A RANCH HOME BECOMES A FAMILY MUSEUM



Tumbleweed Smith

Laurie Churchwell's parents died last year and were buried on the family ranch east of Big Spring. Laurie wanted to preserve their memory so she and other members of her family started turning her parents' ranch house into a museum and art gallery. Laurie's mother, Joyce Choate, was an established artist.

Tumbleweed Smith "I started gathering up paintings my mother had given to nieces and nephews and others and photographed them. I have a very large painting of hers hanging on a wall. There is a QR code in the corner of it and if you hold your phone camera up to the QR code over 100 of her paintings will show up on your phone screen."

Laurie's dad, Carroll Choate, was a great story teller and Laurie recorded some of his stories. "As you can imagine I have a lot of stories with photographs of him doing various things in various places. I decided to pull it all together and put a QR code on each photo. All you have to do is go to a photo with your phone, point it at the QR code and there's my dad on video telling the story of each photo."

Laurie started taping her dad when she saw other people laughing at his stories and enjoying being around him. "I just got a little cassette recorder, put it in his pickup and boy did he ever take hold of that. He'd be driving along in his pickup and when he remembered something he'd start the cassette recorder and start telling a story. I also videotaped him."

Her dad's lariat, saddle, hats and other family artifacts are on display throughout the home. There are shelves full of photos and recordings. Her parents loved to dance and Laurie often plays their favorite tunes at the ranch.

"I feel like I have a real special family and want to preserve their memory and honor their legacy. This ranch house is a way we can do that. This ranch will be here forever and more memorabilia can always be added."

The Choate family has been recognized as one of 100 families who owned land when Texas became a state.

"We are a first family of Texas by two ancestors. I managed to get photos of some of them. Then I created the ancestor wall and had their closest living relative tell the story of their grandfather or grandmother so we can hear about our ancestors. It's awesome because when we have the younger ones in the family that kind of glaze over when it comes time to hear family stories, they've all got cell phones and it's a game to them. They'll go over to a photo with a QR code and they think it's real cool."

Laurie and Tommy love to go to the ranch and sit outside on the deck in the early evenings.

"You can see Moss Creek Lake, Signal Peak, Saddleback and Twin Sisters mountains. Sometimes we get to hear coyotes sing to us."


