BLACKBERRY COBBLER

10 SERVINGS

Ingredients

- 3/4 cup sugar
- 2 cups plus 1 tablespoon self-rising flour
- 2 cups fresh blackberries
- 1/4 cup (1/2 stick) butter, cold, cut into small pieces, plus more for greasing
- 1/2 to 2/3 cup milk
- Vanilla ice cream, for serving



Directions

1. Preheat the oven to 450 degrees F. Butter a 1-quart casserole dish or baking pan.
2. In a medium saucepan combine the sugar, 1 tablespoon of the flour, berries and 1 cup water. Bring to a boil, reduce the heat, and simmer for 2 minutes, then remove from the heat and set aside.
3. In a medium bowl, use a pastry blender or two knives to cut the butter into the remaining 2 cups flour. Stir in just enough milk to make a soft dough that pulls away from the sides of the bowl. Turn the dough out on a lightly-floured board and pat into a square. Use a rolling pin to roll it to 1/2-inch thick. Cut the dough into 2-inch-wide strips.
4. Pour 1 cup of the blackberry mixture into the bottom of the pan. Arrange half of the dough strips on top of the blackberry mix, placing them close together. Bake until brown, about 12 minutes, then remove from the oven and pour the remaining berry mixture over the baked strips. Arrange another layer of dough strips on top and bake until brown, about 15 minutes. Serve warm with ice cream.

CHEDDAR BACON RANCH POTATO SALAD

6 SERVINGS

Ingredients

- 2 lbs petite red potatoes, diced into bite size chunks (about 1-inch)
- 2/3 cup Hidden Valley® Simply Ranch Dressing
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese (I used medium)
- 6 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled (about 1/2 cup)
- 1/3 cup chopped green onions
- Salt and pepper (optional)

Instructions

1. Cook potatoes in boiling water: Add potatoes to a pot. Add enough water to cover potatoes by about 2-inches. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat then reduce heat to medium and allow to boil until potatoes are fully tender, about 10 minutes.
2. Drain potatoes: Carefully pour potatoes into a colander to drain. Set aside to cool (to speed cool them run them under cold water until cool).
3. Toss potatoes with dressing, and mix-ins: Pour cooled potatoes into a large mixing bowl. Add in ranch, cheddar, bacon and green onions, toss to coat.
4. Season as desired: season with salt and pepper to taste. Serve or cover and chill up to 1 day (if you like the bacon crispy wait to add it until ready to serve).

SKILLET CORNBREAD WITH HONEY BUTTER

6-8 SERVINGS

Ingredients

For the Honey Butter

- 1/2 cup (1 stick) unsalted butter, at room temperature, plus more for pan
- 2 Tbsp. pure honey
- Kosher salt

For the Cornbread

- 1 cup fine cornmeal
- 1 cup all-purpose flour, spooned and leveled
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 Tbsp. baking powder
- 1 tsp. kosher salt
- 1 cup whole milk
- 2 large eggs
- 6 Tbsp. (3/4 stick) unsalted butter, melted

Directions

1. Make honey butter: Use a fork to smash and stir together butter, honey, and salt in a bowl until well combined. Cover and refrigerate at least 30 minutes.
2. Make cornbread: Preheat oven to 425°F. Grease a 10-inch cast-iron skillet or 8-inch square baking dish. Whisk together cornmeal, our, sugar, baking powder, and salt in a bowl. In a second bowl, whisk

together milk, eggs, and butter. Add wet ingredients to dry ingredients and stir just until combined. Transfer batter to prepared pan.

3. Bake until top is lightly golden and a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean, 15 to 17 minutes. Cool in pan 10 minutes. Serve warm with honey butter alongside

SOUTHERN STYLE SHRIMP AND GRITS 4 SERVINGS

Ingredients

- Grits
- 2 cups water
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt or 1/2 teaspoon table salt
- 1 cup white grits
- 2 tablespoons salted butter
- 1 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- Shrimp
- 4 bacon slices diced
- 1 pound raw shrimp peeled and deveined
- 2 tablespoons minced garlic
- 1/2 cup sliced green onion divided
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 dashes hot sauce to taste



Instructions

Grits

1. Bring 2 cups water and 2 cups chicken broth to a boil in a 3 to 4-quart saucepan over high heat. Season the liquid with 1 teaspoon kosher salt. Slowly add in 1 cup white grits while stirring constantly until the grits are evenly distributed in the liquid. Reduce the heat to low and simmer grits uncovered, stirring occasionally, for 30-35 minutes.
2. Once the grits are cooked, remove from heat and add in 2 tablespoons salted butter and 1 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese. Stir until fully melted. Taste and add additional salt, if desired.

Shrimp

1. When there are about 15 minutes left for the grits to cook, dice 4 bacon slices. Cook in a 12-inch skillet over medium heat until crispy, about 6-8 minutes. Remove bacon from the pan, and reserve about 2 tablespoons of bacon grease in the skillet.

2. Add 1 pound raw shrimp, 2 tablespoons minced garlic, and 1/2 cup sliced green onion half of the green onions to the bacon grease. Cook over medium heat until the shrimp just turns pink, about 5-6 minutes depending on the size of shrimp.
3. Drizzle with shrimp with 2 tablespoons lemon juice and 2 dashes hot sauce, or to your liking. Stir to ensure the shrimp are well coated.
4. Serve shrimp on top of the cheesy grits and sprinkle bacon and the other half of the green onions on top.

4 INGREDIENT CHICKEN ENCHILADA CASSEROLE 6 SERVINGS

Ingredients

- 1 pound chicken breasts boneless and skinless (about 2 large chicken breasts)
- 14 ounces Enchilada sauce
- 6 medium corn tortillas
- 3 cups Monterey Jack cheese shredded



Instructions

1. Cut each chicken breast in about 3 pieces, so that it cooks faster and put it in a small pot. Pour enchilada sauce over it and cook covered on low to medium heat until chicken is cooked through, about 20 minutes. No water is needed, the chicken will cook in the Enchilada sauce. Make sure you stir occasionally so that it doesn't stick to the bottom.
2. Remove chicken from the pot and shred with two forks.
3. Preheat oven to 375°F.
4. Start layering the casserole. Start with about 1/4 cup of the leftover enchilada sauce over the bottom of a 8x8-inch square baking dish. Place 2 tortillas on the bottom, cutting them in half if needed to fit. Top with 1/3 of the chicken and 1/3 from the remaining sauce. Sprinkle with 1/3 of the cheese and repeat starting with 2 more tortillas, then chicken, sauce, cheese. Repeat with last layer with the remaining ingredients, tortillas, chicken, sauce and cheese. You should end of with 3 layers of each ingredient.
5. Transfer the casserole dish to the preheated oven. Bake for 20 to 30 minutes uncovered, until bubbly and cheese has melted and started to brown on top.
6. Garnish with some chopped green onions or cilantro if preferred and serve warm.

Claybank Master Gardeners June 2025

Were you ever the proud owner of a tiny succulent plant only to have it die in a short time? Sadly, this gardener has killed more than one succulent, and I recently learned why. As a successful succulent plant parent, Autumn Drummond explained at the May Master Gardener meeting, that most people think succulents don't need much water, but surprisingly they DO need water.



They LOVE water, and those fat little leaves are designed to hold lots of water! But it is important to wait until the soil is dry down deep before thoroughly watering it. As a retired schoolteacher, Ms. Drummond kept us enthralled as she explained how each of her many beautiful and unusual demo plants grows and thrives.

Have you ever wondered what the difference is between Master Gardeners and a Garden Club? Master Gardeners are people who have taken the course on Horticulture through the Alabama Cooperative Extension System with Auburn University and become certified through participation in classes, labs, online training and

internship, and a final examination on the specific areas they have studied. All Master Gardeners have also volunteered for a minimum of 50 hours of work at a variety of sponsored venues.

Registration for the next class will begin on June 2nd. If you are interested in taking the Master Garden course call the Dale County Extension Office at (334) 774-2329.

The SOW app tells us that the following seeds can be planted now: basil, collards, corn, Mexican cucumbers, lima beans, tarragon, okra, oregano, pumpkins, rosemary, southern peas, and thyme. Also, as transplants: eggplant, and sweet potatoes.

Claybank Master Gardeners meet monthly at Hoppergrass Restaurant, on the 2nd Wednesday of the month, however, there will be no meeting in July. The next meeting will be August 13th, 2025 at 11AM. The buffet line for lunch is shorter if you come at 10:30. Please call the Extension Office at (334) 774-2329 to verify the time and place in case of unforeseen changes.

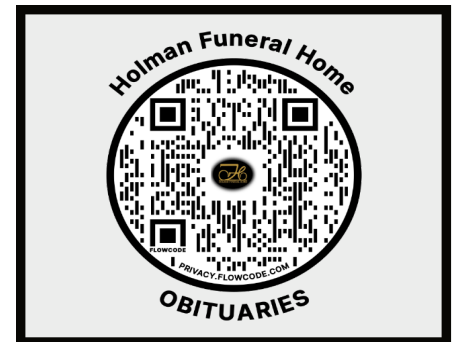
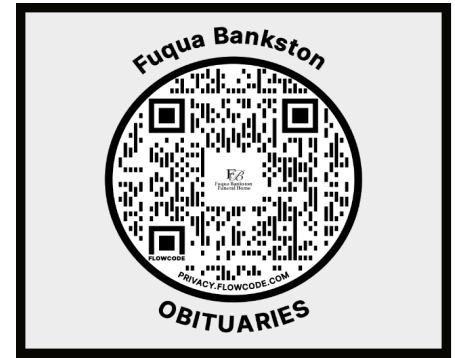

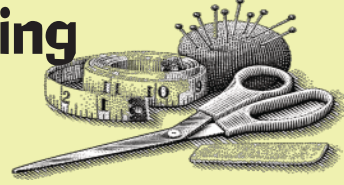
