Dear Tony, my interactions with co-workers have taken a turn for the worse and it seems like we collaborate less, are more stressed than ever, and no one is motivated. I'm impacted negatively every day and its wearing on me. What can I do to change things for myself, and maybe for others I work with?

Our brains are wired to respond to social interactions in ways that either draw us closer to others or push us away. David Rock, founder of the NeuroLeadership Institute, captures this dynamic in his SCARF Model-a framework that identifies five key domains influencing human behavior in social settings: Status, Certainty, Autonomy, Relatedness, and Fairness. By understanding these elements, we can foster more collaborative and welcoming environments, whether at work or in our personal lives, and take steps today to improve our lives immediately.

At the heart of the SCARF Model lie two fundamental principles about how our brains operate in social contexts. First, a physical threat—being chased by a lion, for instance—triggers the same fear response as a social threat, like public criticism. Our brains struggle to distinguish between the two, reacting to social slights as if they were matters of survival. A colleague's harsh feedback or a dismissive gesture can feel as visceral as a physical blow, causing us to withdraw or lash out. Studies show that social pain, like the sting of rejection, activates the same neural pathways as physical pain, with emotional distress lingering far longer—sometimes twice as long as a physical injury.

The second principle centers on our response to social environments. When we feel threatened, our brain shifts into a defensive "away" mode, prompting us to retreat or resist. Conversely, a welcoming environment—one where we feel valued and safe—ushers us into a "toward" mode, encouraging collaboration and openness. This dichotomy shapes how we interact with others, whether in a meeting, a family gathering, or a casual conversation.

Understanding what triggers these responses is key to fostering connection over conflict.

So, how do we navigate these social dynamics? David Rock's SCARF Model offers a roadmap by breaking down the five domains that influence our behavior in social settings. Originally developed to enhance workplace collaboration, the model applies just as powerfully to personal relationships. Each element reflects a core human need, and when these needs are met, we thrive. When they're threatened, we falter.

Status: This reflects our sense of relative importance or social standing compared to others. A perceived slight—like being overlooked for a promotion—can bruise our ego and trigger defensiveness.

**Certainty:** Our brains crave clarity and predictability about the future. Uncertainty, such as not knowing where a project is headed, can spark anxiety and hinder focus.

**Autonomy:** We yearn for control over our actions and decisions. Feeling micromanaged or powerless can lead to frustration, while autonomy fosters confidence and engagement.

**Relatedness:** This is our need to feel connected and belong to a group. Without a sense of camaraderie—whether with colleagues or friends—we feel isolated and disconnected.

**Fairness:** We are deeply attuned to equitable treatment. Perceived unfairness, like unequal workloads in a team, can breed resentment, while fairness cultivates trust.

Together, these elements form a lens through which we can view our interactions. When any of these domains are threatened, we may feel attacked or diminished, even if the threat is subtle. On the flip side, nurturing these domains creates an environment where people feel valued and motivated to contribute.

The SCARF Model isn't just a theoretical framework—it's a practical tool for improving how we engage with others. By reflecting on each domain, we can identify areas where we might inadvertently trigger threats and instead foster a "toward" response. Here are five questions, one for each element, to guide your self-reflection:

- Status: Am I rewarding and recognizing those around me enough? Do I have a healthy self-image of my own status in the world, whether among co-workers or in my personal life?
- Certainty: Do I provide clear expectations and updates to others? Am I seeking enough clarity for myself to feel secure?
- Autonomy: Am I empowering others to make decisions, and do I feel in control of my own choices?
- Relatedness: How can I build stronger connections with those around me to create a sense of belonging?

• Fairness: Am I treating others equitably, and do I feel fairly treated in my interactions?

By asking these questions, we can better understand our own needs and those of others, paving the way for more meaningful and productive relationships. The SCARF Model reminds us that social interactions are not just about words or actions—they're about the deeper human needs that drive us. When we honor these needs, we start to create environments where stress goes down, motivation & collaboration goes up, and everyone can thrive.

# **Keynote Speaker Chris Cournoyer Iowa's Lieutenant Governor**

Chris Gearhart Cournoyer was appointed as Iowa's 48th Lieutenant Governor in December 2024.

At the time of her appointment, she was serving as a State Senator representing Clinton, Jackson, and Scott counties.

First elected in 2018, she chaired the inaugural Technology committee, where she wrote and managed the legislation to make lowa the sixth state in the nation to protect data into law.

Lieutenant Governor Cournoyer announced formally last week she is running for State Auditor.

# Purdy Good Pros, Even Better Guys

As a die-hard Cyclone fan, it has been so much fun to watch all the recent success former Cyclones have had in the NFL and NBA. Many of us "old-timers" can remember the days when you used to hope for one or two guys to be role players on professional teams, and maybe you would catch a glimpse of them on national TV every now and then; my oh my how times have changed! This past week in particular, two former Cyclones who both entered Iowa State as freshmen in 2018 have dominated the professional headlines for very good reasons. Brock Purdy signed a five-year. \$256 million contract extension with the San Franciso 49ers on Tuesday, making him the seventh highest paid quarterback in the NFL. Purdy's deal includes \$181 million in guaranteed money, and will be a major increase from the \$850,000 he made in 2024. Just one day later, while sporting a Brock Purdy jersey on his way into Madison Square Garden for Game One of the Eastern Conference Finals, Tyrese Haliburton scored 31 points and dished out 11 assists to help the Pacers stun the Knicks in overtime, 138-135. Haliburton hit what looked to be the game-winning 3-pointer at the end of regulation, but had his foot on the line and instead forced overtime. Haliburton is an astonishing 12-14 (86%) on game-tying or game-winning shots this season, the true definition of clutch!

Purdy and Haliburton have certainly cemented themselves as outstanding professional athletes; Purdy has led the 49ers to a Super Bowl and NFC Championship game already in just three seasons, and Haliburton has won a Gold Medal for Team USA, has been a two-time NBA All-Star and has twice led the Pacers to the Eastern Conference Finals. What is more impressive about these two standout athletes is the kind of people they are, and how they have maintained their love for Iowa State. Both Purdy and Haliburton openly share their Christianity and credit their faith for much of their success. Purdy's faith has helped him stay grounded and is a major reason he is able to remain calm in so many pressure situations. Purdy defines himself as a Christian first and a football player second, and is an outstanding role model for young athletes. While Purdy was raised in faith and was open about it during his time at Iowa State, Haliburton was not raised going to church, but has recently turned to Christ. In a recent interview with GQ Sports, Haliburton said "over the last two years, my religion has become very important in my life," and said the one thing he can't live without is his Bible. Haliburton credits former teammates Harrison Barnes and Buddy Heild for helping bring him to pregame chapel and build his habit of going before every game. It is also very cool to see these two former Cyclones constantly celebrate their former teams and come back to Ames when they have a break in their schedule. Purdy came back for a game in the 2023 season, and this past year Haliburton came back with George Niang for the Arizona game in Hilton Coliseum. Tyler and I were at that game and it was so much fun watching Haliburton and Niang get into the game and celebrate the current Cyclones success.

In our society, and I'm as guilty as anyone, we often place our athletes on too high of a pedestal that they don't deserve and idolize them. It is so refreshing to see two young men who are having such success at the highest level and have recently signed combined contracts worth nearly \$500 million be so grounded and have their priorities straight. Both Purdy and Haliburton know that their athletic career can end with one bad injury and that nothing in life is guaranteed, but they both know that their relationship with Jesus Christ is forever, and that is worth more than any contract that they sign!

In a 2-cup liquid measuring cup, use a fork to beat together the heavy cream, eggs, lemon extract, and vanilla until combined. Chill until ready to use. In a large bowl, combine the flour, sugar, baking powder, and salt. Drop in the ice-cold butter and use a pastry cutter to cut the butter into the flour mixture until it

resembles coarse wet sand. Pour in the chilled cream mixture, ginger and lemon zest and use a rubber spatula to stir until just combined. Turn the dough onto a lightly floured work surface and knead it a few times before forming it into a ball. With floured fingers, flatten it out into a 1 42-inchthick round. Cut the round into 8 equal-sized wedges and transfer them to the prepared baking sheet. Bake for 15 to 18 minutes, rotating the baking sheet halfway through baking. Transfer the baked scones to a wire rack to cool. Once the scones have cooled, dust generously with powdered sugar before serving.



The mobile food pantry from the Food Bank of Iowa is returning again. The free distribution will take place from 4-6 p.m. Thursday, June 5, at the Good News Estherville Church. The food will be distributed inside the church. Recipients are asked

to bring bags, laundry baskets or boxes to carry the food. At the May Food Bank, 472 individuals (174 families) received 5,865 lbs. of food. The Food Bank of Iowa partners with 700 agencies in 55 counties to distribute 2.5 million pounds of food each month, so that no one goes hungry in Iowa.



12% of Iowans (1 in 8) and 16.6% of Iowa children (1 in 6) face food insecurity. That's according to Feeding America's annual Map the Meal Gap study that just came out on May 14, 2025. All 99 Iowa counties saw an increase in food insecurity in the latest report. In Iowa, 385,130 persons do not know where they will find their next meal. That includes 120,220 children. 





**Clay County Connection Awarded** 

**Okoboji Foundation Grant** On May 22, the Okoboji Foundation announced the award a Leadership Grant

of \$75,000 to support Phases I and II of the Clay County Connection, a 3.5-mile expansion of the Iowa Great Lakes

Spine Trail. To date, the Clay County Connection has received nearly \$1.8 million in grant funding through a variety of sources including the Okoboji Foundation, Iowa Economic Development Authority's Community Attraction and Tourism program, Federal Recreational Trails, State Recreational Trails, and the Iowa DNR REAP program. Additional contributions have come from Imagine Iowa Great Lakes and many generous supporters of the Dickinson County Trails system.

Construction on Phase I, a 1.5-mile section of the trail, is scheduled to begin in June and be completed by August. Phase II will follow later this fall, with the final connection to Clay County on track for completion in 2026. Once completed, this vital addition will enhance regional connectivity, linking three counties across two states and eight municipalities via a continuous 32-mile trail corridor. The DCTB applauds the overwhelming sup-

port and enthusiasm from donors and granting agencies that have made this project possible.

> Grant The DCTB received notification that the Region 3 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) has award-
