For a little more than half of the 1980s, I lived in Utah. I was a secretary at BYU for a few years, moved back to Danville, then returned to Utah and worked in a bank. Danville's call, though, brought me back in 1989. When my niece, Jenny, graduated from high school and was accepted at BYU in 1993, I was the natural choice to fly to Utah with her and help her learn her way around.

My Utah friends and I went to a favorite park and had a cookout. While there, we all noticed a dog on a chain. He had a broken down doghouse, but it was his body language that haunted me. He was lonely. He had completely worn a circle in the ground. His entire life consisted of that small little radius of chain, dirt, and loneliness.

My friends all commented, "Someone should do something." Have you ever heard yourself or someone else say that? Who is the "someone" who needs to do "something?"

What should you do if you see an animal that you believe is being neglected? The answer always is – call the authorities. Maybe nothing can be done, if the legal minimum standards of care are being done. However, perhaps

your phone call is the one hope for help that animal has. In Danville, if the animal control officer is off-duty, regular police officers investigate the complaints of neglect or pick up strays and injured animals. Call 799-5111, and press 8 to reach the animal control dispatcher. Pittsylvania County provides emergency services. Call 432-7937 to file a complaint or to report an animal in need. In my mind's eye, I can still see that hopeless dog. He has been dead for many years now, but I hope that the phone call I made when I returned to Virginia two days after the picnic brought him some relief.

Maybe you can be the "someone" who does a life-saving or life-altering "something" for the animals.



Wearable Art

A charm bracelet can be a thoughtful gift for Mother's Day. Historically, they have been linked to motherhood and family. Queen Victoria, who made family and domesticity an important part of her image, wore a bracelet with lockets that held miniature pictures of her family. She would also give charms as gifts.

Railroad china, however, is usually worth more. A Theodore Haviland plate made for the Canadian National Railways sold at a recent auction for \$50. Railroad memorabilia can sell for

high prices. Items like tableware and silverware, which were also sold at gift shops, are associated with dining cars and luxury travel, making them especially desirable. To learn more about your plate, the Canadian National Railways Historical Association (cnrha.ca) has more information on the history of the Canadian National Railways.

Tilapia That Wasn't Stored Properly Causes Scombroid Poisoning

DEAR DR. ROACH: I ate some tilapia last night, and within an hour, I had nausea and a headache, then vomiting a few hours later, and now diarrhea. What do you think is going on? — V.P.

ANSWER: I would be interested if you felt any sensation of warmth on your face or neck or any flushing, as your symptoms are highly suggestive of a foodborne illness called scombroid poisoning. It most commonly happens after eating tuna, mackerel or bonito but can come on after eating other fish as well, including tilapia. The fact that it began so soon after eating a compatible fish is suggestive of the diagnosis.

Scombroid is the most common foodborne illness from seafood. Scombroid happens if the fish is not stored at a coldenough temperature (at any time) after being caught. This is why you should refrigerate cans of tuna after opening them.

In addition to the flushing sensation, headaches, nausea, and vomiting, people with a scombroid toxicity can get rashes on their face, neck and upper chest. Sometimes they get burning or itching around their mouth.

If the symptoms aren't gone before the condition is suspected, then an antihistamine tablet, such as diphenhydramine (Benadryl), can help relieve symptoms. If there are stomach or intestinal troubles, a different type of antihistamine, such as famotidine (Pepcid), can have an added benefit.

If the vomiting and diarrhea are severe, intravenous fluids may be necessary, dickersonmike21@yahoo.com

although my experience is that most cases are milder than this.

Physicians who make the presumptive diagnosis of scombroid poisoning should contact their local public health authorities to identify where the contamination occurred and help prevent other cases. Scombroid poisoning is vastly underreported.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I was recently in the hospital for a hip fracture and was discharged with oxycodone. I've been taking it for about two weeks after stopping morphine in the hospital (the dosage being 2.5 mg twice daily), but I am worried about withdrawal. I know two people who got very ill after suddenly stopping pain medication. — J.S.B.

ANSWER: Withdrawal from opiates happens when people who are physiologically dependent on opioids suddenly stop taking them. A person can become physiologically dependent in as little as three weeks, or even shorter if they had been taking opioids in the past. Opioid withdrawal is very unpleasant, with abdominal symptoms (nausea, cramps, diarrhea, vomiting, etc.) and agitation being the most common symptoms.

The main way of avoiding withdrawal is to avoid staying on opioids too long. Changing from a long-acting opiate like oxycodone to a shorter-acting one may help. Using non-opioid pain relievers to minimize the need for opioids can also help. I have sometimes tapered down the dose slowly to try to prevent withdrawal; however, the dose you are on is already quite low, so the likelihood of withdrawal is small.

I do want to emphasize that it's important to get off these drugs. Recent studies have shown that 25% or more of people who start chronically taking opioids after a hip fracture continue to take them for months or years, but opioids are not good long-term pain medications for most people.





Q: What is Josh Holloway from "Lost" doing these days? I haven't seen him in anything since the show ended. -D.I.

• While Sawyer on "Lost" is probably Josh Holloway's most memorable role, he's far from retired. CBS had high hopes that "Intelligence," his first series after "Lost" ended, would be a surefire fit, but it was canceled after one season. He followed it with the sci-fi drama "Colony" on the USA Network, which was a modest hit with three seasons' worth of episodes. I ran to catch up with it and, as I boarded, asked the driver, "Didn't you see me?"



Fresh Strawberry Sauce (Strawberry Topping)

This fresh Strawberry Topping or Sauce is quick and easy to make and tastes delicious as a topping for cheesecake or pound cake; or as a sauce with ice cream or whipped cream.



INGREDIENTS

1 pound fresh strawberries rinsed, hulled and halved or guartered

1/3 cup granulated sugar

1 tablespoon lemon juice

1 teaspoon cornstarch or more to taste; see notes below!

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

INSTRUCTIONS

Combine strawberries and sugar in a medium pot or saucepan.

Whisk together lemon juice, vanilla extract and cornstarch in a small bowl until fully smooth/no lumps remain. Pour over strawberries and stir well. Bring to a boil once over medium-high heat, then reduce to medium heat and simmer sauce until berries are soft and juices have thickened slightly, about 5 minutes for a chunky topping (see notes below for other consistencies).

Use warm, at room temperature or chilled.



Strawberries: You can make this with frozen strawberries. You don't need to defrost them, but the sauce will take a little longer to cook and they tend to break up more. Feel free to substitute other berries – the sauce works great with blueberries, blackberries or cherries. Raspberries tend to completely break up and form more of a jam.

Cornstarch: Feel free to double or triple the cornstarch for a more jammy, thick sauce (the recipe as-is yields chunks of soft strawberry in syrup-y sauce). Lemon juice: The lemon aids with the thickening of the sauce. If you use bottled or skip the lemon juice, you may need to add a little more cornstarch to get the same consistency.

Recipe tips

You can cut the strawberries as small or as chunky as you'd like. I prefer a chunky strawberry sauce, especially for cheesecake toppings or for things like extra-special strawberry shortcake and the like. The sauce thickens a little as it chills. If it is too thick when you want to use it, microwave it for 10-15 seconds.

This yields soft, juicy strawberries in a sirup-y sauce. For a thicker sauce, double or even triple the cornstarch. Sauce consistency

I like a chunky strawberry topping with lots of juicy syrup. But in some instances, it can be more useful to have more of a sauce consistency, or smaller chunks. Here are some ways you can vary the consistency: Cut the strawberries in large chunks (halve or quarter)

and only stir carefully during simmering to leave the berry chunks whole for a very chunky topping, perfect for cheesecake

Dice the strawberries in medium chunks, and/or break up some of the berries as the sauce simmers for a more small chunk, jamm-y topping

For a smoother sauce, please do not blend – it turns out too liquid-y. Instead, break up/mash all of the berries with a wooden spoon after simmering the sauce for about 5 minutes. Simmer for 5-10 more minutes, stirring often, until thickened to your preferred consistenсу.

Storage tips

Fridge: Cool the sauce to room temperature, then store in an airtight container in the fridge for up to 3 days. Microwave for 10-15 seconds to warm the sauce and to make it thinner again if it is too thick. Freezer: Cool the sauce to room temperature, then place in a labelled freezer bag or freezer container. Freeze for up to 4 months. Defrost in the fridge overnight.
