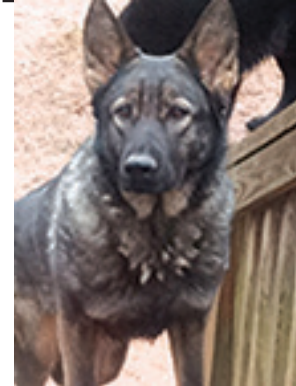

Piedmont Pets

In late summer of 2005, Annette Nolen-Ferguson found a litter of orphaned, unweaned kittens in this area. She took them into her home and lovingly bottle fed them and provided them 24 hours a day care. When they were about seven weeks old, she found all of them homes. People who knew Annette were not surprised by this, because she had loved animals her whole life. Annette and her family had no way of knowing that shortly after that, on October 25, 2005, Annette would pass away suddenly, leaving a grief-stricken family.

In 2018, her parents, George and Judy Nolen, decided that they wanted their daughter's life to be remembered and memorialized, and they chose to do that by establishing the Annette Nolen Ferguson Foster Fund with the Danville Area Humane Society.

As many orphaned, unweaned kittens and puppies come into our open-admission shelter every year (sometimes in the hundreds), the need is great for people to be willing to provide the care in their homes. As a natural consequence of this, they become adoption ambassadors for their foster animals and help find homes with friends and family members, using our regular adoption process. That is a winning situation for the animals, the foster homes, and us!

Sometimes, an animal that requires special care outside of a shelter environment is in need of a

foster home for a short period of time. The reasons for needing a foster home vary.

This fund allows us to provide the food and to pay for the veterinary treatment.

The process for being approved to be a foster home is the same for being approved for an adoption. It is not a long process and it helps us ensure the future safety and well-being of shelter animals. Just stop by the shelter during our regular business hours (12-5:30 Monday-Friday and 12-3:30 on Saturday) and fill out a questionnaire to begin the process.

American Glassware

With the invention of the mechanical glass press in the 1800s, the glassmaking industry moved away from free-blown, hand-decorated pieces and embraced new ways to mass-produce inexpensive decorative glass. But not everyone wanted to leave the old ways behind.

Brothers Henry Thomas, Lorenzo, and William Elbert Clevenger were apprentices at the Moore Brothers Clayton Glass Works, where their father, William Henry, also worked. The Clayton Glass Works closed in 1912. In 1930, the Clevenger brothers constructed their own glass furnace in their backyard in Clayton, New Jersey. They used their training to make glass in the old-fashioned South Jersey style developed in the colonial years: free-blown vessels decorated with blobs or threads of glass applied by hand. They soon started making mold-blown glass, including reproductions of famous antique bottles like the Fisler-ville Jenny Lind calabash flask and the figural E.G. Booz whiskey bottle.

A Clevenger Brothers vase sold for \$192 at an auction by Jeffrey S. Evans. It was free-blown, with a rough pontil mark as evidence. Its two handles, decorative glass blobs called lily pads, and the threading around its neck were applied by hand. The vase's medium blue color is also faithful to the earlier glass traditions. It is still recognizable as a 20th-century piece; for one thing, Clevenger Brothers glass is usually heavier than pieces made in the 1700s and 1800s. The brothers' intent was not to create forgeries of valuable antique glassware but to continue the traditions of their glassmaking forebears.

Q:I have a set with a perfume bottle, compact and lipstick tube made of pearl. They are in a case that reads "Le Kid Paris" inside. What is its value?

A:"Le Kid" was created by the Marcel Franck perfume company in Paris in 1926. It was the first purse-sized perfume atomizer. Individ-

ual Le Kid perfume bottles are worth about \$50 to \$120. Many dealers who sell jewelry also deal in items like perfume bottles and compacts. There are also collectors who specialize in perfume bottles, like the International Perfume Bottle Association (IPBA).

TIP: Never put silverware and stainless-steel flatware in the dishwasher basket together. The stainless can damage the silver.

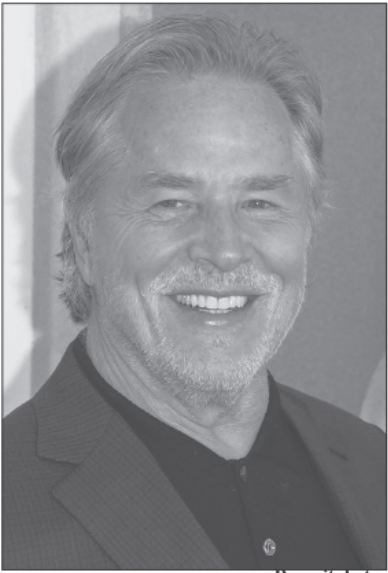
HOLLYWOOD

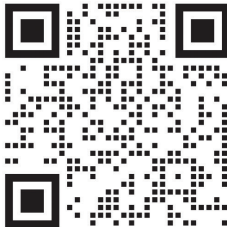

Not Everyone Who Has Artery Blockages Requires Surgery

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have HIV and pulmonary hypertension. I was part of a research study, and a scan found blockages of about 50% in my carotid arteries. I've never had any symptoms or a stroke. Do I need to have surgery? — *V.P.*

ANSWER: In general, screening for blockages in the carotid arteries that provide blood flow to the brain is not recommended, but occasionally, I do see people who get the diagnosis made as part of a study or as a result of a diagnostic test that was performed for some other reason. Screening means that there are no present symptoms, and the management of asymptomatic blockages is different from symptomatic ones.

Not everybody with blockages needs surgical intervention. Guidelines recommend against surgery in people with no symptoms who have less than 70% stenosis. Only when the blockage is greater than 70% is surgery considered.

Medical treatment is effective at reducing the risk of a stroke and includes a high dose of a potent statin agent, aspirin, the careful control of high blood pressure and diabetes (if appropriate), quitting smoking, a healthy diet (such as Mediterranean-style), regular exercise, and weight reduction in some people.

HIV itself increases the risk of stroke by about 40% compared to people without HIV, so it is appropriate to be more aggressive at reducing risk factors. This is similar to what we see in people with chronic inflammatory diseases like rheumatoid arthritis, who have a higher heart disease and stroke risk than what

would be expected based on their other risk factors.

Your HIV provider may wish to consult an expert in cardiovascular disease prevention to help you reduce your stroke risk, although many HIV experts are also skilled primary care doctors themselves. Keeping HIV under control (ideally with no detectable virus) may help reduce inflammation and consequently bring down the additional risk of heart attack and stroke associated with HIV.

DEAR DR. ROACH: My spouse is frustrated by a nagging case of plantar fasciitis. It's been continuing for five or six months now. No amount of stretching, icing or resting seems to help. They are considering using a plantar fasciitis sock device that holds the foot in a specific position to provide relief. I am wondering if you could provide any other suggestions on how to reduce or eliminate this problem. — *M.R.*

ANSWER: Plantar fasciitis is among the most common causes of foot pain, with nearly 1% of people complaining of plantar fasciitis pain during the previous month. Inflammation and pain most commonly occur at the bottom of the foot, just in front of the heel. The pain is often worst during the first step in the morning.

Rest and cushioned shoes or heel pads are helpful for most people. I am cautious about recommending stretching, especially when the pain is severe, as overdoing stretching can make things worse. Still, most people find stretching to be of benefit.

When symptoms do not get resolved with conservative management, I refer patients to a podiatrist. Some people just take a long time to heal, but 80% are better within a year. When conservative measures have failed to bring relief, your spouse's podiatrist might consider an injection of a steroid.

Dry rub the chicken: In a small bowl, combine ingredients for the dry rub. Rub the mixture generously onto each piece of chicken. Allow the dry


