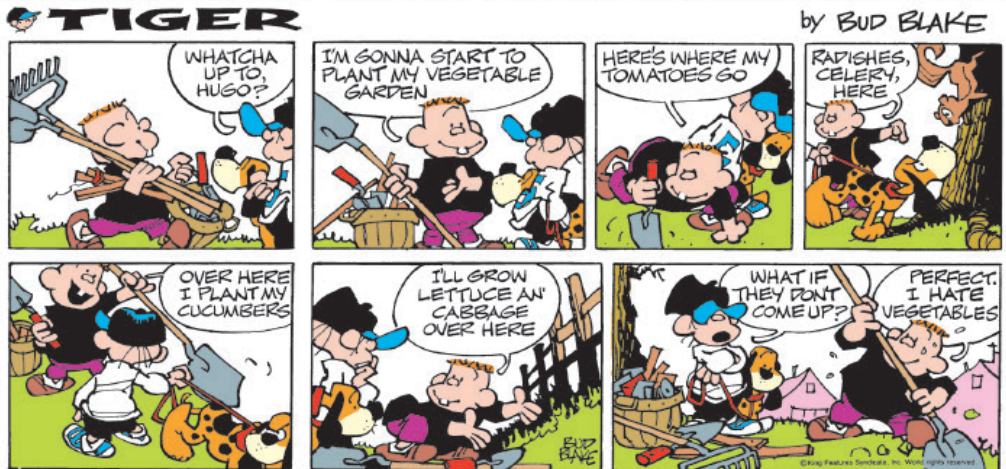
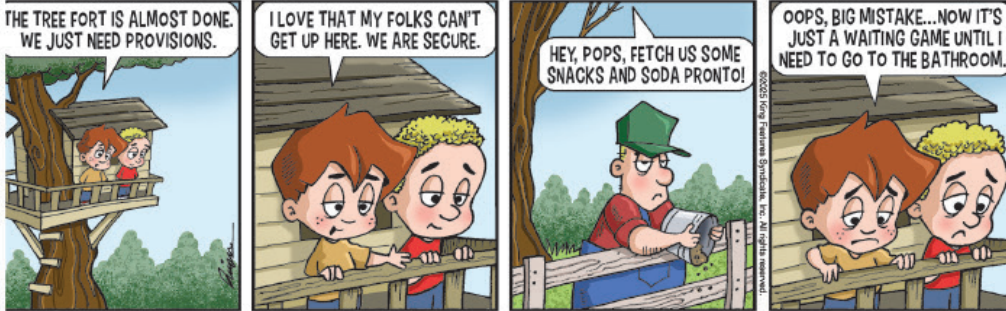

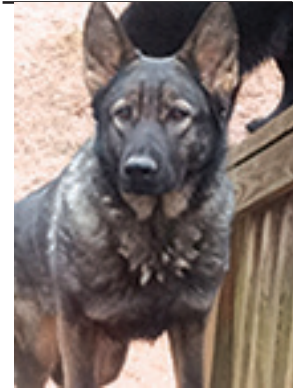

Our annual plea:

Each year animal shelters receive rabbits and ducks that had been given as surprises in Easter baskets. However, we once again emphasize, as we do every year, that live ducks, chicks, and rabbits are not the appropriate gifts to give children.

Young children oftentimes do not understand how fragile these little creatures are. In an attempt to play or give affection, children can injure or kill the delicate babies. Also, many of these animals may carry parasites. Salmonella is a real danger to children, and can be transmitted from chicken or ducks to humans.

Baby animals are often acquired on impulse at Easter, without consideration of a lifelong commitment. Rabbits, chickens, and ducks have an average lifespan of 8-10 years. The longest recorded lifespan of a chicken was 34 years!

These animals have specific physical and behavioral needs that a caring, responsible owner would want to fulfill. A special diet and a carefully controlled environment are necessary for the well-being of the Easter pet.

Pet bunnies especially are being bred in increasing numbers by "rabbit mills" and breeders for the lucrative pet industry. They

are marketed as easy, low-maintenance pets who will sit quietly on a child's lap, when in reality they are complex animals with unique traits and needs. The novelty of the cute bunnies, chicks, and ducklings wears off and animal shelters and humane organizations begin receiving these unwanted Easter surprises when people determine they are not willing to take on the responsibility of a full-grown pet. Worse, many of these animals are merely dumped in the woods and parks where they are easy prey for other animals and cruel people.

We urge everyone to help make Easter a humane holiday by buying only toy or candy animals! (And if you decide to buy one anyway, please remember that we are an open-admission shelter and will never decline to accept an animal!)

## Delftware

Talk about May flowers! The bright colors of the tulips on this charger could rival the real ones growing outside. And to think they're over 300 years old!

The charger was made in England in about 1690. Even with a few signs of wear, its age, craftsmanship and design brought its price to an impressive \$3,997 at Brunk Auctions. It is a type of tin-glazed earthenware pottery called delft or delftware.

The name "delft" may conjure up images of blue-and-white Dutch scenes, and it comes from a city in Holland that produced that type of pottery. Dutch immigrants brought the technique to England in the late 16th century, and London became a center for making delftware. Designs were often inspired by Chinese porcelain, and, although blue-and-white delftware was popular, potters experimented with different colors.

This charger uses yellow, green and ochre as well as blue. Multicolor designs are often called "polychrome." Delftware lost popularity in the 18th century as Europeans began making their own porcelain, but, in the 1800s, ceramics decorated with designs inspired by old delft became popular again in Holland, especially with tourists. They are still popular gifts and souvenirs, although they are often imported. Watch out for pieces labeled "Delft"; they were made in the 20th or 21st century.

**Q:** I have a print that has been in my family for at least 100 years. I have no idea if it is worth anything or just sentimental. I've researched the artist and found some information. Do you know how I can tell if this is an original or a print?

**A:** Check your print for an artist's signature and edition number that are written in pencil, not printed on. Sometimes it takes an art expert to determine if a print is original. You may want to contact an art museum in your area or the art department of

**TIP:** Modern bleach can damage 18th-century and some 19th-century dishes. To clean old dishes, try hydrogen peroxide or bicarbonate of soda. Each removes a different type of stain.

During this episode, oldest son Malcolm will move from the south of Los Angeles to Venice Beach, California, which is the setting of the proposed spin-off.

If the pilot gets picked up by the network as it's expected to be, both Shaun McKinney and Marcel Spears will reprise their roles as Malcolm and Marty Butler. Cedric the Entertainer, who plays their dad, will continue on "The Neighborhood" for its last season. Rounding out the cast are Angelique Cabral and Hunter King from "Life in Pieces," Justin Long ("Goosebumps"), and Kara Royster ("Dynasty").

However, this isn't the only "Neighborhood" offshoot in development. You might remember Tracy Morgan's ("30 Rock") appearance as Cedric's rich younger brother, Calvin, in season four. Well, he won't be playing Calvin in the proposed spin-off that is expected to stream on Paramount+ but instead a cousin named Crutch. No official word on when this series will begin airing.

My family likes to add these kicky pepper rounds to just about anything, whether they top nachos, fish or beef tacos, enchiladas, and tortillas — or they're tucked in a bun with a brat when we gather with friends for a picnic at the baseball park.

Instead of spooning a jar of commercially processed, store-bought jalapeno sliced peppers into or on top of your dishes, make these fresh and yummy pickled jalapeno peppers in minutes in your kitchen with your preteen. Discover the big difference in texture and flavor. Toss the easy-to-prepare peppery-to-eat crunch on your favorite South of the Border recipe and say, "Ole!"

EASY PICKLED JALAPENO PEPPERS

Makes about 2 pints  
— 1 cup white vinegar  
— 1 cup water

- 4 tablespoons sugar, or more to taste (adding more sugar turns down the heat)
  - 2 cloves garlic, sliced in half
  - 1 tablespoon salt
  - 7 fresh jalapeno peppers (from the produce area of your market), thinly sliced
  - 2 fresh red or yellow mini sweet peppers, thinly sliced
  - 2 pint-sized glass jars
- Stir together the vinegar, water, sugar, garlic and salt in a cooking pot, and bring to a boil. Add sliced jalapeno and sweet peppers, stir, turn off heat, and let sit for 10 minutes.
- Remove peppers with a slotted spoon to jars, then fill to the top with remaining liquid. Cool. Keep refrigerated and serve with favorite dishes for up to one month.



**Cook's Note:** The oils in fresh jalapeno peppers can irritate your skin and can be painful if you touch your eyes. You may wish to wear deli or rubber gloves when slicing the peppers. Wash your hands well with soap and water afterward.

Now here's a tip!

\* Yard sale, tag sale, garage sale ... whatever you call it, if you do it right, you can walk away with a decluttered home and a nifty bit of cash, too. Here's my tip: Advertise, advertise, advertise -- on local message boards and websites, as well as using signs. The more people you drive to your sale, the more you are likely to sell.

\* "When you put jewelry out at a garage sale, you can display it for better results. Use a window screen for paired earrings, or maybe a tie rack for necklaces. I sell a lot of costume stuff in my sales. Kids especially like it." -- R.G. in Mississippi

\* One way to organize a tag sale is to group items in bins by price. Or have a dollar table. If you have lots of clothes, you might price it by the piece and have good price breaks for people who buy lots of pieces.

\* "Put well-marked sports equipment in a place that can be viewed by passersby. Make attractive displays of toys and tools as well. People are always looking for these." -- M.H. in Alabama

\* Not sure how to price your items for resale? The rule for yard sales is as follows: For items that are new, still with tags or in original, unopened packaging, price it as 50% off retail. For items that are in good working condition, with all parts and accessories, mark it 30% of what you paid. Other items should be marked down to 20% of what you paid. Be honest with yourself. If something is just usable, but not really worth a buck, put it in a "free" bin. Your customers will be grateful, and you might make an additional sale.

\* Be sure to have plastic bags on hand. Boxes and newspaper are handy if you are selling any dishes or glassware, too.

Don't be impressed by money, followers, degrees and titles. Be impressed by kindness, integrity, humility and generosity.

# THE BEST CARROT CAKE FOR EASTER

## INGREDIENTS

2 cups all-purpose flour  
2 tsp. baking soda  
1/2 tsp. table salt  
2 tsp. ground cinnamon  
3 large eggs  
2 cups granulated sugar  
3/4 cup vegetable oil  
3/4 cup buttermilk  
2 tsp. vanilla extract  
2 cups grated carrot  
1 (8-oz.) can crushed pineapple, drained  
3 1/2 oz. flaked coconut  
1 cup chopped pecans or walnuts

## DIRECTIONS

Line pans:  
Preheat oven to 350°F. Line 3 (9-inch) round cake pans with parchment paper; lightly grease and flour parchment paper. Set pans aside.

Combine dry ingredients:  
Stir together first 4 ingredients—flour, baking soda, salt, and cinnamon.

Make batter:  
Beat eggs and next 4 ingredients at medium speed with an electric mixer until smooth. Add flour mixture, beating at low speed until blended. Fold in carrot and next 3 ingredients.

Pour batter into prepared cake pans.

Bake, glaze, and frost:  
Bake at 350°F for 25 to 30 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean.

Drizzle Buttermilk Glaze evenly over layers; cool in pans on wire racks 15 minutes.

Remove from pans, and cool completely on wire racks.

Spread Cream Cheese Frosting between layers and on top and sides of cake.

## Buttermilk Glaze

Yield: 11/2 cups

Ingredients

1 cup sugar  
1 1/2 teaspoons baking soda  
1/2 cup buttermilk  
1/2 cup butter or margarine  
1 tablespoon light corn syrup  
1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Directions

Bring first 5 ingredients to a boil in a large Dutch oven over medium-high heat. Boil, stirring often, 4 minutes. Remove from heat, and stir in vanilla.
