Summer is here, and the Art League is buzzing with creativity. Art Adventure Camp kicked off in June, and more than 300 children ages 6-14 will participate in the 7-week camp. Thank you to the Donnie Williams Foundation and Choptank Electric Cooperative for the funding to help produce this program, and the Town of Ocean City Recreation Department for partnering.

While Art Adventure Camp is sold out, there are other oppor-

tunities for kids to express themselves this summer including our Free Kids Crafts every Saturday, Kids Acting Camp in August, and youth art classes.

Our galleries have also been buzzing with activity. July features a stunning solo exhibition by Petra Bernstein and the 26th annual Beverly Bassford Juried show, while August brings us master plein air artists Kirk McBride and Lynne Lockhart with new works from their travels.

The highlight of summer is our 20th Annual Artists Paint OC Plein Air Festival August 13-17. This 5-day event brings 50 professional artists to paint outdoors in the Ocean City area, vying for over \$7,000 in prizes. The festival includes opportunities to watch artists create and collect original artwork.

In addition to the adult artists, kids ages 6-17 can participate in Kid's Paint OC. Thanks to a grant from the Worcester County Arts Council and John Sisson, we will provide art supplies for 200 kids to make art "en plein air" just like the adults. Their work will be on display at the Wet Paint Sale on Sunday, August 17.
