





Fathers and Sons

Father's Day is a good time to remember that many design firms of the 19th and 20th centuries were family businesses. Some of the most famous glassmakers, ceramicists and metalsmiths followed their fathers into business, and many famous company names end in "and Sons."

This coin silver coffee pot, which sold for \$1,860 at an auction by Leland Little, was made by S. Kirk & Son of Baltimore, one of the best-known American silversmiths. Samuel Kirk opened his first silver store in 1815. He started partnering with his sons in 1846; the company was known as S. Kirk & Son from 1846 to 1861 and S. Kirk & Sons from 1861 to 1868. The firm was known for its coin silver.

Samuel Kirk introduced handhammered repousse designs to America. His decoration style, with allover designs like landscapes, flowers or architecture in low relief, is still known as Baltimore silver. After his death in 1872, his son and grandson continued the company. The name changed to S. Kirk & Son Co. in 1896. The company was bought by the Stieff Company in 1979, and Kirk Stieff, as it is now known, is still active today.

* * *

You may also want to find a specialist for the postcards and photos. If you are planning to sell the items, you may want to seek a professional appraisal. You can find a qualified appraiser through the





To his chagrin, she revealed how his tricks were done, which was hilarious. I ran into Ruth a lot during her "Rowan & Martin's Laugh-In" days and during my time as a Hollywood paparazzi. She was one of a kind!

Elordi will follow this up by starring opposite Margaret Qualley, Josh Brolin and Guy Pearce in Ridley Scott's "The Dog Stars," a postapocalyptic sci-fi film that will shoot in Italy. ***



6 cups peaches peeled and sliced 1/4 cup orange juice concentrate from a can 1/4 cup peach juices reserved 1/2 cup sugar **1**teaspoon cornstarch 1/2 teaspoon almond extract 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

INSTRUCTIONS

FOR THE BOTTOM LAYER:

Mix the melted butter with all of the crushed cookies, and press into a 9x13in. pan.

FOR THE MIDDLE LAYER:

With a handheld mixer, mix the cream cheese with the powdered sugar and cool whip. Spread the cream cheese layer over the cookie crust.

Cover the dish with plastic wrap and chill for 3 hours or overnight.

Add the peaches layer on top. Serve chilled.

FOR THE TOP LAYER:

Peel and slice all the peaches. To avoid too much excess liquid in the top layer of this dessert (the peach layer), place the peeled sliced peaches into a colander inside a larger bowl, to allow the peach juices to drip out. Reserve the juices. Chill the peeled sliced peaches in the fridge until ready to assemble. In a medium sized sauce pan, bring to a boil the reserved peach juices, orange juice concentrate, sugar, cornstarch, vanilla and almond extract. Let this sauce thicken and cool.

In a large bowl, toss the cooled sauce with the 6 cups of sliced peaches, allowing excess liquid to drip out.

Recipe Notes

Optional: You can chill the top layer separate from the two bottom layers. Just add the peach layer right before serving, to help keep the cookie crust from getting too soft from any excess liquid.


