To the Editor:

The Iowa Great Lakes Association (IGLA) extends our strong appreciation to Supervisors Steven Dullard and Levi Markwardt for standing up for the majority of area residents who do not support the expansion of industrial wind turbine development in our region.

By introducing and seconding a motion to establish a two-year moratorium, Supervisors Dullard and Markwardt acted with courage and integrity. They sought a necessary pause until the full consequences of these massive industrial projects on our lakes' watershed, environment, and economy can be properly evaluated.

Unfortunately, Chairman Bill Leopold and Supervisor Kim Wermersen voted against the motion, ignoring both the data and the overwhelming public concern. Even more troubling was Supervisor Steve Clark's decision to abstain after citizens raised credible concerns about conflicts of interest. The result: a 2-2 split, killing the moratorium and silencing the voices of the majority.

This outcome is not acceptable. Dickinson County residents deserve leadership that reflects their will—not silence, obstruction, or disregard. We call on Chairman Leopold and Wermersen to stop blocking this common sense measure and instead collaborate with Supervisors Dullard and Markwardt to draft a moratorium that respects the people they were elected to serve.

The stakes for our lakes, economy, and community are too high to ignore.



At the end of the day, I'm wiped out. I try my best to be present for the kids and family but I'm mentally exhausted and most of the time I just want to go to bed. How can I improve my energy levels?

Between meetings, deadlines, family, and just trying to keep up, it can feel like we're always running on fumes. So, what do we do? We grab coffee, power through with willpower, or count on adrenaline to carry us. A lot of times it helps to get through the day, but day after day, in the long run, it's not the answer.

The answer is within us, and we have all we need to create maximum energy in our life. What if I told you the real source of energy isn't in your coffee cup or calendar app—but in something I call **ESPN**. And no, not the sports channel.

ESPN stands for **Exercise**, **Sleep**, **Purpose**, **and Nutrition**. These four simple habits are the real MVPs when it comes to feeling energized, balanced, and grounded. They may not be flashy, but they work—and when you nurture each one, they build on each other to power your whole life

E = Exercise: Move to Feel Alive

When you're low on energy, moving your body might feel like the last thing you want to do—but it's often the thing that helps the most. A short walk or a few minutes of stretching can flip a switch in your brain and body. A few simple ways to bring this to life:

- Get moving every day—even if it's just 10 minutes.
- Don't worry about intensity. Just aim for consistency.
- Add movement into your routine: take the stairs, walk during calls, stand more often

S = Sleep: Don't Cheat the Recharge

Sleep is the first thing many of us sacrifice—and the one thing we absolutely can't fake. When we don't sleep well, everything suffers. Energy. Mood. Focus. All of it. I personally use an Oura Ring to monitor my sleep. When its below 70 in the morning I know I won't be at my best throughout the day. A few small steps to try out today might be:

• Aim for 7-9 hours/night of quality sleep. When you exercise, you will sleep better also.

• Stick to a regular sleep schedule, even on weekends (both going to bed & waking)

• Create a wind-down routine. Power down your screens,

dim the lights, and read a book.

P = Purpose: Fuel from Within

Purpose is your emotional engine. It's that feeling that what you're doing matters, even in small ways. When you lose touch with your "why," energy drains fast. But when you're connected to something bigger than yourself, it motivates and inspires you. Three ideas to start are:

• Begin your day by asking: "What's one thing today that matters to me?"

• Prioritize your daily tasks with the things you value most.

• Make space for something that fills your cup—a hobby, a meaningful chat, a small act of kindness.

N = Nutrition: Eat to Power Your Day

Food isn't just about getting full—it's your body's fuel. When we eat mindlessly or grab what's convenient, we often feel sluggish and foggy. But when we eat with intention, it's amazing how much better we feel. A few go-to habits:

• Focus on real food: proteins, healthy fats, whole grains, and vegetables

• Drink more water than you think you need. Aim for half an ounce to an ounce per pound of body weight. Example: 150 weight would be 75 - 150 ounces per day.


• Keep sugar and caffeine in check. With these items it's about moderation.

Putting It All Together

Think of **ESPN** like your personal dashboard. When just one dial is off—say, you're not sleeping well—it drags everything else down. But when you start making small changes across the board, even tiny ones, things start to shift. You feel clearer. Lighter. More in control.

And here's the best part: you don't have to overhaul your life. Just pick one thing to try this week. Maybe it's a 10-minute walk. Or drinking more water. Or going to bed 30 minutes earlier. Start small. Let it build. Keep improving over time, step by step.

Energy doesn't have to be a mystery or something you chase. It's not "out there" – it's already within you. You can maintain it—with intention, a bit of self-awareness, and a little ESPN. Check out my website for FREE resources

Gates open at 5:00pm, there will be a food truck on the grounds. A freewill offering will be taken. All are invited to attend this memorable evening of music!






The publisher does not necessarily share the views/opinions stated in the "Letters to the Editor" published in The Lakes News Shopper. **Letter to the Editor:**

I've always said that one of the things that I love about sports is how they bring people from all different backgrounds together, working with each other for one goal. The other thing that I love about sports is that they truly are such a microcosm about life, and so many times that is truly a good thing. 
Sports being a microcosm of life truly hit for Haliburton, who was battling through a calf injury suffered in Game Four to play for his team and try to help the Pacers win their first NBA Championship. One of the risks of playing on an injured calf is rupturing your Achilles, and the minute Haliburton hit the court, you could tell he knew that is probably what happened. Those of us who watched it happen live and then saw the replay, and have seen this injury before, can also only speculate until they do an MRI on Monday, but it sure looked like a ruptured Achilles tendon, which would put Haliburton's 2025-26 season in jeopardy. So, sports, much life like, show us that even when you do the right thing, the unselfish thing, putting your teammates and franchise first, sometimes it doesn't always work out; hitting Haliburton squarely in the mouth with the "Life isn't Fair" punch. Haliburton insisted on playing through the injury, saying, "If I can walk, I can play," and he had a big role in the Pacers 108-91 drubbing of the Thunder in Game Six on Thursday night, scoring 14 points and handing out five assists in just 23 minutes of action. Haliburton appeared primed for the biggest stage of his career on Sunday night, hitting those three 3-pointers, when life threw its haymaker at him and the Pacers. Haliburton had been the breakout star of the NBA Postseason, leading the Pacers on their improbable run to the Finals. In all four rounds, he hit a tying or winning shot in the final seconds, becoming the NBA's first player do so in a single postseason. It was looking like a story-book finish for this former Cyclone who plays the game with so much passion and a contagious smile, and as we all know, life changes in the blink of an eye. One shot-fake and drive later, and Haliburton is on the court and the Pacers realistic chance of an NBA Championship is truly gone, and honestly, Haliburton's 2025-26 season may be as well.

Sports, much like life, is about how you react to what happens to you when you get punched in the face, when you work so hard for something that you want and you don't get it, when you get knocked down, do you get back up? I have no doubt that Haliburton will get back up, and he will do so with that contagious smile that he came to Ames with, that he played every game with as an ISU Cyclone, that he has played every game with as an NBA player and he will continue to do so in the future. I have no doubt that Haliburton will lean on his faith in Jesus Christ to help him get through this low point of his career, and he will come through this stronger than ever because of this faith. Haliburton also has a very strong support system with his family. This family showed their true character during Haliburton's sophomore season when he broke his wrist and missed the entire second half of the season, yet they still came to every home and away game to see Tyrese and support his teammates. In sports, just like life, you can't get through tough times alone; you need faith and you need family. Haliburton has both of those and will be smiling on that basketball court again, better than ever, and making those around him better, showing life that you can't keep him down!

All you need to do is apply, and, when we ask you to; mow your lawn, pick up pet waste, and flag out shallow utilities and electric lines and we will do the rest through a contractor. The timing of this will be late August through September. We will certainly keep you well informed of the start date and when the SQR will happen on your lawn.

Iowa Lakes Aviation Program Surpasses 300 FAA Check Rides



Clean water panelists include Pete Hildreth, division administrator for Conservation & Recreation for Iowa DNR; Susan Kozak, director of Soil Conservation and Water Quality for IDALS; Joe McGovern, president of the Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation; Larry Stone, photographer, naturalist, explorer and writer. The panel will be moderated by John Lundell, retired mayor of the city of Coralville, who has been inducted into the Iowa League of Cities' Hall of Fame for his career in local government.

Hildreth, who earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Conservation Management in 2001, has served as the Division Administrator for the Conservation and Recreation Division for the Iowa DNR since October of 2020. His journey with the DNR began in 1999 as a seasonal employee in the Wildlife and Fisheries Bureaus.





Iowa with a Bachelor of Science in Geology, was appointed Director of Soil Conservation and Water Quality for the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship in April of 2019. As Director, Susan works on the expansion of the Water Quality Initiative across the state to meet nutrient reduction goals, while still focusing on our important traditional soil

conservation practices.

McGovern is in his 13th year as President of Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation. a nonprofit land trust that works statewide with partners and supports to protect and restore Iowa's land, water and wildlife. Prior to becoming President, Joe spent 13 years as INHF's Land Stewardship Director.




