Author Shares Stories at the LASAC

Author, Kris Erickson Rowley, shares her book about Trolls and their Folklore at the Lakes Area Senior Activities Center on June 13 at 2:00pm.

Kris Rowley has had a life-long interest in all types of folklore, but especially stories from Norway. Her family immigrated from Norway over a 50-year period starting around the 1850s until the turn of the century in 1900. Rowley's own children grew up listening to troll stories and remain on guard when near forests, mountains, and bridges. She has a large collection

of hand-carved trolls and Norwegian fairy tales/troll stories. Rowley began telling troll stories to various groups of all ages in the early 1990s. Unlike life, troll tales are clear about where the battle lines lie between good and evil.

Rowley has been a freelance writer since 1994 in various publications. In 2019, under the name Kris Erickson Rowley, she authored two nonfiction books on commission on Norwegian trolls for elementary-aged children - Mythical Creatures Trolls for Focus Readers and Trolls Legends and Fairy Tales for AV2 by Weigl. More recently, she wrote two books on commission for middle school/high school-aged youth on financial topics for BrightPoint Press: A Quick Guide to Saving and Investing and A Quick Guide to Insurance. These were both copyrighted in 2025. Her books are available on Amazon as well as other

Kris Rowley also serves as the Dickinson County Treasurer in Spirit Lake, Iowa. She and her husband, Dave Rowley, moved to Spirit Lake in 1996 with their 4 now grown children.

Residents who live on Hill Avenue will still have access to driveways and there will be workers helping to coordinate access in or out as needed. Otherwise, normal traffic will need to detour around the various areas when they are under construction. When work is ready to begin at the south end of Hill Avenue additional notice will be provided. The work on the north end of Hill is expected to take approximately three weeks.

The 23rd Street reconstruction work is expected to begin June 16. Homeowners along the affected areas between Hill Avenue and Chicago will be receiving letters from the project manager soon and additional information will be provided to the public shortly before work commences. Plan on the area between Hill Avenue and Erie being closed at that time and until mid-August, and for those who have activities at the Little League fields or want to access Aspen Seemann Memorial Park please use the entrances at the school to the school parking areas to the south of the park and the new concession stand and restrooms.


In response, a restoration project is underway to repair and







LETTER TO THE EDITOR

To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to express my strong support for the continued fluoridation of Milford's public drinking water and to highlight both the historical significance and the well-documented public health benefits of this vital measure. The Milford Municipal Utilities board is planning to discontinue this initiative.

Community water fluoridation has been recognized as one of the most significant public health achievements of the 20th century. First implemented in Grand Rapids, Michigan, in 1945, fluoridation has been instrumental in dramatically reducing the prevalence of tooth decay in both children and adults. Over the past 75+ years, numerous studies and health organizations including the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the World Health Organization (WHO), and the American Dental Association (ADA) — have confirmed its safety, efficacy, and cost-effectiveness. Of note, the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) awarded Milford Municipal Utilities a Water Fluoridation Quality Award from the CDC in 2023.

Water fluoridation works by maintaining a low level of fluoride in the mouth throughout the day. This helps to rebuild weakened enamel and reverse early signs of tooth decay. Importantly, it benefits people of all ages and income levels, especially those who may have limited access to dental care. This limited access of dental care is more than realized in our community due to the low number of dentists in the state that accept Medicaid. Many families do not have the means or ability to travel several hours to seek this care.

Ending fluoridation could have serious public health consequences, particularly for children, seniors, and our already underserved community. We should continue to build on the proven success of this measure, rather than reverse course on a policy that has protected generations from preventable dental disease.

Thank you for your attention to this important matter. I urge you to support the continued fluoridation of our city's drinking water in order to maintain and promote the oral health of all residents by attending the Milford Municipal Utilities board meeting on June 17, 2025, at 4pm.

Each year a portion of the Iowa Great Lakes Walleye Weekend Registration proceeds are donated back to the community to assist with various conservation and

angling projects. This year, with the fantastic turnout of over 2,200 anglers from 21 different states, the Iowa Great Lakes Area Chamber is excited to announce a total donation amount of \$20,000. The funds were split between six applicants with a variety of projects directly aff ecting angling and conservation in the Iowa Great Lakes Area.

The recipients of this year's grant application process were:

Camp Foster YMCA (\$1,000). These funds will be used to help share the joy of fishing and educate their campers on how to properly handle fish. The funds will be going towards quality supplies to give campers the best experience possible.

Center Lake Improvement & Protective Association (\$1,000). These funds will go towards collecting water samples in four different locations within Center Lake for water quality purposes for Iowa Lakeside Lab.

East Okoboji Lakes Improvement Corporation (\$3,500). These funds will assist with the injection of 190 gallons of Aquathol K into East Lake Okoboji, south of the Narrows shoreline, Upper Gar shoreline, and Minnewashta shoreline.

Okoboji Protective Association (\$3,500). These funds will help with the (Cooperative Lakes Area Monitoring Project (CLAMP) to help in measuring water quality in the Iowa Great Lakes. Measuring water quality helps guarantee safer lakes for fishermen/women and their catches.

The Iowa Great Lakes Fishing Club (\$5,000). This club hosts numerous kids fishing events for various organizations throughout the Iowa Great Lakes Region. Funds will be used to help support our local kids fishing events that will impact over 800(+) kids. Their event has 105 kids at Isthmus Park, 99 Okoboji 4th Graders, 5 Lakeside Lab events with 110 kids, 20 Camp Joy kiddos, 100 Spirit Lake students and many others. Each participant gets a

Spirit Lake Protective Association (\$6,000). These funds will go to acquire and install a new fishing/public access dock at Marble Beach in collaboration with the Iowa DNR.

Word is out and the check was secured for Dawn Ingvaldson who had the catch of a lifetime winning the grand prize of \$43,000. Another tagged walleye was caught shortly after and the angler was not registered for the extended contest. There are still 8 tagged Walleye out there. All anglers registered for the extended contest can cast their chance at catching these tagged walleye until August 31st, 2025. The first three tagged walleye caught will be paid out a portion of the extended contest registration fees for this year's extended contest.

Dear Tony, I am in a dark place. It's not work, it's not life it's everything. I have this sense of doom and my life seems to be filled with depressing thoughts that I can't get out of my mind. I need to find a way out of this dark place.

I can hear the despair in your words—feeling overwhelmed by a sense of doom is heavy, but you're not alone. We all face moments of darkness, and the way out begins with hope. In the 1950s, Dr. Curt Richter, a Johns Hopkins psychobiologist, conducted a controversial experiment on rats to study the impact of hope. He took rats and placed them in a water filled jar and measured how long they could swim before drowning. The rats gave up within minutes. In a follow-up, knowing the precise time the rats were about to perish, Richter "rescued" the rats just before they drowned. How much longer do you think the rats could swim after being saved? 15 minutes? 60 minutes? Remember, originally they swam for only a few minutes before

As it turned out, after being saved, the rats swam for over 2.5 days, suggesting that the experience of being saved instilled hope, enhancing their perseverance. This demonstrated hope's powerful role in our lives. We too can change our outlook and attitude toward life in a heartbeat with a renewed sense of hope.

By being more hopeful, we bring many benefits to our life,

- Increased Resilience: Hope helps you bounce back from setbacks by fostering a belief that challenges can be overcome.
- Improved Mental Health: Hope reduces anxiety and depression by promoting positive expectations for the future.
- Enhanced Motivation: Hope inspires you to set and pursue meaningful goals, driving persistent effort.
- Stronger Relationships: Hope encourages optimism, making you more supportive and fostering deeper connections with others.
- Better Physical Health: Hope is linked to lower stress levels, which can improve immune function and overall
- Greater Problem-Solving Ability: Hopeful thinking promotes creative solutions and adaptability in difficult situations.
- **Increased Life Satisfaction:** Hope cultivates a sense of purpose, leading to greater fulfillment in daily life.
- Boosted Self-Esteem: Hope reinforces belief in your
- ability to shape a positive future, enhancing confidence. Improved Coping Skills: Hope equips you to handle ad-
- versity with a focus on possibilities rather than limitations. **Inspiration for Others:** Living with hope can uplift those

3. **Connect with Supportive People:** Surround yourself with optimistic individuals who uplift and inspire, reinforcing belief in a brighter future.

4. Visualize Positive Outcomes: Engage in mental imagery of successful scenarios to boost motivation and maintain hope during challenges.

5. Learn from Past Successes: Reflect on times you overcame obstacles, like the rats' extended swimming after rescue, to reinforce belief in your resilience.

Despair is a human experience, but what matters is how we respond. It's a call to action—reach out, ask for help, and make
